

Editorial

One of the regular outings we looked forward to during the Autumn Half Term holiday, when our children were of an age to relish such expeditions, was 'chestnutting'. Conkers from the Horse Chestnut trees are always down first and they make for easier gathering as they do not have the spikes on their outer cases. It is very satisfying finding the large smooth, shiny dark brown fruit and I think this and the subsequent battle to bore holes through for the necessary strings was more fun then actually playing the game - a few bruised knuckles and the children had soon had enough - I don't think we had the requisite skills or knew the rules well enough! Having tired of the delights of conkers we then visited various woods in Kent looking for sweet chestnuts to eat. One of our best discoveries was near Faversham. Driving along a country lane, by Sharsted Court, on a windy autumnal day the entire road was inches deep with chestnut husks and the nuts just littered the ground. No gloves were needed that day as we picked up dozens of enormous chestnuts in no time at all. We just happened upon the spot at the optimum time. Revisiting in subsequent years it is obviously well known and never again have I seen such abundance. although you can still usually find a good harvest. However we did not need to venture that far away as there are several good chestnutting spots in and around this area. Having gathered the chestnuts I always feel a great sense of achievement if I manage to prepare and freeze sufficient to serve with our Brussels sprouts at Christmas dinner. Locally sourced chestnuts are an essential part of our Christmas lunch, probably more so even than the turkey - certainly for the vegetarian! The problem when the family were young, as it is a time consuming job, was managing to complete the work before they were all eaten. This year I had been afraid that for the first time I would not be able to gather my free fruits, the best tree I have relied on for many years seems barren and there have been various warnings in the press about poor harvests. However I have managed to find a replacement supply. A nearby tree which has never before produced much of a crop of any size seems suddenly to have come good, so all should be well!

If you feel it is too soon to be preparing for Christmas we do have other items to interest you this month although there are also a large number of Fayres, Craft Fairs and Sales all featuring Christmas in their title at the end of November and beginning of December. If you would love to get to grips with a computer, but have no idea where to start, Rainham School for Girls are offering free Silver Surfer courses in their new Independent Research Centre. You could go back to school and with the roles reversed be expertly tutored in how to surf the net, use a smart phone, download and use an App, begin on-line shopping and send emails and attachments by one of the pupils at the school. Alternatively if the television Choir programmes have rekindled your interest in singing Upchurch Choral Society are seeking a new Music Director - a demanding job I am sure - are you up to the challenge?

Nature Notes

NATURE NOTES FOR OCTOBER

Last October we visited the annual Apple Festival at Brogdale Farm on the outskirts of Faversham. The farm is home to the National Fruit Collection, the largest assembly of different varieties of fruit trees in the world, including 2,300 different apple varieties. The collection is not simply a living museum; it is an important gene bank for future fruit breeders. The main attractions of the festival were tours of the orchards and the testing and sales of apples but there were also displays and demonstrations of gun dogs, falconry, flower arranging, cooking, gardening and horticulture.

We first went on a guided tour of the orchards. Before we moved off the guide gave us us all a short history of apple growing. All domestic apples have their origins in the mountains on the boundary between China and Kazakhstan. The Romans brought the first domestic apples to Britain some 2,000 years ago; they were a more palatable alternative to our own sour, small, native crab apples. After the Romans left this country, the art of apple growing was kept alive in a handful of monasteries until the arrival of the Normans who brought certain varieties of domestic apples from Normandy. Even so, most apples growing in England during the Middle Ages were too sour to eat and were therefore turned to cider. The situation began to change after the fruiterer of Henry VIII. Richard Harris, established this country's first large apple, pear and cherry collection at Teynham. He imported apple grafts from France and pear and cherry grafts from the Netherlands. The 18th and 19th centuries were the golden age of English apples when varieties like Bramley's Seedling became household

That brief history lesson over, we commenced our tour. The apples pointed out to us were in various shapes, sizes and colours. Names such as Chelmsford Wonder and Braintree Seedling were a reminder that, in the past, apple varieties were developed locally. Armed with a pocket knife, the guide handed out slices of certain apples for us to taste. We were shown a tree of red and cream apples of the variety "Decio"

which is the oldest, by far, in the collection. The variety dates back to Roman times and was named after a Roman general. Unfortunately we were not allowed to taste that particular one. The guide told us that Brogdale's apples are sold in the farm's shop and at local greengrocers. Any apples unfit for sale are fed to Gloucester Old Spot pigs kept on the farm and owned by Brogdale Butchers who have a shop on the premises.

We also had a look at one or two pear, quince and medlar trees. We were shown a wild pear tree with very small and hard fruit. Growing in the shape of a bushy shrub, it originated from a Site of Special Scientific Interest in the Tamar Valley, By contrast we saw some Belgian "Beurre" pear trees whose fruit "simply melts in one's mouth". Unfortunately, the fruit had already been picked. We were told that the large, yellow, soft fruit of the quince tree is too strongly flavoured to be eaten raw and is used to make jelly, to flavour apple pies or to add to other fruit in the making of preserves. The hard, sour fruits of the medlar tree are stored until they become soft when they are either made into a jelly or eaten as a dessert. Both fruits were highly favoured by the Victorians.

On finishing the tour we headed for the Courtyard restaurant and inspected the menu. As expected, the main courses and the desserts were mostly apple based. Having spent the morning sampling apples and intending to do the same in the afternoon, we needed a change, and so had a snack at one of the food stalls in a barn. Afterwards we headed for a large marquee in which visitors could taste and buy apples. Here, on display, were varieties of old English dessert apples which are not generally stocked by the supermarkets such as James Grieve, Worcester Permain, Laxton's Superb, Blenheim Orange, Cox's Orange Pippin and Egremont Russet. I myself had a taste of a Cox and a Russet. The member of staff who served us, and who clearly knew his onions, suggested that the Cox had a deliciously sweet and richly aromatic flavour; and who was I to disagree with him. The Russet was described as having a very distinctive, nutty flavour. Having arrived home with a good supply of Coxs

and Russets it was time for reflection on our day out. With so many people inspecting the Brogdale orchards on Apple Weekend it was not surprising that we saw so little wildlife. Visiting redwings, fieldfares, starlings and blackbirds may, however, be seen feeding on the fallen apples, particularly after the hawthorn and other berries have been eaten up. Modern commercial orchards, with their serried rows of dwarf trees, be they apple, pear or cherry, are fairly lifeless compared with the very few orchards that survive from the age of mixed farming. Sheep grazed · under the large, standard fruit trees in those orchards, although pigs would often be turned loose in them in order to mop up fallen fruit. They were the habitat of, among other birds, barn, little and tawny owls; green, great spotted and lesser spotted woodpeckers; nuthatches; and great and blue tits.

BRITISH STANDARD PORTLAND CEMENT WORKS by Jim Preston

The firm of E. J. and W. Goldsmith of Gravs were the largest barge owners in Essex with at one point 147 sailing barges, many of which were engaged in the transportation of cement on the Thames and Medway. When many of the cement firms merged to form Associated Portland Cement Manufacturers in 1901 the new combine acquired its own fleet of barges, reducing the freights available to Goldsmith's. As a result the firm entered the chalk quarrying industry in 1901, working a quarry to the south of the Lower Rainham Road, just east of Berengrave Lane [O.S. ref TO 820 671]. The quarry was connected by a tramway to a wharf to the west of Motney Hill Road which had been used by the East Rainham brickworks [O.S. ref TQ 823 673] back in the 1860s. Their barges could then be used to carry the chalk to independent cement works which had no supply of chalk of their own such as Elmley and Queenborough. Goldsmiths were afraid of losing their share of the cement trade on the Thames after a second merger of independent cement firms to form the British Portland Cement Manufacturers in 1911. To remain independent of APCM and BPCM they constructed their own cement works in 1912 just to the east of Motney Hill Road [O.S. ref TO 822 674]. The new works were equipped with the then most up to date plant including a rotary kiln supplied by Emest Newells of Misterton,

Nottinghamshire who were leading kiln manufacturers in the early part of the twentieth century. This kiln was 202 feet long with a diameter of 10 feet. This was a wet

process kiln fired with coal dust capable of producing 150 tons of clinker per day, feeding into a rotary cooler before grinding. Production started in 1913. Somewhere around 1923 a second rotary kiln, this time supplied by Vickers was added. This kiln was 198 feet 6 inches long with a diameter of c.10 feet, again wet process, feeding a rotary cooler, but capable of 165 tons of clinker per day.

The works were acquired in 1927 by the Home Group who sold cement under the Red Triangle trade mark, and who were buying up independent cement works. The Home Group proceeded to modernise the works "at considerable expense". Unfortunately this was bad timing just before the Depression hit. A cement price war broke out in 1928 which only ended in November 1928 when the Home Group and other independent producers joined the 'Cement Manufacturers Association' which fixed production quotas for the industry. The Home Group then failed due to lack of finance after the price war and possible poor management leading to inefficiency. The first kiln went out of production in 1929, leaving the plant working at only 59% of capacity, which was uneconomic. The Home Group was liquidated in 1931. The labour force was laid off by the liquidator, who sold the works to Associated Portland Cement Manufacturers, APCM appointed a works manager whose job appears to have been to supervise the dismantling of the plant. APCM had no intention of reopening the works, the reason for the purchase was that under the cement marketing agreements each works had been allocated a production quota, and APCM could reallocate the British Standard works quota to increase capacity at their other works [Chatham News, 6th November 1931, page 5]. The plant was dismantled with the more modern equipment being removed to their other plant, including the Vickers kiln which was installed at Magheramome cement works in Ulster.

Little trace remains of the cement works or the adjacent dock. The vertical walls of the guay have been reprofiled by Medway Council, and the walls of dock side store houses levelled. The works site is now part of a nature reserve and has been reclaimed by scrub and bramble. Any buildings have been levelled, but it is possible to find a few traces of the footprint of the silos and kiln bases. The washmills in the quarry have survived to above ground level, and may be substantially interpreted. These are being excavated by the Friends of Berengrave, and more details of progress so far may be found at their website: www.friendsofberengrave.btik.com.


