It was built for them to rent by Lord Harris the owner of the nearby brickfield where Thomas Apps was employed. The picture shows Thomas and Mary Ann Apps in the centre with their eldest son Robert. In the back row are Florence, Emma, George, Lucy, Frank, Ada and Minnie and in front Roland, Mark and Silas. The 1881 census also lists daughters Martha and Eva Emily and the 1891 includes Norah. Probably a not unusually large family in those days which just shows how in a hundred years our perceptions have changed.

GIBRALTAR FARM Dear Editor.

We were very interested in the photograph of Gibraltar Farm in the April issue of Action Forum. We have lived here for 24 years.

The house was once two cottages and part of one of had been damaged by "Big Bertha" a large gun situated on the dummy aerodrome that is now Elm Court garden centre. The damaged part was demolished while the remaining part and the other cottage were made into one house. The cottages had been built of attractive flint and brick but these had been coated in a substance at some time in the past that has proved impossible to remove.

Some years ago I saw a man taking photographs of the house and farm which he said had been his home for the first 26 years of his life. He was Ivan Chambers and was with his sister-in-law Kathy who was on holiday from New Zealand. We invited them and Ivan's wife Peggy to come to tea and they came with some lovely photo's of their young lives on the farm where Ivan's father was bailiff. They and Ivan's brother Richard were so generous with their photo's and we were delighted to have them. Sadly Ivan died soon after but Kathy and I still keep in touch.

Not long after Ivan died another man, a Canadian named David Murray, was taking photos over the gate and it turned out that his ancestors, the Wyles family. had once owned this farm, Darland Farm and Bredhurst Mill besides some other properties. We keep in touch as well and I was so pleased to tell him that I had found him a living relative besides some information and old photos of Bredhurst mill plus some of the photographs that Ivan had given and he sent a snap of his ancestors with lots of details of what had happened to the family after they sold up here and emigrated to Canada. The Wyles family were very big land and property owners in this area, in fact his uncle (or great-uncle) who was a builder had Wyles Street in Gillingham named after him.

A few years after David's visit Laurel Beechey, a cousin of David's, called to try and trace her ancestry. Neither of the cousins knew that the other had been on the same trail.

In November 1959 there was a terrible fire which destroyed a great many buildings close to the house. I tried to get a copy of the report of this for the Canadians but the records were destroyed in a flood at the local newspaper offices and the council archives copy would not print out.

During some alterations we discovered a partial skeleton of a cat in the fireplace and a little further into the room part of the skull of a foal. These of course were superstitious beliefs that the cat would keep evil spirits from entering the house via the

chimney and, I believe, the horse was thought to bring REPAIR OF ST MARGARET'S CHURCH, good fortune to the inhabitant. It is a pity that the flints RAINHAM are now covered and that the thatched sheds have disappeared but though thatch might look pretty it is not practical in modernfarming. It was so interesting while doing so many repairs and alterations to wonder Progress notes and photographs are being posted on about the people who had trodden the brick floors and worn them so well down in the doorways. What had their lives been like for it must have been quite a remote place in times past.

Nature Notes

NATURE NOTES FOR JULY

"Kent, Sir - everybody knows Kent - apples, cherries, hops and women".

"Pickwick Papers". Charles Dickens, 1812 - 1870. For the purposes of Nature Notes I want to amend Dickens' above list to "apples, cherries, hops and cobnuts." In this month's Notes I write about cherries and will cover the other three products of the Garden of England in subsequent Notes.

The scene often associated with rural Kent, and the one that frequently appears on calendars, is that of sheep grazing among the blossoms of a traditional cherry orchard. Two such orchards are at Church Farm, Church Lane, Stockbury and Denley Hill Farm, Seasalter Road, Graveney. But the one I am writing about this month is at Park Farm, Lynsted. The latter village is south of Teynham where Henry VII1's fruiterer, Richard Harrys, established a cherry orchard in the 16th century.

Owned by farmer Philip Neaves, the Lynsted orchard has been designated "Park Farm Community Cherry Orchard". "Blossom Day" is celebrated there towards the end of April, when local people picnic in the orchard amongst the blossom and the lambs. "Cherry Day" is held in July when the cherries are ripe and at their best. Finally, every Halloween, the villagers congregate around a large bonfire in the centre of the orchard; the children are entertained by a story teller and play at apple bobbing and other Halloween games. Last July, Mrs Ennis and I joined the people of Lynsted for "Cherry Day". Local families were picnicking under the trees and listening to the Sittingbourne Wind Assemble. Whilst the musicians had a break, the children of Lynsted and Norton Primary School danced around the maypole. Cream teas were on sale and visitors could take part both in cherry tasting and pick their own fruit. The trees in the orchard are 55 years old and are some 25 - 30 feet in height. Except for those on the lowest branches, the cherries have to be picked by means of traditional, tall fruit ladders which, for safety reasons, have splayed feet. Years ago, the vast majority of cherry pickers were women. Wives of farm labourers,

gypsies and people from nearby towns flocked to the Kentish orchards in June and July. Most of the cherry crop was bought by London wholesalers. Some farmers would auction the right to outsiders to pick and sell cherries from their orchards and gipsy families would usually be among the bidders. Auctions were held at the Bell Inn at Sittingbourne, among other places.

The Lynsted orchard has about thirteen different varieties of sweet cherry, most of which are red. although some are white. The trees produce fruit from the end of May to the beginning of August. The need for successful pollination is the main reason for having a great diversity of cultivars; traditional sweet cherries will only produce fruit if pollinated by a cherry of another variety. For the purposes of pollination, there are a number of bee hives in the orchard.

Most old orchards, be they of apple, pear, plum or cherry, provide a home for a broad range of plants and animals. The Lynsted orchard has a typical mixed pattern of trees, open spaces, mature hedges and permanent grassland grazed by sheep. The orchard attracts a range of birds, including chaffinch, goldfinch, mistle thrush, tree creeper, stock dove, turtle dove and wren. Green and greater spotted woodpeckers probe decaying tree stumps for invertebrates. Little owls are well established and tawny owls have been noted.

At cherry time some birds are not very welcome. Blackbirds, thrushes, woodpeckers, rooks and starlings are very fond of cherries and Philip Neaves (the farmer) maintains that the birds take his entire crop of Merton Favourite, despite the use of bird scarers which simulate gun shots. Sufficient to say that, on 'Cherry Day' itself, the activities of the local people drove away all birds but overflying wood pigeons.

As for mammals and insects in the orchard, surveys have revealed the presence of common shrew, wood mouse and the rarer vellow - necked mouse. These small rodents probably remain under cover in the hedgerows during the day and forage out in the orchard at night. Rabbits are abundant. Pipistrelle bats hunt flying insects in the gaps between the trees on warm summer evenings. Common field grasshoppers can be heard chirping in the orchard and stag beetle larvae are abundant in the fallen logs and dead wood.

As I always do whenever I visit the countryside, I took my binoculars with me to Lynsted. On this occasion they remained unused. I was quite content to do little more than sit in my folding chair, listen to the music, watch the maypole dancing and enjoy a cream tea - all in the shade of a spreading cherry tree.
