

Russells, once a farmhouse, was an attractive, elegant building. The site is now Sutton Close and part of Scott Avenue. In the 1950s this was the home of the Quinnell family as Colin Macgregor recalls in the final part of his 'Trip Down Memory Lane' on page 9. George Quinnell had six children all of whom at some time worked in his prosperous grocery business next to The Green Lion (by 1955 this had become Vye & Sons). In earlier years the family was noted for its social work in the village. Mr Quinnell served on the Council having the distinction of a road being named for him as one of the first elected councillors when Rainham left Milton Rural District to join Gillingham in 1929.



Walking has long been considered a beneficial activity not just for the body but also for the mind. Less than a hundred years ago no one would have needed the advice to get out and walk more, walking was an essential part of life. True the railway had arrived in Rainham in 1858 immediately opening up travel prospects previously unknown. This became even easier with the arrival of the trams to Chatham in 1906. Later local buses took passengers to more rural destinations but walking still took up a fair part of each day. Travel on public transport was expensive, the penny fare to Chatham may seem insignificant to us but for a family existing on a farm workers wage it would have been a definite consideration so you walked. For the past few years we have been making a conscious effort to take more exercise, consequently several times a week I walk from Meresborough to Rainham to and from work but it is a fair weather pastime! Yet I know in the 1930s the children who lived in our house did the same walk four times a day, coming home for lunch and returning for afternoon school, whatever the weather, from the age of 5. Perhaps rising costs and shrinking budgets will prompt a return to this more healthy lifestyle and families will leave the car on the driveway and walk to school or work. I must admit I find it difficult to make myself just go out for a walk – there is always something else I should be doing – but a walk with a purpose is different. The experienced readers will see where this is going! One walk with a purpose we can recommend and encourage is the monthly door to door distribution of Action Forum. A combination of circumstances means we have several rounds for which we need willing volunteers in various parts of our distribution area, a list is on page 3. If you are able to spare one or two hours during the first week of the month and would enjoy the walk please do get in touch (01634 310011or email af@thenet.uk.net). Even if there is no round mentioned near you at the moment it is useful to know of willing volunteers as with over a hundred helpers it is a constantly changing list and each month we have people on holiday or not able to help so a reserve list is very useful. Alternatively you can always join one of the healthy walking groups which offer short walks once a week from a variety of meeting points. For longer expeditions check our diary for the local footpaths and ramblers groups outings.

Speaking of walking if you have been along any road or street recently you have probably noticed the coloured blobs which now decorate many water stopcock covers. One reader was intrigued so emailed Southern Water to find an explanation. She had worked out that ultramarine blobs mean 'no meter', and no blob at all presumably means that they are happy with the present meter but could not determine the difference between yellow and turquoise. Although they didn't give details of what each colour meant, they explained

'Southern Water is changing the way it supplies and bills customers. Between 2010 and 2015 it aims to install meters to almost all the homes it supplies, and to change customers to metered charges. Our metering teams are currently working in the area. As well as fitting meters to properties currently unmetered, we are also replacing some older existing meters.' They will soon be in a road near you. Do enjoy the rest of our belated summer and make the most of any fine days we have. All too soon we will be battening down the hatches for winter. Have a good month. We will see you again in November.

# Nature Notes

NATURE NOTES FOR SEPTEMBER

This month's Nature Notes record a trip on the Romney, Hythe and Dymchurch Railway from Hythe to Dungeness, along the seaward edge of the Romney Marsh. The railway's steam locomotives are restricted to a speed of 25 mph, but because they are only one third full size, and passengers are relatively low to the ground, the ride is quite exhilarating. Our view from the windows of our carriage was one of a flat landscape of fields surrounded by dykes and sewers. Some of the fields were dotted with round bales of straw, evidence of a recently harvested wheat crop. On other fields scattered sheep grazed. The Kentish ragstone towers of the mediaeval churches at Burmarsh and Newchurch were picked out in the sunshine. In the distance were the hills that formed the coastline before the marshes were claimed from the sea. Pairs of swans, some with families of well-grown cygnets, swam serenely in the dykes, which were lined with common rush and the flowers of water mint and meadow sweet. Coots, water hens and little grebes, clearly used to the passing of trains, went about their usual business. Dragonflies and damselflies were in evidence, the most noticeable being male banded demoiselle damselflies with their striking dark blue bodies.

Our first stop was at Dymchurch, which is a traditional, charming seaside village, very popular with families with young children. As we continued our journey we noted flocks of rooks, jackdaws and lapwings feeding or resting in the fields. We also caught a glimpse of a looker's hut, about the same size and shape as a garden shed, with red brick walls and a peg tile roof. Men who looked after sheep during the lambing season lived in them. At one time, over 300 lookers' huts were scattered across the marshes. The men would be visited at weekends by their wives and children who would bring traditional lookers' pies which could be reheated in the fireplaces in the huts. They were made of lamb cutlets, onions and potatoes and had a suet

Our next stop was the small, wayside station just a few minutes walk from the extensive sands of St Mary's Bay. Between the latter and New Romney, on the seaward side of the line, is The Warren, an area of sand dunes occupied largely by Littlestone Golf Links. Three species of rare animals can be found in the area. Ponds, especially those on The Warren, are the breeding sites of great crested newts. The dykes of the marshes are one of the

strongholds of the water vole in the South East and are also the home of medicinal leeches which feed on the blood of frogs, water fowl and livestock

At Greatstone-on-Sea the dark earth of the Romney Marsh gave way to the shingle of the Dungeness National Nature Reserve. The marsh flowers in turn gave way to those of the shingle - viper's bugloss and yellow homed poppy, among others. Until the latter part of the 19th century, Dungeness remained a remote place, untouched and rarely visited by outsiders because of the incidence of so called marsh fever, in reality malaria. Indeed, until comparatively recently, it could be said to be one of the last truly natural landscapes in the British Isles. However, in the 20th century, considerable damage was done to the shingle ridges and the plants and animals associated with them. The building of holiday dwellings and two nuclear powers stations, military use. and water and gravel extraction have taken their toll on the unique ecology of the peninsular.

The train entered onto the Dungeness Estate upon reaching the Pilot Inn. We passed wooden cottages, some still lived in by fishermen's families and others by weekenders. Fresh and smoked fish can be bought at Dungeness and sea fishing trips can be undertaken. Some visitors may consider that unrestricted building in the 1930s has resulted in a scene which looks somewhat of a shambles. However, the late Derek Jarman, who built a famous garden around his weekend cottage, was very fond of what he described as the 'otherworldly atmosphere' of Dungeness.

We alighted from the train at Dungeness Station and, after a cup of tea in the Light Railway Cafe, took a leisurely stroll around. On the ground we came across wheatears and pied wagtails, in the gorse bushes linnets, in the air migrating swallows and house martins and, on the roof ridge of a cottage, a row of herring gulls. We climbed up the spiral staircase of the old light house from where we had views of Beachy Head in one direction and South Foreland Light House in the other. All too soon it was time to return to Hythe. We settled ourselves into a carriage with a party of jolly visitors from the Netherlands. They seemed to have enjoyed themselves ... and so had we.

#### A TRIP DOWN MEMORY LANE Part 3

Continued from September 2011

Crossing Station Road we past The White Horse public house, closed at this time of the day, licensing hours on Sunday lunch time were 12 noon til 2pm, the pub is still there but it has seen many changes inside since 1955. After The White Horse, we came to the Co op stores now demolished and The Rainham Healthy Living Centre constructed on the land. There was a hall above the Co op where a couple of years earlier in 1953 a big party for us kids was held for the Coronation. It's nice to see that the old Palm tree is still at the side of the new building. I can recall looking at this tree from my school in Station Road from when I was five years old. Hutchinson's Plant Nursery was behind the Co op. Next we came to Bardens, a Greengrocers shop now The Olive Tree Restaurant, Mr Bridges big house The Old Parsonage was next, I remember him and his children riding their horses out of the stables there. This building is now a fitness centre.

We walked on past The Old Parsonage to the Post Office, I believe that there were some buildings before this that later became The Post Office Sorting Office which itself has been demolished to make way for Apple Tree Court. Passing the Post Office we would walk by Cross the Jewellers, Webbs the Drapers and Mills Outfitters coming to Mountains solicitors on the corner of Ivy Street.

We would cross Ivy Street and pass Oldlands Florists which is now a Tattooist and then to Greens Newsagents. Although this is now a Hairdresser you can still see the old Newsagents sign sticking out from the wall above the window. Eddie Stone turf accountant and P Duff opticians (now opposite Orchard Street) occupied the next two premises. We would then cross Pudding Road coming to Jelly's Outfitters I think this is now Hons Chinese Restaurant. Walking on we would pass D Peek photographer, Tuckers Watch Repairers, G W Elphick a sweet shop and then come to Mr Quinnell's beautiful mansion (Russells) in its grounds. The house has sadly long been demolished to make way for town houses and flats. The road that I lived in was named after Mr Quinnell who owned a grocery

business next to The Green Lion and was also, I believe, a local councillor.

Following Mr Ouinnell's house we would reach Scott Avenue. Many of my school friends lived in this road in the pre fabricated flat roofed houses that have since been replaced by modern homes. We crossed the entrance to Scott Avenue passing Gilberts Builders and Panda Press coming to The British Legion now called The United Services Club. Then we would pass a few more shops [Editor: from Kelly's Directory 1957 - William Swan general stores, Frederick Howard secondhand furniture, Mrs B Bibby draper] the last one being The Chocolate Box.

We would cross the main road here to Mierscourt Road and the farm was just a short way up the road on the right.

It was now time to walk back home with the milk but that journey is to be told another time. I'm sure many of you who read this article will remember some of the people and places that I have

mentioned and I am sure that I will have missed a few and apologise in advance. I hope you enjoyed my trip down Memory Lane in old Rainham.


