In 1927 when official discussions began about the long suggested idea of Rainham become part of the Borough of Gillingham opinion was divided. The long time residents valued their links with Milton Rural District Council, Faversham Constituency and the Diocese of Canterbury. However the parish had grown steadily during the past few years and the newcomers were anxious for the improvements that Gillingham promised. Main drainage, electricity, Council houses and secondary education were all lacking in Rainham at that time and Milton had few resources to supply them. The vote in 1928 provided a victory for amalgamation and so Rainham was incorporated into the Borough of Gillingham on Easter Monday April 1st 1929. Those still smarting from the lost vote felt this was an appropriate date! However the residents did manage to rebut the final indignity when the railway company proposed re-naming Rainham Station 'Gillingham East'. Now I see we are to be known by the travelling public by this much disliked name. The hoardings surrounding the new Premier Inn construction site on the Manor Farm Restaurant ground at the junction of Maidstone Road and the A2 proudly proclaim the coming of the new 'Gillingham-East A2' Inn. Admittedly Rainham can be confused with our namesake across the river (occasionally we have received phone calls from a puzzled delivery driver unable to find Station Road as he was attempting to deliver our goods in Essex) but what is wrong with 'Rainham, Kent A2' The owners of the restaurant did not endear themselves to many of us when they gave the building a makeover in the spring of 2003 completely obliterating the attractive brick work detail of the original structure. PUMP FARM

Dear Editor,

I read with great interest Stan Randall's article on Pump Farm in Action Forum No 451 (January 2010) as I was brought up at the farm, spending most of my time whilst mum was fruit picking, with granddad and nan (Pop and Sue Smith) who ran the farm from 1930. They had previously been at Little London Farm in Twydall and before that at Forresters Lodge Farm at Boughton although they were both from Dargate originally. Their eldest son Alfred who was mentioned by Stan was my dad. I was born in 1946 when he returned from North Africa via Messina, North Italy and a six week spell circling the Bay of Biscay - the whole boat was quarantined due to Smallpox - before returning to RAF Detling Aerodrome. After this experience Dad hated boats, even channel ferries were not an option.

I used to spend many a day with my dad in his beloved AEC Mammoth Major 8 wheeler fleet No 6 lorry mainly carrying reels of paper from Aylesford Paper Mill. One trip I remember in particular was four days including going through the first Mersey Tunnel to Odhams Press, Liverpool where they printed The Eagle comic. Later the company became British Road Services and Dad and his mate Tommy Knight had brand new vehicles, the pride of the fleet but they were all eventually relocated to the Aylesford depot. Pump Farm was used by several firms before becoming the home of Sommers and then King's Ferry Coaches.

Dad went to BRS Strood and later drove for me as by then I had a few lorries. He retired in 1980 and died Last year we were pleased to raise nearly £500 for the in 1987. He never had an accident throughout his working life and was one of the old school - never late, never got lost and drove every vehicle perfectly. Many of the Medway Transport drivers were from Rainham, Frank Westaway, Freddie Moore (Dad taught him to drive), Geoff Styles, Tommy Cresser, Geoff Lewis, Frank Ackerill, Bill Ford, Don Clark and Ray Hatton (whose niece Carole is now my wife) spring to mind.

When I first started with my lorries (Terry A Smith Transport) I parked them at Pump Farm but the new style of transport articulated and heavier vehicles meant I needed to move to larger premises. After Kings Ferry Coaches moved from Pump Farm the bulldozers arrived and everything was flattened including the oast house, agricultural buildings and a grade II listed cottage. Speaking to the developers I was asked to suggest a name for the new road. I answered it could only be Pop Smith Close or Cherry Farm but these were obviously not acceptable so it became Russett Farm and I fully agree with Stan they could at least have spelt it correctly (ie Russet).

Nature Notes

NATURE NOTES FOR JUNE

This month's article is partly based on notes that I took, as surreptitiously as I could, whilst watching a performance of "Midsummer Night's Dream", in the grounds of Leeds Castle, on a glorious summer's

With time to spare before the performance, my wife and I took a stroll around the castle's Culpepper Garden, which is the epitome of a large English cottage garden. Flower beds are arranged in an informal pattern with low box hedges as borders and, in summer, the garden is a profusion of scent and colour. During our visit there was a buzz of bees about the place. Roses were in full bloom and one particular variety caught our attention. It was "Rosa Mundi", a sweetly smelling shrub rose of a very pale pink colour with crimson stripes. Known since the 16th century, Shakespeare may well have had it in mind when he wrote that " ... a rose by any other name would smell as sweet."

We then sat down in the Italian Garden overlooking the Great Water. The garden is rich with Mediterranean and sub-tropical plants which provide flowers throughout the year. On or by the side of the Great Water was a large flock of mute swans and a smaller flock of black swans. House martins were feeding on insects in the air above the lake and calling to each other as they did so. Beyond the lake, sheep were grazing in parkland dotted with oak and sweet chestnut trees. A hot air balloon was rising into a clear blue sky criss-crossed with vapour trails.

In due course we made our way towards the venue for the 7.30 pm performance - the lawn in front of the former tennis pavilion. The setting was ideal, beside the diminutive River Len and surrounded by weeping willow, alder and other trees. We settled down in our seats in front of a portable booth stage of the type used in Shakespeare's day by actors on tour. Sitting on the grass immediately in front of the stage were two groups of school children who, it is pleasing to report, remained interested and attentive throughout the performance.

The evening got off to a good start when I noticed a

spotted flycatcher emerging from its presumed nesting site in the wisteria in front of the tennis pavilion. It joined its mate at the top of an alder tree from which both parents sallied forth, caught a passing insect, and then returned to their perches. Once they had a mouthful of insects they flew to their nest, undeterred and undisturbed by the players and their appreciative audience.

The wood pigeon is now one of this country's commonest birds and their display flight is accordingly a common sight during summer. I watched a couple of pigeons rising in an arc, clapping their wings and gliding down on bowed wings. The clapping sound is caused by a whiplash effect. Through the trees, I caught sight of a group of swifts scything and screaming though the evening air. The bird song all around me was a reminder that the breeding season was not yet over. I heard blackbirds, chaffinches and song thrushes, one of the latter singing until sunset.

By the second half of the play, after the picnic interval, the sun had long since disappeared below the trees and it was becoming cooler. I could hear jackdaws as they flew overhead on the way to their woodland roost, which they probably shared with the local rooks. As the evening light began to dim, the electric lights on the front of the stage started to attract moths and other insects, none of which I could readily identify. Not long ago it was common to find moths such as the garden tiger and magpie in gardens or coming to lighted windows, even in towns. But a combination of adverse effects on them has greatly reduced their numbers in recent years. Moths are important pollinators and are a key source of food for many species of bats.

The grounds of Leeds Castle are, in fact, one of the best places in the South East of England to see pipistrelle, daubenton and serotine bats, which roost during the day in the old buildings and trees within the grounds. They feed, largely after dusk, over the moat and the Great Water, in the woodland glades and over the grassland areas. The rustic tennis pavilion serves as a day roost for quite a number of bats. However, we failed to see a single bat during our sojourn on the lawn and Mrs Ennis showed no enthusiasm for a bat hunt, elsewhere on the estate,

before we went home.

So, the bats were nothing to write home about. But what about the Shakespeare? "Midsummer Night's Dream" is, of course, a comedy and the actors and actresses of the Globe Theatre on Tour, dressed in summer clothes of the 1920s, gave an enjoyable and amusing performance. It was an appropriate choice of play for a warm, mid summer's evening on the lawn and among the trees.

THE JEZREELS TOWER part 2

(continued from June 2010)

Although he firmly believed in his own immortality, James Jezreel died at the age of 45 in 1885 and is buried in the Grange Road Cemetery. His funeral was attended by more than 4000 people. After his death Clarissa was proclaimed Queen Esther the Virgin and Mother of Israel but the group became troubled. In particular one American, Noah Drew, a wealthy landowner had sold everything so that he and his family could follow Jezreel to England and now found themselves in abject poverty. Drew publicly denounced the sect and told all who would listen his grievances. His ranting encouraged a crowd of some 500 people who set upon a group of Jezreelites who were marching through New Brompton. The incident needed Police reinforcements to disperse the crowd and drew the attention of the London newspapers.

Oueen Esther was not immortal either and she died in 1888 aged 28 of kidney disease. Buried in Grange Road her funeral was only attended by 40 people highlighting the decline in popularity of the group. After her death it was revealed to the sect that although £30,000 had been spent on building the Tower, another £30,000 was needed for completion. In addition contactors were owed a great deal of money, This was thought to be the reason why death had come to Jezreel and his wife as they were obviously unsuitable to be taken to Heaven in the final gathering.

In 1897 the Tower and surrounding land was put up for sale but it was 6 years before a buyer could be found. With falling numbers the sect fell behind with the rent and in 1905 the owners ordered the demolition of the Tower. Attempts were made to liquidate the materials but so well built was the Tower that these attempts failed with contractors

made bankrupt. The iron and steel frame was cut out by Hall & Sons of Rochester who were declared desecrators of a Holy place. Strange to say, that soon after Mr. Hall died adding to theories that all who tried to bring the Tower down were doomed!

The whole site was purchased by the Cooperative Society in 1920 and the Canterbury Street buildings were converted into shops and a shoe repair factory. A painting was made of the Tower by Tristram Hillier in 1937 which now hangs in the Tate. During WWII the Tower was used as a fire plotting point and a broadcasting station. The Canterbury Street buildings were finally demolished in 2008 after years of dereliction. The Tower was eventually raised to the ground in 1961 and became the site of the Jubilee clip factory. However, as before, misfortune accompanied its destruction when a worker on the site was killed.

It is interesting to note that one of Jezreels followers Benjamin Purnell and his wife Mary went on to found one of America's most famous communal societies 'The Israelite House of David'.
