

I have for many years, probably since my children used to watch Blue Peter and follow their advice to the letter, fed the birds in our garden with peanuts, fat balls and seed between Christmas and Easter. We were able to watch a good selection of small birds with occasional added interest if a woodpecker arrived and of course the perennial dozen or so pheasant who clustered hopefully waiting for droppings. However this year we realised that actually the smaller birds also need help through the summer months, when they BREDHURST CAT ADOPTION CENTRE are feeding their fledglings, before the seeds are available on the vegetation. So we have continued all year providing fat balls and peanuts and have been rewarded with daily exhibitions from a variety of performers. It is not unusual to have a queue of sparrows lining up in the shrubs waiting their turn or a dozen or so all trying to feed at once, not very successfully. Occasionally a real bully flies in and won't allow anyone else near the food but the trouble is he is so busy attacking intruders he has no time to actually eat anything. The antics are a constant source of entertainment during daylight hours. My mother. who lives in Pump Lane, also used to enjoy watching the high jinks at her bird table but a few years ago the birds all but vanished and have never reappeared. One day on the annual bird survey weekend I remember her count for the hour watching was one pigeon and two aeroplanes flew overhead! We have a letter this month from a reader in Wigmore who reports the same thing, suddenly all the garden birds have vanished from her woodland. Can anyone explain why this should happen and how the birds can be encouraged to return. Putting feeders out has not helped in my mother's garden. It is such a shame as the display of feeding birds provides great free entertainment for all the housebound amongst us particularly those who spend much of the day alone. We include many Bazaars, Fairs and Sales in our pages this month to which you are invited and many have a 'Christmas' theme. As it is yet again, as I write, a beautifully sunny and relatively warm day, it is hard to imagine that Christmas is only two months away. Please do read on and decide which events you would like to support. All the organisers will be most appreciative of your presence. Have a good month, enjoy the sunshine whilst it lasts and we will see you again in December.

Nature Notes

NATURE NOTES FOR OCTOBER

This month's Nature Notes are based on a visit made to Knole Park, a National Trust property near Sevenoaks, in order to witness the rutting of the fallow younger bucks and round up any does that deer. The park was originally created in the 15th century, at the same time as Knole House itself. It enabled the owners to indulge in a passion, popular among the nobility, for hunting. Largely unchanged since the 17th century, Knole is now the only remaining mediaeval deer park in Kent. Readers may remember that the town of Sevenoaks lost six out of its celebrated seven oaks in the Great Storm of October 1987. Seventy per cent of the trees in Knole Park were also lost. Since that time. however, 200,000 replacement trees have been planted. Despite the losses, Knole retains hundreds of ancient oak, beech, sycamore and sweet chestnut trees whose leaves were turning brown or yellow at the time of my visit.

The entrance to Knole Park is in Sevenoaks High Street, opposite St Nicholas Church. The drive crosses a dry valley and then winds through woodland, the under storey of which consists mainly of bracken or heather. One of the "stands" where fallow deer bucks and does congregate during the rutting season is on Echo Mount, which overlooks the car park and Knole House itself.

During the rutting the bucks size up their competitors by walking alongside each other. Rival males can gauge each other's strengths by the size of their antlers. So any fights normally take place between stags of similar stature. However, it is the does who decide with which bucks to mate. They choose those capable of producing a continuous belching sound which is deep and resonant, since this shows that they have the necessary stamina to mate successfully with a succession of does. The stand on Echo Mount is dominated by a massive lime tree sporting several large clumps of mistletoe. Around the tree are saucer shaped scrapes in the soil created by the bucks, with their hoofs, as an expression of assertive behaviour. At the time of my visit the herd consisted of three

fully grown bucks, two smaller, immature bucks and fourteen does. One of the mature bucks was asleep in a muddy depression and the other two were strutting about, making the occasional belching sound. They would make what appeared to be half hearted attempts to drive off the attempted to wander off. After a while, since nothing exciting was happening, I myself wandered off. I decided to look out for fungi and other signs of autumn.

Knole Park has been designated a Site of Special Scientific Interest, specifically for its unimproved grassland and the invertebrates that can be found in dead wood. The grasses at Knole are generally low growing, partly because the underlying sandy soil is not very fertile and partly because they are under constant nibbling by rabbits and deer. I noticed that the many varieties of mosses and liverworts in the parkland stood out among the yellowing stalks of the grasses; they have an ever-fresh, bright green mantle in the cool dampness of autumn and winter. The National Trust at Knole appears to have a policy of not removing dead branches or dead trees and leaving fallen branches and trees where they lie, unless they are causing an obstruction. Consequently, it is quite common to see birds such as green and great spotted woodpeckers and nuthatches, which rely on dead wood for nesting sites or as a source of invertebrates for food. Spectacular displays of fungi, such as beefstake, bracket and honey fungi, can be found on the dead wood at Knole.

With few wildflowers in bloom, autumn is the time to search for plants and other organisms that tend to be overlooked at the height of summer. I therefore walked around the garden walls of Knole House which are built of Kentish ragstone and are pierced at intervals by fine wrought iron gates.

On the walls grow ferns such as wall rue and lichens. Some ferns, including bracken, die down in the autumn, but others are evergreen, lichen are an indication of clean air; the most noticeable ones are those consisting of a bright orange crust and found on walls and gravestones.

Soon it was time for a cup of tea and a cake in the

BOUNDARY STONES

The correspondence about the stone in Hempstead Road reminded me that there was a similar stone on Chatham Hill. In 1994 I took part in a sponsored walk round the boundaries of Gillingham in aid of the Mayor's Benevolent Fund, which visited this and several other stones. It is still there, on the northern side a few yards below the footbridge, but it is currently half-hidden by trailing ivy. The markings are quite clear: at the top is the date, 1899, then No.16, and finally GP for Gillingham Parish. Another similar stone stood beside the footpath that runs steeply west from the top of Pear Tree Lane to emerge in Capstone Road by Whitewall Farm, near the Ski Centre, but I could not find it when I searched in July.

Beating the bounds was an important ceremony ensuring that boundaries were clearly marked and familiar to the local inhabitants, for in the days before the welfare state parishes made sure that they only cared for their own poor. There is in the Archives at Strood a handwritten record of beating the bounds of Rainham in about 1840, and many of the places the party stopped at en route can still be recognised. On the western side of the parish their task was simplified because Gillingham Parish had erected stones at crucial points. One of these, in a back garden in Edwin Road, remains. Much older and more weathered than that on Chatham Hill, it has a 3-line inscription - G, then 16, then 1800. Perhaps when Ordnance Survey maps showing parish and other boundaries were published it was not found necessary to have so many markers, so new, renumbered, stones were erected only at strategic points. This would explain the number 16 at two completely different locations.

There is another older stone set into a gatepost on London Road (between Edwin Road and Tesco). but the inscription is now indecipherable. The owner of the house believes this to be the original 'Rainham Mark', and it lies on what the late Freddie Cooper believed to be the boundary between East and West Kent. Rosemary Dellar
