

The tank was almost full and the people are very grateful to have access to clean water. The work has been completed to a very high standard and the community are keeping the area in good order.'

It is good to know that the money has been put to such good use - thank you to all who help with our door to door distribution each month. If you feel you would like to take some exercise in a good cause we still need volunteer distributors of Action Forum for a few roads in the area (see page 3 for details). Have a good month and we will see you again in April, it will be time to be planning the garden and summer will be just round the corner by then.

Nature Notes

NATURE NOTES FOR JANUARY & FEBRUARY In late January I visited two of the nature reserves of the Royal Society for the Protection of Birds, those at Cliffe and Dungeness. The former is one of the Society's newest reserves and the latter is its oldest. They are similar in that thousands of waders and wildfowl, mostly from abroad, spend the winter at each reserve. However, the landscapes of which the reserves are comprised are very different.

The Cliffe reserve lies on the Hoo Peninsula, to the south west of Cliffe village, and was once under threat as the site of London's fourth airport. Although there are plans for a visitor centre at the reserve, the public facilities currently amount to little more than a fairly large car park. However, the RSPB has had to carry out a lot of work before it could open the reserve, such as the removal of fly-tipped rubbish, contaminated soil and burnt-out cars. Having parked my car, I headed for a view-point called "The "Pinnacle", which is a pyramid chalk cliff left over from quarrying. From there I had an aerial view of the reserve which consists of fresh water, saline and brackish pools interspersed with scrubby bushes and grassy marshlands. The pools have been created by the digging of clay for the onetime cement industry. I could see hundreds of avocet, lapwing, black tailed godwit, wigeon and dunlin feeding on the edges of the pools. At high tide large flocks of waders such as dunlin wheel in from the mud banks along the Thames to roost on the islands in the pools. Unfortunately I was not there at the right time to witness any spectacular aerial displays. I did not tarry too long on the view-point, as I was exposed to a bitterly cold, northerly wind. I could hear

jackdaws calling to each other on the other side of "The Pinnacle" as they perched in the sunshine and out of the wind. Having descended to ground level, I took a short walk between two of the pools where lots of little grebes (or dabchicks) were diving, I assumed, for fish. As I returned to my car I made a mental note to visit the reserve in the spring, when the weather should be kinder, and when I hoped to be able to hear the calls of turtle doves and nightingales in the scrubby areas of the reserve. The latter is planned to

become the RSPB's flagship reserve on the north Kent Coast, with the necessary public facilities. In the meantime, the nearest toilets and places of refreshment for visitors are at Cliffe village and Cooling.

The headland of Dungeness juts into the English Channel between Folkestone and Hastings. It forms the largest shingle formation of its kind in Europe. Not unnaturally, the RSPB's reserve there consists largely of shingle, but also includes fresh water pools, grassland and reed beds. The Society's association with Dungeness dates back to 1905 when two "watchers" were appointed to guard birds breeding there, including stone curlew and Kentish ployer. The entrance to the reserve is on the Dungeness Road about half way between Lydd and the coast. My January visit had got off to a good start upon seeing a large flock of Bewick's swans in a field adjoining the Dungeness Road. The swans are winter visitors from arctic Russia.

Hopefully, visitors to the Cliffe reserve will, in due course, enjoy the same facilities as are provided at Dungeness, namely, a visitor centre with a wellstocked shop, toilets and disabled access. The centre overlooks Burrowes Pit, the largest of the fresh water pools. Here one can sit, in warmth and comfort, and watch the birds through plate glass windows. During my own visit I noted ducks such as shoveller, wigeon, pintail, teal and pochard. I was told by a lady volunteer at the centre that a bittern was present in the reed beds at Denge Marsh. So I followed a group of birdwatchers with telescopes slung over their shoulders as they headed for the hide overlooking the marsh. It was almost standing room only when I got there but, I found myself a seat, and my neighbour kindly pointed out the bittern to me. It was the first of the species that I had ever seen. The bird is a large, tawny and brown marsh heron which is normally very secretive and difficult to spot. As I completed the circular walk around the reserve, a large flock of lapwing flew overhead, identified by their characteristically slow, floppy flight.

I decided to head for Dungeness Point, near the nuclear power stations, because guillemots, razor bills, kittiwakes

off The Point. When I arrived there anglers were fishing from the water's edge along the bottom of the shingle bank and birdwatchers were lined up along the top. Apparently, fishing boats had been coming across large shoals of whiting and school bass, which were attracting the sea birds. A birdwatcher I met in the hide invited me to view the birds through his telescope, since it was difficult to hold my binoculars steady in the strong wind. To complete my comparison with Cliffe, I should add that hungry visitors to Dungeness can obtain fish and chip lunches at The Pilot Inn, The Britannia Inn and (at weekends only in winter) The Light Railway Cafe. and gannets had been reported to be feeding in the sea

Strips can be knitted in one long length, changing colour only when at the end of the ball of wool. If knitting squares for us to sew up, please leave ends long enough for sewing up.
