Rainham Recreation Ground in the early 1900s. The land between Station Road and Scott Avenue was acquired in the late 1880s when the local Cricket and Football clubs needed permanent grounds. After lengthy negotiations with various worthy Rainham citizens and landowners 21 acres were purchased and seven donated in perpetuity to the Parish and vested in the trustees names (the Vicar, Charles Cobb, the overseers and the Guardians of the Parish)the remainder were sold. A gate at the entrance, which was locked at night, was inscribed 'Donated in commemoration of Queen Victoria's Golden Jubilee 1887'. See page 9 for more about the Recreation Ground.



### Nature Notes

#### NATURE NOTES FOR OCTOBER

Last October I attended the Harvest Festival at St Margaret's Church. I approached and entered the building to the joyful sounds of the church bells. The inside of the church was decorated with the fruit, flowers, nuts and berries of autumn - including apples, pears, grapes, chrysanthemums, hops, horse chestnuts, holly berries and rose hips. Propped up near the communion table were stalks of wheat and a fancy loaf of bread in the form of a sheaf of wheat. There was a large congregation and a large choir. During the service, conducted by the then curate and reader, two traditional harvest hymns were sung, "We plough the fields, and scatter" and Come, ye thankful people, come".

Harvest festivals of the kind celebrated, generally in October, in churches throughout the country date back only to 1843, when the Rev Robert Hawker invited his parishioners to a special thanksgiving service at his church at Morwenstow in Cornwall. Harvest hymns composed or translated into English during Victorian times, such as "All things bright and beautiful" and the two hymns sung last year at St Margaret's Church, helped to spread and popularise the holding of harvest festivals, including the custom of decorating churches with home grown produce.

Morwenstow was and is a remote parish between Bude and Clovelly, whose western boundary is the Atlantic Ocean. The Rev Hawker watched the moods of the Atlantic from a hut on the immense cliffs of the parish and, under a ship's figurehead in his churchyard, he buried the bodies of dead sailors. It is quite remarkable that a festival which is celebrated throughout the Anglican world should have originated in a small, dark Norman church at the end of Cornwall and the edge of Europe.

We have been left with a pictorial record of harvest time here in Rainham, in Victorian times, in the form of a stained glass window in St Margaret's Church. At its apex there is a scene of stooks of wheat sheaves over which a native grey partridge glides with out stretched wings. The window is a memorial to Solomon John Brice who was a farmer and one-time

church warden who died in 1904. Until relatively recently, farmers would meet at the lych gate of their local church, at Harvest Festival, each with a sheaf of corn under his arm, and would follow the choir and clergy in procession into church where they would leave their sheaves on the chancel

Because of the almost universal use of combine harvesters, stooks of corn are rarely seen these days. Grev partridges are much less common than they were in Solomon's day. In his book "Notes on the Birds of Rainham", published in 1894, Walter Prentis, who was also a local farmer, notes that "the grey partridge is generally distributed in the district. Our chalk soil, with hill and valley, field and wood combined, makes excellent sport for the 1st September." Grev partridges could be seen, until fairly recently, at Gore farm in the neighbouring parish of Upchurch. The previous owner, Michael Blee, provided seed food and cover for the birds. As many readers will know, the old mosaic of different habitats has been replaced with serried rows of dwarf apple trees which have little or no wildlife value. I have however spotted grey partridges in Hartlip where there is a mixed habitat of rough ground and fields of wheat and maize. The presence of fairly tame pheasants and red legged partridges indicates that shooting rights are exercised over the areas concerned in the shooting season.

Red legged partridges are easier to spot than the native grey. They are bigger, more colourful and less timid. If caught in the open, with no cover, they will run quickly away with heads held high. If there is cover they will hold their heads down and creep away. I have been informed that, last winter, red legged partridges were occasionally seen in gardens near to Mierscourt Road, on the eastern boundary of Rainham.

In days gone by, house sparrows were perhaps the most common wild birds to be seen in wheat fields. For reason which are not clear, the population of the once common sparrow has been much reduced. Wood pigeons are now one of the commonest birds in the countryside, being able to feed on a wide range of vegetable matter such as cabbage, young

rape plants, tree buds, cherries, cereal and holly and ivy berries. Along with rabbits, the birds are currently the farmer's worst pest, yet Walter Prentis wrote that, in Rainham, wood pigeons "are not numerous enough to be troublesome". They were doubtless widely shot. Today, nobody wants to bother making pigeon pie apart from cooks on television.

#### RECREATION GROUND

Rainham's Recreation Ground, which was given to the Parish in commemoration of Oueen Victoria's Golden Jubilee in 1887, was frequently in the news for various reasons during the early years of the twentieth century. In March 1901, shortly after the Queen's death, the East Kent Gazette reported that 'There is a feeling in some circles that something should be done at Rainham to perpetuate the memory of our late beloved Queen'. It had been suggested that perhaps a statue of her late Majesty should be erected at the 'Rec', funds for this purpose being raised through a series of concerts. Apparently nothing came of this idea, but perhaps the rather more practical improvements the following year happened instead: several loads of manure were placed round the shrubs, the seats and gates were painted, and the railings were 'tarred to within 12' of the gates'. Whether this meant that they were treated with black bituminous paint as a preservative, or whether this was an early attempt to prevent vandalism I don't know. 'Yobs' are not new, for in 1908 'thirteen young trees that were planted to beautify the park have been wantonly destroyed' and there had apparently been similar damage the previous year. As a result, the Gazette told its readers, 'A watch has been set to catch the miscreant, who appears to scale the railings in the dark and to break up the trees. If any of Baden Powell's boy scouts are to be found squirming around outside the Rec. at night, it will be known what they are there for'. Since this report appeared in November they would have found their watch rather RAD chilly.
