MEMORIES OF WIGMORE

Dear Editor

Having read your excellent publication about local places and incidents, there has not been very much about Wigmore and the Second World War, I would like to relate my experiences when living in this area.

I was living at 139 Wigmore Road, aged about 9 years when a bomb landed on a bungalow owned by Mrs Stone some three doors down from us. Mrs Stone had a small shop which sold various "bits and bobs". The bungalow was completely destroyed. She also lost THE BEST OF BRITISH - Old Time Music Hall and her aviary of budgerigars. Fortunately she was in her "Anderson Shelter" and was unhurt. The road at that time was unmade and used very little by vehicles. The side wall of 139 was completely blown out and the scars of the repair can still be seen today. I should add that my father, Jim Reed had a pig farm on the area which is now Kings Frith Park. There were several people keeping pigs on this area namely, Harry Foulds, Jack Carter and Joe Martin . How things have changed.

I also remember the invasion of Canadians, in massive lorries with bridge building parts in Wigmore Road just prior to the Invasion. I am sure that many of their hair down and "Wave Their Flags Down at the these brave men lost their lives. They only staved in this area for about 2 weeks during which time the local definitely encouraged!) For tickets, £7 each, please residents made them very much at home. I remember that the thing they wanted most was eggs, and the children raided a few hen houses for these for which we were rewarded with chocolate, something we all wanted at that time.

The second incident involved a new "Morris" car which was delivered from Strood Motor Company to my Father on a Thursday and was gutted by an incendiary bomb on the following Sunday at Hartley, near Longfield. The car was sold for £12 for scrap. That Sunday was when the Royal Air Force shot down Lower Rainham Road from Berengrave Lane to over 150 aircraft in one day and it marked the turning Pump Lane including Lower Bloors & Lower Pump. point in aerial warfare in the war.

We were living in rented property in Maidstone Road while 139 was repaired and my father purchased 178 Bredhurst Road with some extra land, and we moved in. One night there was an almighty bang and amid the dust we could see the stars through the roof. It transpired that an un-timed shell from "Gibraltar Guns" had landed on our house. Gibraltar guns were situated in the area where Elm Court Garden Centre is today.

Nature Notes

NATURE NOTES FOR AUGUST

Motorists travelling east along the A2 have their first sight of Canterbury Cathedral as they reach the top of Boughton Hill and commence their descent into the valley of the Great Stour. On their right they have a view of rolling hills, chestnut coppices, apple and pear orchards, fields of sheep and the white cowls of former oast houses. It is a view of one of the areas in Kent that can still claim to constitute the Garden of England. In August I visited two traditional apple orchards in the area, one at Chartham Hatch and one and Old Wives Lees.

I approached the first old orchard by means of a stretch of the North Downs Way as it skirts the edge of the recreation ground at Chartham Hatch. After a short walk through a chestnut coppice I arrived at "No Man's Orchard ", which is owned jointly by Harbledown and Chartham Hatch Parish Councils. A fading poster on a notice board showed that, in July, the local community had celebrated, apparently a little belatedly, the 60th anniversary of the planting of the orchard. The events included Morris dancing, a brass band, a wandering minstrel, food and drink (including a hog roast) and children's activities. It was a pity that I had missed the celebrations. The orchard is bounded on three sides by woodland and on the fourth by a field of sheep. It consists of eight acres of mainly Bramley Seedling apple trees which were planted in 1947. In recent years six cider apple varieties have been planted on a further two acres. A number of the Bramleys are now either dead or dying, which tends to give the orchard an appearance of neglect and dereliction. Some of the Bramleys that have died have been replaced by other traditional apple varieties, including Flower of Kent and Kentish Fillbasket. However, other dead trees have deliberately not been removed as they are a source of nesting holes for birds such as tawny and little owls, green, great spotted and lesser spotted woodpeckers, blue and great tits, starlings and nuthatches. The dead trees are also a home of beetles, grubs and other invertebrates, which provide food for the birds, particularly the woodpeckers. The trees as a whole, dead or alive, also

support a large number of lichens and mosses. The floor of the orchard seemed overdue for a mow. There were extensive patches of bramble, thistle, nettle and plantain. A pamphlet on the orchard claims that it is moved twice a year, after the wild flowers and grasses have dropped their seeds. On my own visit the only flowers I came across were buttercups although the pamphlet notes that cuckoo flower, or lady's smock, among other species, are found in the orchard.

Local people are allowed to pick the apples and I would like to think that, in the autumn and winter, many families tuck into apple tarts, pies and dumplings - all topped with lashings of creamy custard. Britain's infinite range of apple puddings and this country's preference for cooking apples with a tart taste almost certainly stems from the historically abundant variety of British apples, many of which were astringent. Britain remains the only country in the world where a culinary apple, Bramley's Seedling, is one of the best selling varieties on the market. Kent produces half of the country's output of Bramley apples: these are almost all grown, not on standard trees in traditional orchards, but on dwarf stock in the serried rows of commercial orchards.

Those apples in "No Man's Orchard" not taken for human consumption are eaten by blackbirds, starlings, redwings and fieldfares, particularly in harsh winters. Foxes, rabbits, badgers, stoats, slow worms and grass snakes are just some of the mammals and reptiles that have been seen in the orchard.

In due course I moved to Cork Farm apple orchard on the edge of Old Wives Lees. It also consists mainly of Bramleys and is likewise being conserved under DEFRA's Countryside Stewardship Scheme. Sheep were grazing there and so the floor of the orchard looked neat and tidy. It was consequently more photogenic than that at Chartham Hatch and was the epitome of a traditional Kentish apple orchard. The downside was that there were no wild flowers there. Growing on the adjoining roadside were marioram, scabious, knapweed and hedge woundwort, flowers which might have bloomed in

the orchard had it not been for the constant nibbling of the sheep.

Soon it was time for lunch in the picture postcard village of Chilham. As I climbed up the hill towards the village square I had two questions on my mind. Should I head for the White Horse Inn, the Woolpack Inn or the Copper Kettle Restaurant? And, here in the middle of the East Kent fruit belt, would there be apple crumble - topped with lashings of creamy custard - on the menu?

It is fair to say that most people in Rainham have been touched by its presence and ministry.

Well the Friends of St Margaret's Church was established in 1978 with its sole purpose being the restoration, preservation, repair, maintenance, improvement and beautification of the building and its grounds. The Friends are a diverse group of people who share this common goal and who offer an open door to all and you do not need to have any religious faith to join. been passed down to the people of Rainham. We, and we hope you, are now the stewards for our lifetime and it is our aim to pass this important landmark at the heart of Rainham on to future generations.

We know from the response to the Heritage Appeal that many of you are concerned that this historic building survives so please consider becoming a Friend. Individual Membership is just £12 per annum and Family Membership (two parents and children under 16 £25 per annum. Whilst existing to raise money for the fabric of the building we do hold various social events throughout the year to which all are welcome. 
