## Nature Notes

NATURE NOTES FOR APRIL

The late Dr Eric Treacy, one-time Bishop of Wakefield, was a well known photographer of steam engines. "A familiar picture", he once wrote in one of his books, "but I must include it. It breathes the atmosphere of a spring day on Shap." I can only hope that these Nature Notes for April will be as successful as Treacy's photograph and will breath the atmosphere of a spring day on the marshes of the island of Elmley. The photograph shows a train of parcel vans near the hamlet of Greenholme in what is now Cumbria. The line side fields are separated by either stone walls or straggly hawthorn hedges. Clumps of sycamore trees provide some shelter from the winds. An impressive group of the Westmorland fells tower in the background. In the fields or in the higher fells, unseen by the camera, lapwing, redshank, oyster catcher, snipe and curlew would doubtless have been preparing to breed. All five of these species are present in winter on the island of Elmley (which is part of the Isle of Sheppey) but only the first three breed there. The grazing marshes of Elmley have been designated as a National Nature Reserve. The marshes are divided by a network of ditches and fresh water fleets, many of which are lined with common reed. The grassland is managed by the selective grazing of cattle and sheep so as to provide varieties of subtly different habitats. In the spring the short, grazed grassland, with scattered tussocks, encourages the resident lapwings and redshanks to breed there.

I entered onto the reserve at Straymarsh Cottages and proceeded slowly along the bumpy track, making a number of stops on the way. Birds and mammals beside the track take no notice of visitors provided that they stay in their cars. In the air a couple of male lapwings were competing with each other in a courtship ritual. They were seeking to attract a mate by means of exuberant, twisting and tumbling displays, accompanied by mewing calls. These song flights are a classic herald of spring and a memorable feature of the English countryside.

Other harbingers of spring are the swallow, the brown hare and the skylark. A number of newly arrived

swallows were indeed flying backwards and forwards over the grassland on both sides of the track. The Island is one of the important habitats in Kent of the hare and I came across two of them as I drove slowly along. Both were solitary and not involved in the courtship rite which has led them to be described as "mad" March hares.

Skylarks are fairly common on the grazing marshes and one very nearby encouraged me to stop for a while. The song of the skylark, as it hovers high in the air, is another evocative sound of Spring. A little further along the track, a flash of yellow caught my eye; it was the sight of a male yellow wagtail, a delightful and dainty summer visitor. This particular wagtail makes its nest in a depression in the ground in water meadows, well hidden under a cover of vegetation.

In due course I came to Kings Hill Farm, the HQ of the RSPB on the island. I then walked down to the Wellmarsh Scrape which is deliberately flooded grazing land. Crossing over a reed filled dyke on the way to a hide overlooking the scrape I heard the "plop" of a water vole as it entered the water. The reserve is a stronghold in Kent of the vole and, being used to visitors, they are quite tame.

The scrape consists of a number of little islands, surrounded by water, which are intended to give some protection from predatory mammals such as foxes and stoats. Visible from the hide were hundreds of waders including lapwing and avocets. I could hear the occasional alarm call of a redshank which is a nervous, noisy and restless bird at any time of the year. But I failed to see or hear any courtship display of a redshank or oyster catcher. What I did see, on the horizon, was the slow and lazy flight of a marsh harrier. These particular harriers are quite common on Elmley where they nest on the ground, usually in reed beds, but also in fields of rape or wheat adjoining the reserve. Their presence is not good news for nesting waders; mammals and amphibians comprise much of their diet but they also take nestlings of marshland birds. I much enjoyed my visit to Elmley but I have to say that I would have enjoyed, even more, a spring day on Shap, listening to the silence of the Westmorland

Fells, and watching the trains go by with the Bishop of Wakefield.

PS The most direct route to the Island of Elmley is over the old lifting bridge across The Swale and not over the new flyover. For the interest of any railway enthusiasts, the engine in Treacy's photograph was an unnamed and unrebuilt Patriot (45542) helped at the back by an unidentified tanker from Tebay shed.

MEMORIES OF RAINHAM Easter Primroses Joe Ennis' Nature Notes in April's Action Forum brought back very early memories of my childhood and how we decorated St Margaret's Church for Easter in the early 1920s. Each section of the congregation took charge of its own area, the more important places like the font, the pulpit, the chancel and the south porch were the privilege of the more important people i.e. the Vicars wife, Mrs W.A.R. Ball, Mrs Scott and Mrs Richard Wakeley etc. The Sunday School turned the north porch into a beautiful Easter garden. The window at the back on the south wall by the tower was the responsibility of the Rainham Girl Guides and like the others, no doubt, we were determined that our effort should be the best. That's where Joe Ennis Bredhurst Wood comes into the story. Although primroses grew freely on the other side of Boxley Hill we only knew of them growing anywhere near us in a wood reached by crossing an open space opposite Bredhurst Church. Our design for the window included an enormous cross of primroses standing up from a garden of spring flowers.

So on Good Friday we set out with our picnic equipment in the trek cart to gather primroses at Bredhurst. True they were there, but not in great numbers so after our picnic and a rest we set to and picked every flower that dared to show its face – not one escaped.

On Saturday we tied our well watered little bunches to a big wooden cross and joined other enthusiastic decorators in Church. I well remember the busy atmosphere, with Ladies, choir, Sunday School, Girl Guides and all the others rushing about spilling water and getting in each others way. By midday the work had to be finished and order restored in time for the afternoon weddings.

In subsequent years we found that our raid on Bredhurst ceased to supply sufficient material for our cross even when our own gardens were also denuded. So we became dependant for our window on a share of the armfuls of daffodils that Mrs Wakeley always sent from her fields at Meresborough. Her house is now Bryony School. Maybe Joe Ennis would say that we were partially, at least, responsible for the loss of primroses at Bredhurst, although such loss has also happened all around. I was thrilled to see that this year there have been small patches of primroses in the woods and banks round the Scragged Oak area. Perhaps they are coming back.

One memory leads to another and in 1940 when the school children were evacuated to South Wales some of us became involved with the local church and Sunday School. We were always eager to keep the children occupied during the holidays so we decided we would show Brynna how we decorated Rainham Church for Easter. We made a large wooden cross and on Good Friday set off for the railway embankment, where we were told the best primroses grew. They certainly did, great banks of long stemmed flowers just what we needed. The children picked baskets full with no danger of not leaving some to grow next year. The only trouble was that they were all covered in black smuts and had to be gently but thoroughly washed before we could use them. We made our cross and collected enough fish paste pots to fill with flowers to hang on the end of every pew.

Brynna had not been altogether sure that such goings on were in order for their church but on Sunday morning all agreed that the enthusiastic efforts of the children, including some of their own, added to the joy of that wartime Easter.


