It still leaves 3 unknown girls if anyone else has any ideas.

Nature Notes

NATURE NOTES FOR JULY

Over two years ago I reported on a late winter visit to Oare Marshes Nature Reserve, which is near Faversham and owned by Kent Wildlife Trust. This month, by way of contrast, I write about the reserve in early summer. It consists of grazing marsh, open water scrapes created by the Trust and dykes of both brackish and fresh water. We drove through the village of Oare and along Harty Ferry Road. We parked our car near the former Watch House of HM Customs and Excise, just below the sea wall, from where we intended to take a circular walk around the eastern half of the reserve.

From the top of the wall we had uninterrupted views in all directions. We could see the new Swale Crossing, Harty Ferry Inn, Harty Church, Shellness, Whitstable, Faversham Church and the North Downs. A Thames sailing barge, with red ochre sails, was proceeding very slowly along The Swale. Billowing white clouds floated in the wide, blue sky. It was a perfect summer's day.

We set off along the sea wall in the direction of Whitstable. Below us, on the landward side, were the reed beds of one of the dykes that line the reserve. Those that are fed by fresh water from a spring are recognisable by the profusion of common and lesser reed mace (commonly called bulrush) and common reed, whilst a characteristic of the brackish dykes is the presence of sea club rush. Common reed is, of course, the nesting habitat of reed warblers, whose sharp "tac" calls we heard during our visit. Marsh frogs, grass snakes and dragon flies also inhabit the dykes. Merlins will take dragon flies, as well as small birds. We kept our eyes open, but we were not lucky enough to see one of these delightful little falcons.

From the hide overlooking Faversham Creek we had a distant view of Hall Sands in the middle of The Swale. Exposed at low tide, they were about a mile away from where we stood. Through our binoculars we could just make out a group of seals hauled up on the sands. We assumed that they were common seals. These mammals feed at sea, but regularly haul out

onto inter-tidal sandbanks in order to rest, to give birth and to suckle their pups. Female common seals give birth to a single pup in June or July each year. The young are very well developed at birth and can swim and dive when just a few hours old. This enables the seals to breed in estuaries where sand banks are exposed for only part of the day. We followed the sea wall alongside Faversham Creek, on the waters of which were two shelduck followed by a line of ten ducklings. The latter would probably have been hatched down a nearby, disused rabbit hole. On the mudflats of the creek were beds of a pernicious hybrid plant called cord grass. It has become quite dominant throughout North Kent, to the exclusion of many native salt marsh plants. Even so, on the higher parts of the foreshore we spotted sea aster, sea lavender, sea wormwood and golden samphire, among the more common sea purslane.

Having turned inland, we arrived at the East Hide, which is wheelchair accessible, and which gives a very good view of the birds in or around the shallow water scrape known as East Flood. We could see, among other birds, avocet, oyster catcher, ringed ployer, garganev and shoveller. But the birds that were there in their hundreds were black tailed godwits. These waders were still in breeding plumage, having just nested in Iceland. They were passing through this country, on their way south, perhaps to the Iberian Peninsular or Africa. Beef cattle were feeding on the remnants of the grazing marsh surrounding the East Flood. The tussocky grassland that their grazing produces is an idea! nesting habitat for redshank, lapwing, yellow wagtail, skylark and meadow pipit.

Whilst walking down Harty Ferry Road, on our way back to the car, we spotted a little grebe (or dabchick) on her floating nest in a dyke on the other side of the roadside fence. She was totally unconcerned about the attention she was receiving, being clearly used to bird watchers. Visitors can view the eastern half of the reserve without getting out of their cars, this being very useful for visitors with disabilities or when the weather is bitterly cold. Roadside information boards have been set up for those who need help

As co-editor of the Doctor Who magazine Nothing at the End of the Lane (www.nothing-lane.co.uk) and a resident of Rainham for over 30 years (now in Lordswood!), I was fascinated to see Sheila Ralph's letter and photograph in November's Action Forum, about the Daleks visit to the fete at Wakeley Road Junior School in the 1960s!

Sheila had thought the fete may have been in 1964, but a quick look at the photograph showed that it must have been later. In their first two appearances in Doctor Who, the Daleks had two plain metal bands around their middle, where the sucker arm and gun are. For their third appearance, the design was changed to the vertical slats (supposedly solar panels). The production of this story, called *The* Chase, didn't finish recording until 4 June 1965, so the fete would have to have been after that, as the BBC wouldn't have allowed their Daleks to go anywhere until then. After ploughing through the Chatham Standard and the Chatham, Gillingham & Rochester News for 1965 at the Medway Archive, it's been possible to positively identify the Wakeley Road fete that Sheila attended as being held on Saturday 17 July 1965, with the

A month prior to their appearance at Wakeley Road, the Kent Messenger brought four Daleks and a model spaceship to Chatham Town Hall on 17 & 18 June 1965 before transferring them over to the Maidstone Corn Exchange the following week (21-23 June). It would be very interesting to find anyone who has photographs of these appearances or can supply the date of a fete at Parkwood Junior School, which was opened by the Daleks creator, Terry Nation who brought along a couple of Daleks. Next, when we first moved to Rainham, we lived in Chart Place and everyday on my walk to school, I passed the Southern Water reservoir at the top of Maidstone Road (next to Lime Court) which had an old concrete Police Box perched on top of its grassy bank. It was there for a good few years, but I never understood how it got there in the first place. Does anyone know?

Finally, Doctor Who was filmed a few times in the Medway area - at the Berry Wiggins plant in Hoo in 1970, at the caves at Stonehouse Farm, Frindsbury in 1972 and onboard the decommissioned Royal Fleet Auxiliary ship, Robert Dundas at Chatham Dockyard also in 1972. If anyone has any photographs or cine footage of filming taking place, I'd love to know!
