

Editorial

This month we celebrate the 40th birthday of Action Forum, coincidentally, I heard on the radio today, sharing it with the birth of colour television. In early 1969 Hamish had the idea of printing a free delivery sheet, paid for by local advertising, to publicise the work of the 'Help the Needy' committee with which he was involved. Having successfully set up the advertising, production and distribution teams it seemed a waste to stop after that first edition in March and so he with the editorial team decided to produce a monthly copy which would be delivered to every door in Rainham and Wigmore (at that time 10,000 houses). After a few months Hamish went to further his education at the London College of Printing and an enthusiastic team continued the monthly magazine. By the time he returned to Rainham in the autumn of 1971 the enthusiasm had begun to wear a bit thin as the team were trying to hand print and fold the copies each month, a mammoth task! Hamish again took control and having talked me into helping we reverted to commercial printing with the first copy that carried my name as editor in December 1971 and the rest as they say is history. Over the forty years many hundreds of people have helped in a variety of ways with the production of Action Forum, some for very long periods. Christine Smith only recently retired from compiling the Diary each month after a thirty five year stint, some door to door distributors from the early days returned to help again after our brief foray with commercial distribution and continue to this day. Joe Ennis has been writing his monthly column 'Nature Notes' since January 1994 and prior to this in the 1980s we enjoyed many 'Rides from Rainham' penned by Kemsley & I, his pseudonym. Freddie Cooper was a regular contributor from the early days with his 'Memories of Rainham' series. As a result of an article in Action Forum clubs and societies have been formed, the Medway Towns Footpaths Group immediately springs to mind and many, many readers have answered appeals for volunteer help in a wide variety of causes. This is all made possible by our advertisers payments and in turn your loyal support by using their services when appropriate. Robert J. Kitney, B. Hayfield & Sons and John Weir have all been advertising with us since the 1970s. Since we returned to volunteer distribution in September 2000

the money saved has been donated to charity, the three main recipients being the Kajiado Development Trust in Kenya, St Matthew's, Wigmore and St Margaret's, Rainham parish churches. Thank you everyone who has helped in any way during the last forty years your efforts are really appreciated by very many residents and I know that copies of Action Forum are sent all over the world each month providing a small glimpse of home to many ex pats.

Sadly, celebrating in a very different way as a family, we appreciate three lives this month. On February 17th my aunt Vi Harris died peacefully but suddenly at her home of the last 70 years in Newington aged 96. Born and brought up in Rainham, the youngest of the three Cheeseman sisters, she will be remembered by some of our older readers as a member of the Rainham Historical Society. Together with her sister she enjoyed many talks, outings and holidays with the group. Two days later we had the news of the death of my father in law J. P. Mackay Miller (Jamie) after several years of gentle decline. The family moved to Macklands in Rainham in 1956 and quickly became involved in community life. One of Jamie's biggest contributions was to coordinate the purchase and subsequent conversion of Wakeley's Oast and granary beside Rainham Station, in the late 1960s, to the community centre it still remains. The necessary fund raising took several years and continued after he & Phyl moved to Norfolk in 1975 but the project was eventually completed. Other readers may remember the youth club that took place in the cellar at Macklands, a brave decision to allow youngsters the run of your property. Another two days and we heard that my aunt Mabel Thomas who had for the last few years lived at Rogers House after leaving her home in Maidstone Road had died. Some of you may remember her husband Bert Thomas who sold greengrocery around the streets of Rainham for many years initially from his horse and cart and later a small

As I write it is a glorious spring day, the snowdrops are out and the warm sunshine means it is very tempting to be outdoors. Enjoy the month and we will see you again in April, here's to the next 40 years.

Correspondence ST MARGARET'S CHURCH HERITAGE FUND UPDATE

Dear Editor.

We would like to thank everyone for the tremendous support and contributions that have been made to the Heritage Fund over the past four years.

We are very pleased that there are now sufficient funds available to carry out the roof main repairs and renovation of the historic painted ceiling panels. Work will start on the 20th April using a local company, B. W. May and Sons, and will take six months. This

company is expert in the repair of old Churches. An expert conservation architect will be overseeing the project together with a project manager and a safety supervisor, all experienced in this type of work.

The Church will be partitioned to allow use for most church services and events, including funerals and weddings. Because less damage than expected was actually found the figure required for the work has been revised, this automatically results in a decrease of the amount of grant that will be provided by English Heritage.

The good news is that there is sufficient money to pay for part of the Tower renovation and we are therefore hoping to follow on with this work.

We still need about £100,000 to complete the project, but this is very achievable with continued support and then the long term future of the Church Building will be secure for the use of everyone and we can feel very proud of our great achievement.

Nature Notes

NATURE NOTES FOR JANUARY & FEBRUARY Despite the fact that I have lived in Kent for many years, I have paid only a few fleeting visits to the Isle of Thanet. As a one-time commuter, the Thanet towns are more familiar to me as the last six stops on my trains home, namely, Birchington, Westgate, Margate, Broadstairs, Dumpton Park and Ramsgate. In February I decided to make amends by visiting the Isle of Thanet, the coastline of which is essentially chalk cliff with a rocky foreshore and sandy bays. Thanet is one of the most reliable localities in Kent to see the purple sandpiper, the ring-necked parakeet and the fulmar. In winter, inclement weather conditions, particularly northerly gales, may force ocean-living birds such as red-throated divers, guillemots, kittiwakes and razorbills into the shelter of Ramsgate Harbour or the various bays around the Thanet coast. Having taken the Thanet Way, the A299, I drove through Birchington and Westgate before stopping briefly in Margate, near to the Dreamland Amusement Park. The sandy bay, well known to holiday makers for over two hundred years, was empty apart from a lone dog walker and a flock of black headed gulls. The area around the harbour appeared somewhat down at heel but there are hopes that it will benefit from the building of a Turner gallery at the end of the harbour

I parked and left my car near Foreness Point, in Cliftonville, which juts out into the Thames Estuary. On a grassy headland I came across a small number of turnstones probing, presumably, for worms. They are small waders, dull brown above and white beneath, and are so named because they upend stones (and seaweed) along the shore line in search of sand hoppers and other crustaceans. They can be extremely

Below the low cliffs at Foreness Point are musselencrusted platforms of chalk. Feeding there were some small waders which I immediately recognised, ringed plovers, and some which I didn't. A check of my bird book showed that they were purple sand pipers. Like turnstones, they are among the tamest of birds but are very inconspicuous and easily overlooked. Their upper

parts are brown and black, faintly glossed with purple. They feed near the edge of the water, running up and down the shore line with the movement of the

Once back in my car, I headed a short distance inland to Northdown Park, Cliftonville. Here I met up with a locally well known flock of rose-ringed parakeets; they are descended, it is thought, from escaped cage birds. They have bright green plumage and a long tail and are the most northerly wild parrot population in the world. The birds are a serious agricultural pest in much of their African and Asia range. Evening roosts at Northdown Park are accompanied by a cacophony of loud screeching calls.

I returned to the coast at Kingsgate Bay which is over looked by Kingsgate Castle, a 19th century folly. Among the many black headed and herring gulls flying around the bay I spotted a number of fulmars which appeared to be inspecting old nesting sites on the chalk cliffs below the castle. At one time the fulmar nested only on St Kilda; today it breeds all around the coastline where there are suitable cliffs. This expansion has been attributed to the increase in the amount of offal being disgorged by trawlers and factory ships. The fulmar's stiff winged flight pattern enables it to ride updrafts on cliffs as easily as it glides over the waves.

I retired to the Captain Digby Inn for lunch where I had a window view of Kingsgate Bay and Castle. After lunch I went just a short distance along the coast before stopping at Joss Bay and North Foreland. Here keen surfers come to show their skills and parents with children probe with their nets in the many rock pools for crabs and shrimps. On the rocky outcrops I spotted curlew, oyster catcher, turnstone and rock pipit.

I proceeded down the coast road towards Broadstairs. I passed the North Foreland Lighthouse and many seaside villas, protected from the winds by sycamore and holm oak trees. Broadstairs is the smallest, quietist and most pleasant of the Thanet resorts. It overlooks a charming little harbour in Viking Bay which is surrounded by a horseshoe of low chalk cliffs. My attention was drawn to the bird

that is perhaps most associated with seaside towns, the herring gull. Large, robust, raucous and aggressive, it is the only grey backed gull that nests on roofs in these towns.

I finally arrived at Ramsgate, a handsome resort rich in robust Victorian red brick with a large and attractive harbour. As far as I could see, no red throated divers had been driven to shelter in the harbour, no guillemots, no kittiwakes and no razorbills. It was my fault, really, for having chosen to come on a nice, warm, sunny day. Still, I had seen purple sandpipers, rose-ringed parakeets, fulmars and a little more of the Thanet towns.

NINETEENTH CENTURY RAINHAM: Part Two of titbits from Milton Union records by Audrey Perkyns.

In 1838, while there was still only one MO for the whole of Milton Union, based in Milton, difficulties could arise in parishes at the opposite end of the

One late evening in November a Mrs Coulter had an accident, and the local doctor, George Dear Friend, was called to attend her. He knew he needed official authorisation to do so, so he called on both parish Overseers (answerable to the Relieving Officer at Milton), then both churchwardens; none was at home; in desperation he got the parish constable to authorise treatment, with a note to the MO to call in the morning.

Afterwards he sent in his bill to the Guardians of the Union. That was where the trouble started. The constable was not one of the officials legally recognised to authorise treatment, so the Guardians refused to pay. Dr Friend then wrote to the Poor Law Commissioners in London, on 25 November, 17 December and 13 January asking, with increasing exasperation, what he was supposed to do in this situation. The Commissioners consulted the Guardians, who now said that the case was not sufficiently urgent to have required instant attention, despite the memorial signed by the local Overseers, churchwardens and a majority of the ratepayers affirming the urgency of the case. Eventually the Commissioners chickened out and said the auditor would have to decide. In their letter the Guardians referred to 'laxity in this part of the Union'; Rainham had a bit of a reputation for being stroppy.
