Editorial

A few weeks ago St Margaret's Church in Rainham held an extremely successful 'Big Open Day'. As I am sure everyone realises the church has been swathed in scaffolding for the past year whilst urgent repairs were clothes, good bric-a-brac, books etc to raise funds for undertaken to the roof. This is now finished but in order to make the best use of the scaffolding less urgent work to the tower has also been commissioned and this work continues, hence the need for the tower scaffolding to remain when the main body of the church was disrobed just in time for the Open Day. The idea was to thank the local community for their generosity in supporting the many appeals necessary to raise the half million needed for the repairs by showcasing all the many different aspects of church life in Rainham. I am sure the organisers spent hours planning and delegating and their efforts were rewarded by a crowded church and Millennium Centre showing a wide variety of displays. I know of several locals who were visiting the church for the first time despite having lived in Rainham most of their lives and I am pleased to say very much enjoyed the experience. I was stationed at the far eastern end in the St John the Baptist chapel guarding the local archive material on loan from the Strood centre. The stained glass above is variously called 'the Ward window' or 'the parable window'. It was designed by Francis Spear and depicts four parables (the rich man and Lazarus (sometimes called Lazarus and Dives), the good Samaritan, the sower and the talents, and has an inscription below, 'This window was given by George and Enid Ward of Caldew House in the parish in thankfulness for the safe return of their sons Dennis and Geoffrey from the World War 1939 -1945 and for many other mercies'. Several visitors after studying the window asked 'Where is Caldew House?' I had to confess I did not know and could only suggest it was probably in the Rainham Mark area as Caldew Avenue is there. I have now been told that Caldew House is behind the houses that line White Hill and is reached by a trackway between the new Football Centre on the Howard School field and the first house on the hill. Thank you to those who took the trouble to supply this information. It just shows we are all still learning. Our front cover drawing last month of Pump Farm vard has raised a great deal of interest. We will be including more on this area of Rainham in the coming months as space permits but as always after our longer

Please do read on to discover many opportunities to get out and about this month, concerts, plays, walks, fairs, coffee mornings they are all here for you to enjoy and before we know it April and spring will be here. SOUARE KNITS

During 2009 we took even more knitted goodies to Blythswood, thank you all for your efforts. 110 blankets, 429 tank tops and other items. We have patterns for hats, gloves, scarves and tank tops: if you would like a copy, send a sae (6"x 9") to Square Knits, c/o 21 Wheatcroft Grove, ME8 9JF. Instructions for blankets are as follows:-No. 8 needles, double knitting wool, cast on 30 stitches, and knit 60 rows, this may vary according to your tension. The squares are knitted in garter stitch - every row knit. Please make sure that your squares are 6"x 6" as we often sew up squares knitted by different people and different sizes cause problems! It is not necessary to change colours at the end of 60 rows, as long as the finished length is the equivalent of 10 squares or 60 inches long. It is appreciated if a few inches of wool is left at the end of a row for sewing up. 8 strips across makes a whole blanket. Do please phone us if you are delivering your knitting or if you would like it to be collected. We can however only collect from the Rainham, Wigmore and Hempstead areas. Nature Notes

NATURE NOTES FOR JANUARY & FEBRUARY I didn't stray far during January and February, paying local visits to Gore Farm, Darland Banks and East Hoath Wood.

Gore farm, at which there is a farm shop and a

restaurant, lies off Oak Lane, the road to Upchurch from the A2. Uniform rows of apple trees have replaced the mixed crops grown under the farm's previous ownership. It is good to see a Kentish fruit farmer fighting back against foreign imports but changes to the old order appear to have had a detrimental effect on certain wildlife. The grey partridges seem to have disappeared now that seed crops and cover are no longer provided for them. It also seems likely that the resident kestrels and barn owls may have trouble in finding enough voles and mice for their young, as a result of the close mowing of previously rough grassland in which the mammals would have been found. I was however pleased to see flocks of redwings, fieldfares, blackbirds and starlings feeding on the apples in the pick-vour-own orchard. Almost all of these birds would be winter visitors from northern and eastern Europe where winters are generally much more severe than in this country. I visited Darland banks at a time when it was covered in snow. The rather harsh "chack chack" alarm calls of fieldfares drew my attention to their presence. Parts of Darland are thickly covered in hawthorn bushes and the birds were after the red haw berries. Also feeding on the berries were five or six blackbirds. Many of our native born blackbirds are sedentary, not straying far from the garden or other habitat in which they have established a territory. During the winter our resident population of blackbirds is augmented by visitors from northern Europe. Some stay throughout the winter but others, after varying lengths of stay, move to southern France or Spain. It is almost certain that the group of blackbirds at Darland were winter visitors. Seed eating finches such as chaffinch, goldfinch,

linnet and greenfinch can be found on Darland Banks

in winter, feeding on seed heads. In the deep snow of

that day only the seeds of tall plants such as scabious

and knapweed would have been readily accessible to

them. Flocks of finches tend to be somewhat flighty and I was unable to identify the birds I had seen.

I moved on to nearby East Hoath Wood which is composed of sweet chestnut coppiced trees and oak standards. I could find few berries on the masses of ivy growing up the trees in the wood. They appeared to have been eaten by the wood pigeons which were conspicuous by their absence during the period when the area was white over. The birds would not have been able to forage on any nearby snow covered oil seed rape plants and may well therefore have flown to the fields of cabbages and Brussels sprouts on the Isle of Thanet.

As I walked through the wood my attention was drawn to rustling in an area of leaves sheltered from the recent snowfall. Up flew a small flock of redwings to the safety of the branches of an oak tree. They had been searching for worms, having undoubtedly exhausted the local supply of holly berries. They may have been the same birds that stripped the berries off a holly tree in my own garden in a matter of days. They were cautious birds, flying into the centre of the tree and eating the berries from the inside. They did not expose themselves to potential predators by perching on the outside of the

Finally, I write about our own gardens as a winter habitat for birds. We often put out nuts, seeds, fat balls or scraps and yet fail to attract any birds. However, in early winter, particularly if the weather is mild, birds may still have access to nuts, seeds, fruits and berries growing in woods, hedgerows, fields and gardens. Naturally occurring food such as grubs, insects, worms, slugs, snails, caterpillars and spiders, which the birds concerned presumably instinctively prefer, will be available until such time as heavy frost or deep snow make life difficult for them. Also birds are aware that they are vulnerable to predators such as cats and sparrow hawks at exposed bird tables, which is why they keep a constant look out whilst they are feeding. It is only in severe weather that some normally shy and cautious birds are driven by hunger to risk feeding in the open. It is not surprising that our overtures are sometimes rebuffed.

Here in well wooded Wigmore, woodland birds such

as great spotted woodpeckers, coal tits, great tits and nuthatches can sometimes be found at bird tables. At ground level visitors can include wood pigeons, green woodpeckers and jackdaws. Joe Ennis

RECOLLECTIONS OF RAINHAM

My wife Josie and I originally from London came to Rainham in 1969. We moved into a brand new Wards mid-terraced house in Meresborough Road on what was known then as the Maryland Estate. The estate was a group of houses bordered by Miers Court Road, Meresborough Road and Bayswater Drive. There was another housing estate adjoining ours to the south with houses either side of Sandringham Road. These two small estates were surrounded by woodland and orchards all the way down to the High Street with none of Parkwood housing as we now know it. For about a year I travelled backwards and forwards to work in London before getting a job locally. My journey from home in my commuting days went past the old well the remains of which is still on the original part of Miers Court Road that has since been blocked off. Miers Court Road was nothing more than a narrow lane then with no bus service and very little traffic. A footpath towards the High Street end

from an area known locally as Monkey Island cut through the orchards and linked to another footpath, Church Path, that is still there today - this was the route I took, then across the High Street past the National School, (demolished 30 years ago) in Station Road, where the shopping centre now stands, and on down to Rainham railway station. The station was nothing like it is today. It was a brick built building with a slate roof and I remember many a time in the winter going into the waiting room, where a welcoming coal fire was burning, to get warm. The gents toilet was separate to the main building and was no more than a wall for you to use with no roof to keep you dry if it was raining. Also the platforms were much shorter than they are now. I travelled home from work using Victoria Station in London and if the train was a long one you had to get in the rear four carriages of the train to alight at Rainham. This was because the platform at Rainham was not long enough for the entire train. I remember in my first few weeks of travelling getting in the wrong end and finishing up at Sittingbourne before realising that I had missed Rainham.

That was some thirty years ago now and since 1977 I have lived in Silverspot Close and my house stands roughly half way down that footpath that led from Miers Court Road to Church Path. All the many times I walked along it those years ago I never ever dream't of houses being built there let alone living in one.
