Sunday 22nd July will be the third occasion on which singers from all over Kent gather at St Margaret's Church to join in an impromptu performance of a major choral work under Barry Kemp's direction. In 2005 it was Handel's Messiah, last year Mendelssohn's Elijah, and this summer Haydn's Creation is the work planned.

Some members of the choir have 'come and sung' the Creation before, most memorably at the Albert Hall in the company of several thousand other voices. Although we don't anticipate quite that many on this occasion, we do look forward to welcoming a good band of singers, whether they sing regularly in a choral group or not. This is a chance for those who may feel rather diffident about their musical abilities to enjoy singing with others Haydn's wonderful music. Perhaps you know 'The Heavens are telling the glory of God', or appreciate how the composer represented the different animals as they were created in the accompaniment. Maybe this is a work you have always wanted to hear - now is your chance.

The soloists this year will be Maggie Bloor (soprano), David Clark (tenor) and Christopher Winter (bass), while the organist will be Michael Cooke. The rehearsal will start promptly at 3.00 p.m. and the performance will begin at 6.30 p.m.

Entrance for both singers and listeners will be £6.00, contributions this year again going towards the roof appeal. The fee will include a glass of wine or fruit juice and, for singers, light refreshments after the rehearsal. 

## Nature Notes

### NATURE NOTES FOR JUNE

Each June, certain private gardens in the precinct of Canterbury Cathedral are open to the public under the National Gardens Scheme. They include the gardens of the Archdeaconry and the Deanery. The Archdeaconry is perhaps the most picturesque of the buildings in the precinct. It consists of a mixture of flint, ragstone and red brick and was constructed from the remains of the refectory and kitchens of the former Christ Church Priory.

A wild flower garden has been created under a large and spreading copper beech tree next to the Archdeaconry. At the time of our visit, foxgloves, red campion and green alkanet were the predominant species in bloom. Roses were scrambling up the ancient walls surrounding the garden and growing on the walls themselves were a mixture of domestic and wild flowers including antirrhinum, wallflower, red valerian and pellitory-of-the-wall. Ferns such as polipody and maidenhair spleenwort had also found themselves a space on the walls where they could thrive.

Within the five gardens as a whole we came across, among other trees, medlar, walnut and common mulberry. Along with quince, they make up a quartet of trees often planted in the past at the corners of herb gardens and orchards. The medlar, walnut and common mulberry trees we saw at Canterbury may well be descended from specimens planted when the gardens of the precinct were cultivated by the Benedictine monks of the dissolved Christ Church

The fruit of the medlar is pear shaped and is vellowish brown. Medlars are gathered in October when they are still hard and sour. They are stored until they become soft when they are either made into jelly or eaten as a dessert. They taste a little like baked apple.

English walnuts can be pickled in vinegar whilst the green plum-like husk is still fleshy. Alternatively, the walnut can be left until it is ripe when the husk rots away, exposing the wrinkled shell of the nut.

to red to black. Although it has an unusual flavour, some people like to eat it raw, but it is more often used in jam and wine making. The common mulberry tree is often found in gardens of old country houses, serving as the centre piece of a lawn.

Above our heads, as we inspected the gardens one by one, we caught the sight or heard the calls of house martins, jackdaws, herring gulls and swifts. With their distinctive blue-black and white plumage, house martins are one of the most conspicuous of all of our summer visitors. Most householders who have house martins nesting under the eaves of their homes feel privileged to have the birds return to the same site year after year. In Canterbury house martins doubtless obtain the mud they need to build or repair their nests from the many building sites that currently exist in the centre of the city. House martins basking on a sunlit roof prior to departure to Africa in September or October are a classic sign of Autumn.

The jackdaw has an irrepressible jauntiness both in the air and on the ground and a reputation for guile and intelligence. It is an intensely social bird and nests in belfries, down chimneys, in holes in trees and on the towers of ancient buildings. A colony of jackdaws nests in holes in the walls of Canterbury Cathedral in which scaffolding poles were once inserted, among other nooks and crannies on the building.

The herring gull is the species which we automatically associate with the word 'seagull' and its resounding cries are reminiscent of the seaside. Herring gulls started nesting on the roofs of buildings in the 1920s and their presence is often deemed unpopular by homeowners. The birds' favourite food includes molluscs and crabs although they have a very catholic diet. In Canterbury they doubtless take advantage of food dropped or discarded by the thousands of visitors to the city.

In June the yearling swifts (the ones not yet breeding) gather together, particularly in the evenings, to perform wild displays as they case each other in the sky above Canterbury. These gatherings are known as screaming parties and are a fitting finale to a wonderful summer's day.

### The final part of Stan Randall's series about a vear in the life of a fruit farmer THE FRUITS OF OUR LABOUR

And so we reach the last stage of our yearly quest to harvest and sell enough fruit to keep us solvent. Routine weed and pest control continues until gathering the crop becomes a full time job. Now the help of the women in the family is needed together with casual workers. Women generally make the best pickers of soft fruit and many are very good ladder workers. Men were in demand for their ability to move and set ladders, especially in the taller trees, and up until the 1960s and 70s many local shift workers found part-time work on fruit farms for a few weeks, but as cherry growing declined and more dwarf hard fruit trees were planted women pickers predominated.

Even if Spring has been kind there can be trouble ahead - indeed there will be for sure if you grow cherries. As the crop ripens bird damage can be disastrous, particularly when caused by starlings. Attacking in flocks they squabble and slash at everything in sight, and can leave a tree dripping in juice in no time. Attempts to shift them have included shaking football rattles, or tins full of stones, gas cannons and fireworks on a slow burning rope, and the ultimate weapon, a shotgun. The other major problem is rain, several hours of which can split even semi-ripe fruit as can a short thunderstorm. I remember one in particular. We had just begun picking a black variety, Gaucher, which was usually more resistant to splitting than most, when a storm blew up just before 3 o'clock. We dashed to the shed and had an early tea break, emerging about 20 minutes later to hot sunshine. Returning to the tree we found at least 80% damage, and it was obviously going to be uneconomic to continue. Split cherries are not marketable, and they soon rot on the tree spoiling any sound fruit that remains.

Late frosts, severe enough to damage blossom or even blacken fruitlets, are not too common on the lower lying land near the river, but one such did occur on the 17th May 1935. Surprisingly a few places suffered only slightly, and Father had what I believe was his best year financially. Cold damp weather seems a bigger problem, and can result in poor pollination or, by halting the growth of tiny fruits for even a short period can cause later natural thinning to be excessive. In any case, the variation in crop volumes year on year can be great; we've picked

as low as a couple of hundred to as many as 2,500 twelve pound trays of Victoria plums from the same

Other problems? As we had boundaries on both road and footpaths we suffered quite badly from scrumping, including once some soldiers standing on the top of their lorry in the lane! It was not so much what people took as the damage they did to trees and fences that annoyed us most. One Sunday evening in the 1950s, relaxing in Pump Lane with some friends after a hard weekend cherry picking, I watched in horror as about thirty or so boxes of our best Naps fell off the lowered tail board of our local haulier Mr Elliott's pre-war Bedford 5-tonner as it groaned past us. The 'chip' baskets, made by the splendidly named British Basket and Besto Co., had been stacked too high, and the lower ones had sagged as gravity overtook the strength of containers. Alan dashed off to get some replacements and we all mucked in to salvage what we could. Remarkably little damage had occurred, and we found we now had 101 boxes where 100 had been loaded! And surprisingly, when we received the sale return from the Covent Garden agent no adverse comments were

As the season progresses, from gooseberries and currants, through the worry of cherries, the more relaxing picking of damsons and plums, I always found the stress reducing all the while, and apple and pear gathering very enjoyable. And as the last Comice pear is carefully packed in your picking basket, you can think to yourself, 'this is where we came in twelve months ago'. Stan Randall


