

The gardening bug has been passed on to our children who all grow some vegetables, making use of pots to compensate for lack of garden. They also like to go away with full veggie boxes whenever they visit of course!

# Nature Notes

NATURE NOTES FOR SEPTEMBER

In early September I walked to Hartlip across the fields from Moor Street. Beyond Spade Lane the footpath ran through a recently harvested wheat field. I put up a large flock of wood pigeons which rose into the air with a loud clapping of wings. They would have alerted any other birds, such as any partridges, feeding on the stubble. If there were any of our native grey partridges in the field they would have squatted down, out of sight, until I had passed by. Any red legged partridges present, being quite bold in character, would have either walked or trotted away from me. But I did not notice either species. The corn is packed so tightly in corn fields these days that very few wild flowers manage to flourish. Once the crop has been cut, however, wild flowers that have survived any herbicides that may have been applied can grow up quickly. These may include scented mayweed (white flowers), field pansies (creamy white), scarlet pimpernel (bright orange-red), field speedwell (blue) and field forget-me-not (blue). Flowers such as corn cockle, corn marigold and cornflower, which were considered pernicious weeds by the farmer and miller, are now but a distant memory for most people. They have generally disappeared because of a combination of herbicides and more effective seed cleaning by modern combined harvesters. However, the corn cockle (which has bright pink flowers with dark streaks) can be found in the corn regularly grown in Kitchen Field at Ranscombe Farm near Cuxton, which is jointly owned by Medway Council and Plantlife International, This field is believed to be the only field in the UK where corn cockle still grows in the wild.

A corn field flower that has survived in much greater profusion is the common poppy. It can still be regularly seen in the light, chalky soils below the escarpment of the North Downs. Last year corn fields between the bottom of Blue Bell Hill and Boxley were a solid mass of red. The farmer told me that he had not seen so many poppies in the 44 years that he had been farming. Many of the flowers were purple opium poppies which were last legally grown as a crop in the

1830s and the purple variety had therefore grown from seed sown some 180 or more years ago. The farmer told me that he has planted opium poppy seeds in his garden but they revert to the red colour after a while. So the large numbers of opium poppies of last year were not from seeds of poppies that had been growing in those fields in recent years. I continued on my walk to Hartlip and, upon reaching Dane Lane, the distinctive autumnal smell of fallen poplar leaves was very evident. I came across further evidence of autumn as I walked down Dane Lane in a semi-circular direction towards Hartlip Church - the fruits of elderberry, dog rose, hawthorn, bramble, holly and damson, in varying stages of maturity. At the church Iych-gate I reflected on the institutions that still exist for the use of the villagers. Apart from the church, there is a Methodist Chapel, a C of E Primary School, a public house and a village hall. At one time both a parson and a vicar lived in the parish, as is evidenced by the "Old Parsonage" and the "Old Vicarage", both imposing buildings. Today the vicar of Hartlip is shared with Stockbury, Upchurch, Lower Halstow, Iwade and Newington and lives in a modest, modern house in Newington.

I recommenced my walk along The Street and made a short diversion to the site of the allotments next to the village hall. Here were growing potatoes, leeks, runner beans and tomatoes, among other crops, and there were very colourful displays of dahlias and chrysanthemums. Just after the Methodist Chapel I turned right into Place Lane. At Place Farm I noted a number of pheasants scratching around for food as nonchalantly as farmyard chickens. They had clearly been raised domestically and were destined for the pot once the shooting season began in the autumn. Across the road I picked out, with my binoculars, a covey of eight red legged partridges feeding among the stubble along the edge of a field of maize, which I assume had been planted as cover for game birds. Observations made during this walk and previous ones showed that, unlike our own parish of St Margaret's, that of St Michael, Hartlip remains almost totally rural. The hop fields have gone but there are apple, pear, plum and cherry orchards. Our neighbouring parish can, I think, still claim to be part

Editor: After we published the picture of Wigmore Evangelical Free Church on the front of our August edition Phill Firmin, a member of the Church, emailed the following interesting article which was first published in a local paper in the late 1940s.

EFFORTS OF WIGMORE FREE-CHURCH EVANGELISTS

One of the few pre-fabricated churches in the country, the Wigmore Evangelical Free Church at Durham Road, Rainham, which was opened by the Mayor of Gillingham (Alderman P J. Bruce) last week, consists of three ex Army wooden huts erected in the shape of a "T."

Behind the opening of this unique building for worship, is a story of perseverance and faith which goes back to 1942.

The secretary, Mr. R. Jewell of 127, Marshall Road, Rainham, who is a Baptist had to travel several miles to his nearest church near the Shaldars Arms. Gillingham, until he and his wife decided in 1942 to hold services at their home.

"We had 10 people at our first service but we had many more afterwards," Mr. Jewell told our

He went on to explain that two years ago it was decided to start raising money for some sort of building in the district, but the chief difficulty had been the finding of suitable huts.

After 12 months' correspondence with the Army authorities we still could get nothing, and then a friend saw an advertisement in. the "Kent Messenger" advertising three huts for sale near Cranbrook.

They originally belonged to Dulwich College for evacuation purposes, and then, they had been taken over by the Army.

"They were transported to Durham Road last autumn where they were re-erected, lined with fireproof material and re-decorated." Mr. Jewell said.

The church has electricity for heating and lighting. The centre section which comprises two of the huts, measures 60ft. by 15ft., and there is seating accommodation for 150, although at the opening. there were many more than that number present, and chairs had to be brought in from St. Matthews Church.

Mr. Jewell said that the building had cost £1,600

and so far £600 had been raised from bring-and-buy sales and gifts. After the Mayor had officially opened the church door, he entered the church, followed by the congregation. A service was conducted by the Rev. S. A. Hart, of West Norwood.

Tea was served afterwards, at which the Rev. F.W. Jordan (vicar of Rainham) and local Nonconformist ministers were present.

"We have no resident minister at the Church yet, but we have local preachers, and I shall probably help out." Mr. Jewell said with a smile of achievement.

Sunday School classes have been started and the church has its own hymn books.

Organist is Mrs. Spurge, who is over 80. Footnote: This was originally a newspaper article circa 1946 and we know Mr Jewell went to be with our Lord on the 4th April 1950. Unfortunately we do not know which newspaper but intend to give credit once and if resolved. If any reader can help with this enquiry please contact us.


