The first issue of Action Forum appeared in March 1969. Our mission statement in a pre publication sheet hoping to attract advertisers declared:

'We intend every person in Rainham and Wigmore to read Action Forum. We shall therefore deliver it free to an initial minimum of 10,000 homes, gradually covering the whole area later in the spring. We can afford to deliver free because our editorial and distribution staff is entirely voluntary. Our printing and paper costs will be covered by a maximum mix of

fifty percent advertising.'

To this day, 483 issues and 43 years later, this largely remains the same however I am not sure we have ever succeeded in getting every person to read our pages! Our distribution figure has risen to 20,000 copies each month giving some indication of the changes that have happened in the area, but our editorial and distribution teams are all volunteers and we remain at roughly 50:50 editorial and advertising, which still pays our costs. Advertising costs have of course risen. In 1969 a half page cost £8.10/- and a quarter £5. Fifteen or so years ago when time was at a premium for us we decided to pay for the distribution of Action Forum. This helped us over a few years when our family and business commitments were at their height but it was never as satisfactory as our committed band of volunteers. When things calmed down a bit by September 2000 we reverted to organising the voluntary distribution. This released a section of the regular income from advertising which as Action Forum is a non profit making magazine was now available to donate to charity. Over the last 12 years we have made regular payments to three organisations. St Margaret's Church, Rainham, The Parish of South Gillingham and the Kajiado Development Trust in Kenya. A recent contribution of £1500 for each has brought the total donated to date to £28,050. Thank you very much everyone who has helped to make this possible. Over the years several hundred people have assisted. We have some very long standing deliverers, some I can think of who even gallantly rejoined the team in 2000 despite the fact that we had given them their cards when we went to commercial distribution! Your excellent, efficient help is much appreciated not only by us but also by the many residents of Rainham and Wigmore (now joined by Parkwood, Bredhurst, Upchurch and Lower Halstow) who do read Action Forum each month.

As usual the first few weeks of December are very busy, our diary is full of Christmas Fairs, parties and visits from Santa on his annual Sleigh Runs when the Lions Club of Gillingham collect for local charities. 1 am also happy to say that towards the big day itself we also include many dates from various local churches for Carol Services, Crib Services and Christmas Day Services including the traditional Christmas Eve Midnight and later Family events. In all the rush and preparation it is good to set aside a short while to consider the real meaning of Christmas. Have a wonderful time and we will see you again in the middle of January with our usual combined edition.

M2 ACCESS Dear Editor

Once again the access roads on and off the M2 at Moto M2 Service Station are under threat of closure. This last happened over 10 years ago and it caused gridlock all around the towns until people took it into their own hands and pulled the barriers down allowing traffic to flow normally again. Now while I am not advocating civil disorder, I think it is time that the local wishes are taken into account. The reasons cited for closing the access are:

1. That it is the only Service Station with access to the surrounding area. This is not true, according to the internet at least 50 other service stations have access to surrounding areas.

2. That there is a high accident rate. As many locals will tell you this is untrue. I am waiting to hear back

from the Police with facts and figures.

3. That local people are complaining about the noise. The majority of people who live at the top of Mierscourt Road happily use these roads, however there will always be one or two who object. These access roads have been used for over 30 years. Until the government puts their hands in their pockets and builds new access roads on and off the M2 why not allow these roads to carry on being used. Most local councillors are against the closure as is our MP. Please write to them and state your support. Petitions are at 'The Farm Shop' Mierscourt Road, The Centre next to the Travelodge and 'Ladyfair Hair and Beauty' Rainham High Street. Please pop in and sign - make your voice felt.
