The Dummy Airfield of the Second World War at Elm Dear Editor, Court near Gibraltar Farm, Bredhurst was obviously a well known secret at the time and a big attraction to small boys who made strenuous efforts to get close enough to spy on the site. Judging by the interest still today many succeeded and live to tell the tale. I have been sent stories, a map and an aerial photograph of the site, in which you can see the planes on the perimeter of the field. The planes were indeed plywood, the hanger canvas, the road ways shingle and old vehicles were moved around the area each day to give the impression that the field was working. These elaborate plans in fact proved a success and the ultimate compliment was paid by the Luftwaffe who bombed the field on more than one occasion, diverting their dangerous load on to farm land and away from Shorts Brothers at Rochester Esplanade who were the real target. The heavy guns based at Gibraltar Farm apparently did much damage to property in the area, shattering windows and cracking walls when they were fired. Ray Morley's letter in May Action Forum mentioned a 'dummy airfield' constructed at Gibraltar Farm during the Second World War. The actual construction there was much more ambitious. Technicians from Shepperton Studios were employed to design and build a complete dummy aircraft factory, intended to divert bombing from the Short's factory at Rochester, considered a key target.

The location was immediately north of the presentday Elm Court Garden Centre. As well as an extensive 'building' constructed of canvas-covered tubing; shingle was laid to simulate service roads, complete with non-running vehicles in parking spaces. Dummy

aircraft were parked on the surrounding fields to simulate finished product awaiting shipment. There were even dummy air-raid shelters and filled-in bomb 20th Century harp favourites and extracts from craters. The vehicles and aircraft had to be repositioned daily to preserve the illusion of a working

ability of the site to attract bombs diminished and it was eventually closed down. It would be interesting to me a line at 42 The Goldings, ME8 0AX. know if any traces of it are still recognisable.

# Nature Notes

NIGHTINGALE NATURE NOTES FOR MAY In early May I visited the Countryside Park on the Lower Rainham Road in the search for two summer migrants whose arrival I eagerly await. They are the turtle dove and the nightingale. The former can usually be found in the vicinity of the visitor centre. Last year, for example, I saw one perched on the top of a wild cherry tree overlooking the children's play area adjacent to the cafe. However, during three visits to the park, in early May, I failed to see or hear a single turtle dove and the bird's name had not appeared on the "Sightings" list at the Centre. I was becoming a little anxious, partly because of the copy date for this article was looming and partly because the numbers of visiting turtle doves to this country have fallen dramatically over the years. This may be attributed to their being shot or trapped whilst migrating over mainland Europe and to the use of herbicides on the short lived weeds such as fumitory on which they feed.

I commenced my search for the nightingale at Eastcourt Meadows, on the other side of Sharp's Green, where, last year, six of the birds were heard singing. For hundreds of year the meadows consisted of grazing land but, until some years ago, they were used as a municipal rubbish dump. They are now covered in scrub and are the breeding grounds, not only for nightingales, but also other birds such as whitethroat. Both of these species nest in the understorey of bramble and nettle which covers a large area of the former tip.

The flowers of the scrubland, in early May, were predominantly white. They included those of cow parsley, jack-by-the hedge or garlic mustard, hoary cress and white dead nettle, as well as those of hawthorn, rowen and wayfaring tree.

On my walk through the scrub I witnessed the unmistakable display flights of two whitethroats. The males burst into the sky singing and then plunged back into cover. I also heard the somewhat fitful calls of two male nightingales. I decided to return to Eastcourt Meadows during an evening when, hopefully, they would be putting on a more enthusiastic performance.

A week or so later I arrived at Sharp's Green an hour before sunset, having left my car outside the soon-tobe closed park gates. The scrubland was full of bird song: I heard the calls of blackbird, song thrush, robin, dunnock and chaffinch, as well as nightingale. I headed for a seat on the sea wall opposite Copperhouse Marshes. The piping calls of redshanks and oyster catchers emanated from the Medway Estuary as the birds settled down for the night. Behind me, much to my pleasant surprise. I heard the unmistakable call of a turtle dove, a soft, soporific, purring sound. It is quite distinct from the cooing calls of the collared dove and the wood pigeon. The turtle dove is typically seen perching on a bare branch and, sure enough, there it was on the bare branch of a large, partly toppled, railway poplar (or hybrid black poplar). Through my binoculars I could clearly see its pinkish breast and throat and the orange and buff chequered pattern on its wings. I was both relieved and delighted to see my first turtle dove of the new season.

I returned to my seat to watch the sun go down. Its light reflected on the exposed mud banks of the Medway, which turned from a silver colour, to yellow, to orange, and to red. As the sun disappeared below the horizon above Chatham Maritime, it was time to work my way slowly back through the scrubland towards Sharp's Green. By now the mountain bikers and dog walkers had gone home. I was on my own with the rabbits and the nightingales. of which there were about four or five. The birds are quite relaxed about human presence and one can get quite close to them without disturbing them. The male's song is a rich, loud, warble, with characteristic repetitions, including a remarkably bubbling "choc, choc, choc", and a long, high, drawn-out note slowly increasing in volume. Unfortunately, there was quite a high wind blowing during my visit and it was for this reason. I assume. that the nightingales' performances appeared to be somewhat subdued. (The mistle thrush has the alternative name of "storm cock" because he one of the few birds who is determined to sing through fierce March winds.) What I heard that evening, from the nightingales, did not appear to be their


