I could not resist using the idyllic farmyard picture of Westfield Sole Farm on the front cover this month. It is slightly out of our area as it is at the top of Boxley Hill but nevertheless receives a mention in the memories of Gibraltar Farm we include this month. The scene is so like the typical jigsaw puzzle picture of a 1950s farmyard it is hard to believe it is real. I feel fortunate that I can just remember those days when farming was one of the main employers in this area before mechanisation, particularly tractors, became the norm and hedgerows were grubbed to allow ever larger and more complex pieces of kit access to the land. After sixty years the circle has almost turned and once again the value of poppies and wild flowers in hav meadows, the use of natural fertilisers, rotation of crops, and allowing land to lie fallow every so often is appreciated, driven in not some small measure by the rapidly rising cost of all the artificial supplements modern farming demands. The introduction of a compulsory buffer strip around each arable field has helped this return to nature. As intended it allows plants and animals an undisturbed home and incidentally means walking the footpaths which border fields is much more pleasurable then when we were restricted to a three foot wide path which very quickly either became completely overgrown or almost impassable when ankle deep in mud. While the experiments continue we all reap the benefit and can enjoy the more traditional countryside of those days gone by. Even so I do not think we will ever again find such a beautiful country scene with a hand crafted hay stack, like the one pictured, next to a duckpond. Large round bales wrapped in black polythene do not have the same romantic image I'm afraid.

My apologies to the Apps family for my complete misunderstanding of their pictures, one of which we printed on the front cover last month. The only member of their family included in this photograph was Grandma (Mary Ann) Apps who is front centre next to the gentleman with the shotgun. They would be very interested to know if you can name any of the other people. They think possibly the picture was taken by someone who lived in the house and gathered all the available workers together to take this marvellous picture during the cherry harvest. I hope to

be able to include the correct family photo next month! If the thought of fresh Kentish cherries makes your mouth water you may like to join the Macmillan Cancer Support charity picnic in the Vines at Rochester on Sunday 5th July where fresh picked cherries from Upchurch will be on sale. Our pages contain many more suggestions to occupy your time this month so do read on and enjoy as many of them as you are able. Have a very good month and we will be with you again in August.

Dear Editor,

Thanks for printing my letter about the stone outside 292 Hempstead Road in the June edition of Action Forum. I have had an interesting reply. It seems the stone is not a Milestone but a Boundary Marker marking the boundary between Hempstead and Lidsing villages (though this boundary has now changed). The area known as Hempstead belonged to a man who lived in Highgate in London, (an absentee farm owner or landlord maybe). There is a traceable date on the stone reading 1800 or thereabouts. There seems also to be a tradition associated with the stone which required a man to go once a year to the stone with a child then hit the stone three times then hit the child. This would account for the lean of the stone perhaps. Should this be a true tradition then the man required to strike the stone could have been a tiedman beholden in some way to the absentee owner of Hempstead. If so I wonder if any of his family still reside in the area and whether or not they should be carrying on the tradition. Perhaps some of your Historical Society readers might find this an interesting challenge and investigate further with a resulting story in Action Forum.

GIBRALTAR FARM

Dear Editor

My Sister-in-Law has sent me clippings from the April and June Action Forums. I was born at Gibraltar Farm in August 1940, at the height of the enemy action. I can just remember the mock airfield on top of what we called the 'banks'. It was clearly visible from GARDEN PARTY our kitchen window. I seem to remember my brothers Dear Editor, who were a good 10 years older than me taking me there to look at the 'aircraft'. There were indeed many Garden Party on Saturday, 1st August at 37 Edwin bomb craters in the fields of the farm but my mother and father said that the only action the airfield really saw was when RAF planes in trouble tried to land. My fee of £4 includes a salad meal and a dessert. All father was bailiff to Henry Gurr and Sons who owned friends and supporters are welcome but please bring a Gibraltar Farm, a farm at Lidsing and one at Westfield garden chair if possible. The Annual General Meeting Sole at the top of Boxley Hill, as well as two butcher's of the Friends will take place in church on Saturday shops in Chatham High Street. The farm employed two brothers John (Jack) and Fred Hogg and neither had spoken to each other for years. The farm was put under army guard because of the proximity to the gun BREDHURST ART, CRAFT & PRODUCE SHOW site and one morning arriving for work one brother was challenged by the sentry to prove his identity, 'tell Bredhurst will be holding its annual Art. Craft and him who I am, Jack' said Fred - 'never seen him before replied Fred'!

The photo of Gibraltar Farm Dairy (April 2009) brought back many memories. The buildings were little altered when we left the farm in 1955. The thatched building was the dairy where milk was cooled and put into churns. It was a circular wooden building with the minimum of equipment, just a surface cooler and some troughs for washing pails and churns. The sloping roof behind the horse's head was one of two cow sheds, and the chimney stack on the skyline is Gibraltar Cottages. These were built in 1905 Wheatcroft Grove so the photo must post date that time.

I now live in Manchester and have not been back to Gibraltar Farm since 2001. Most of the buildings and the surrounding patchwork of field are gone.

Nature Notes

NATURE NOTES FOR JUNE

This month's Nature Notes are about a journey made along the Pilgrims Way between Wrotham, Kemsing, Otford and Chevening. To give readers their bearings, Wrotham lies in the shadow of the tall and slender telecommunications mast one sees on the top of the downs as one travels west on the M20 towards the M26 and Chevening lies to the north of the junction of the M26 with the M25.

Wrotham was once an important village on the turnpike Road between London, Maidstone and Folkestone, Here a cock horse or two would be hired to help carts and stage coaches up Wrotham Hill. In the early days of motoring the steep hill remained a problem, causing many an overheated engine. Once one reached the top, however, one had (and still has) the finest view in the county. In the foreground of the view is the Vale of Kent and, with Sevenoaks at its centre, the Ragstone Range. On the horizon is Ashdown Forest and Crowborough Beacon in the High Weald and Battle Ridge to the north of Hastings. We left Wrotham along the Pilgrims Way which, on its passage through Kent, runs along the bottom of the escarpment of the North Downs. The leaves on the trees on the downs varied in colour from the white of whitebeam. to the light green of field maple and beech, and to the dark green of yew. Sheep were grazing on some of the open slopes. The fields on both sides of the track were lined largely with oaks trees and had been set with either wheat or oil seed rape. In one field of wheat red poppies proliferated. Above another a number of swifts were hawking for flies: they were likely to be non-breeding yearlings. As for the rape fields, they may have been less barren than they appeared to be. Sedge warblers, reed buntings and whitethroats have been found nesting among the tangle of stems and linnets and tree sparrows have been seen feeding on ripening rape seeds.

The hedges lining the ancient Pilgrims way are also likely to be old, particularly since they are composed of a large variety of trees and shrubs. These include blackthorn. dogwood, field maple, hawthorn, hazel and privet. Hedges along the track are cut regularly, in the main because they would otherwise be a hazard along a road which is so narrow and winding.

The approach to Kemsing is through a tunnel of beech and

other trees which, in summer, bring some welcome shade to those walking along the Pilgrims Way. Kemsing is a pretty village with a well cared for look about it. We took a small detour to have a look at the large Victorian house that served as a youth hostel for many years. The former cycle shed was readily identifiable. The Youth Hostels Association, The Ramblers' Association and the Cyclists' Touring Club were all formed in the days when rambling and cycling were extremely popular and before the motor car became widely affordable. At one time there were four youth hostels within easy reach of the Kent stretch of the Pilgrims Way. Those at Crockham Hill. Kemsing, and Doddington have closed; only that at Canterbury remains open. High above the village is the Kemsing Down nature reserve which is managed by the Kent Wildlife Trust. I made a lone ascent to the top, after which I sat down for a well earned rest. The slope is most certainly steeper than the days when I did conservation work there. I spotted some typical flowers of chalk downland, including common rock-rose, small scabious and yellow wort. Dog and field roses were in bloom among the scrub on both sides of me. On this warm summer day grasshoppers and crickets could be heard chirping in the grassland; brown argus and common blue butterflies fluttered over it. A vellow hammer kept repeating its familiar call.

Otford, which is a thriving commuter village, was our next stop. It boasts the only listed village pond in the country. The pond's semi-domestic ducks are not however of any natural history interest. What we did come across. nevertheless, was a small colony of house martins, which are charming and delightful birds, nesting under the eaves of a row of terraced houses. A walk to the end of the High Street brought us to a tributary of the River Darent, by the side of which was growing fools' watercress and lesser water parsnip.

We crossed over the Darent, the fields on each side of which were dotted with sheep, and then over the M25 towards the red brick hamlet of Chevening. We had timed our visit along the Pilgrims Way to coincide with the opening of the grounds of Chevening House, the 18th century country retreat of the Foreign Secretary of the day. The union jack was flying from the top of the Kentish ragstone tower of St Botolph's Church and the six bells were being rung. The House itself lies in a parkland of

oak, common lime and beech trees, among which dairy cows graze. Swallows were swooping back and forth over the grassland. Having inspected the gardens we had a walk around the lake which was fringed with meadow sweet, water mint, water betony and vellow loosestrife. We then sat with great ceremony on the Foreign Secretary's well-cared-for lawn and had tea and cakes laid on by the Trustees of the Chevening Estate.

NINETEENTH CENTURY RAINHAM: titbits from Milton Union records by Audrey Perkyns. In 1842, on instructions from London, the Board of Guardians of the Milton Union appointed three separate Poor Law Medical Officers (MOs), one being for the parishes of Rainham, Lower Halstow, Hartlip and Upchurch. Since much illness resulted from poverty and malnutrition they could recommend the provision of mutton or spirits (gin or brandy). All their services had to be authorised by Poor Law officers, principally the Relieving Officer at Milton, but in an emergency by the overseers of the parishes. All the MOs were in constant trouble with the Guardians, most frequently for inefficiency with the paper work (weekly lists for the board meetings and quarterly returns). Sometimes they were reprimanded for failing to provide an adequate service or for other

Dr John Friend, MO from 1842, finally exasperated them beyond endurance by giving an order for mutton to a butcher other than the official one whose tender had been accepted by the board. He was asked to resign in 1850.

Dr George Henty, 1850-65, was reprimanded after he had a guarrel with one of the Rainham Guardians about a false entry in his report book.

Dr Henry Penfold was appointed in 1865. In 1866 the Guardians enquired if he had attended Elizabeth White who was sent to the workhouse by the Rainham overseer while in labour and her baby was delivered in a cart en route. His reply is lost, but he was not reprimanded on this occasion.

In 1874 the Rainham overseer with two assistants brought a sick man to the workhouse at 1.00 a.m., on Dr Penfold's orders. The workhouse officers were woken; they found the man simply drunk; he admitted he had been for three days, and he left the next morning. The Guardians remonstrated with the

MO: 'this is not the first time from the Rainham District in which expense and much trouble has been unnecessarily incurred'. Dr Penfold's reply states that he was concerned about the man's general condition (he seems to have feared hypothermia), and said he would have incurred public censure if the man had died.
