### Editorial

Sixty years ago as a country we were in party mood. June 2nd 1953 was Coronation Day. Happily the disappointing cold, wet weather did nothing to dampen the patriotic fervour and did not point to a disastrous reign. Far from it – who would have imagined on that rainy Tuesday as we sat glued to tiny black and white television sets, generously shared by their proud owners, that in 2013 our glamorous young Queen would be celebrating her Diamond Jubilee? The fact that Her Majesty still fulfils numerous engagements each year, which would be a strain for people years younger, is often overlooked, we just expect her to continue as she has always done. Perhaps now this milestone has been reached we should be more understanding of her position, surely it would be possible to continue as monarch but delegate the travel and tiring ceremonial occasions to the younger royals. They seem more than capable of fulfilling the tasks admirably!

For the Coronation Rainham, under the leadership of Councillor Freddie Cooper, had a full programme of activities planned. This started with a Coronation Celebration Carnival on the evening of 27th May continued with special Coronation Sunday Services and the main events were to take place on Coronation Day itself. These were not scheduled to begin until 2.30pm by which time the rain had mostly given way to the damp overcast weather we know so well this year. However the morning, when the organisers had intended setting up the activities, had seen torrential downpours. The programme for the arena included Girl Guides and RE Cadets Marching Displays, Sheep Dog Demonstrations, a Comic Football Match. Maypole Dancing, the London Mime Theatre Company and Children's Races. Around the Recreation Ground were to be Swings, Roundabouts and Sideshows, Bowl-out-Batsman, Bingo, Bowlingfor-Pig, Football-in-Hole, Darts, Aunt Sally, Hoopla, Coconuts Shies, Wheel-em-in and all the other regular Village Fete entertainments. As anyone who has been involved with a Summer Fair knows this all takes a considerable time to prepare. Inevitably some events had to be cancelled but wherever possible the programme went ahead as planned. Despite the problems the whole event was voted a success and even made a small profit which caused much debate among the committee for months to come. Eventually it was decided to donate the clock above Barclays

Bank to the village (a small plaque on the wall commemorates this) and the Council undertook to maintain it. They continued to do so for many years only in 2009 reneging on the promise when the clock needed a major overhaul. To their credit the local Rainham Councillors generously paid for the renovation and we again have a reliable time piece. Less said the better about our recent weather I feel! I am looking forward to a glorious warm, sunny spell to take us past midsummer. Well I can dream! Have a good month we will see you again in July.

The crown was made specially for the event and it is being held by Keith Randall. To the right of him is my best friend, Patricia Wilkinson, and she is holding the half hoop with Annette Ashdown. I think the boy chosen as the Captain, to the left of me in the photo, is Brian Bennett.

I can still remember part of my speech "I welcome you, friends, this happy day and thank you for making me Queen of May..." It ended with "...Be seated, friends, this happy day and let us begin our revels gay." This was followed with dancing round the maypole. I still keep in touch with Patricia and will be sending her a copy of magazine as she has moved away. This photograph brought back many

happy memories of my school days and, hopefully, to other pupils too. I always enjoy reading Action Forum but never thought that my few moments of fame would ever make it on to the front cover.

### Nature Notes

NATURE NOTES FOR MAY

In May I visited the National Nature Reserve at Northwood Hill, near High Halstow on the Hoo Peninsula, which is owned by the RSPB. I assembled with other visitors at Bromhev Farm, the local HO of the Society, just off the minor road from High Halstow to Cooling. Under the leadership of the warden, we were to visit the viewing area for the nesting site of the grey herons, little egrets and rooks in the late afternoon and, in the evening, areas where we were hoping to hear nightingales singing. At Least 20 pairs of the latter breed on the reserve.

We set off through an area of mixed scrub and grassland. Almost immediately we heard the characteristic, soft "purring" calls of a turtle dove. The bird's song, like that of the yellow hammer, is reminiscent of hot days in the English countryside. Bare and exposed branches are much favoured by male turtle doves for perching but this particular bird was out of sight of all of us. Its nest, if there was to be one, would be a flimsy structure of fine sticks in one of the hawthorn bushes from which the calls were emanating.

We proceeded around the edge of Northwood Hill, where it borders Cooling Marshes, until we arrived at the viewing point. Some 100 pairs of grey herons, 250 -300 pairs of rooks and about 50 pairs of little egrets nest in the oak trees in the wood. The herons have had a colony there for about a hundred years, having bred previously at Cobham. The rooks originally nested in the wood's elm trees but, since the rayages of Dutch elm disease in the 1970s, moved into the oaks as neighbours of the herons. The little egrets have arrived at Northwood Hill only relatively recently and, due to a shortage of sites in the oaks, also nest in the hawthorn and other low growing trees and bushes. The nesting site of the three species is the woodland equivalent of the noisy, sea cliff colonies of nesting gannets, guillemots and razorbills.

By the time of our visit in May, leaf cover prevented us from seeing all but a few nests on the edge of the wood. Even so, there was much to see and hear. We watched parent herons bringing food for their young from the dykes of the marshes. This doubtless included fish, eels, amphibians, small mammals and small water birds. We could hear the constant "ekk ekk" calls of begging youngsters which rose to a crescendo when food arrived. The parents themselves were quite noisy; they indulged in croaking, rasping and bill clattering whilst at the nest.

The spectacle and symbolism of a rookery is as closely tied to our sense of spring as the sight of snowdrops, hazel catkins or new born lambs. The cacophony of a rookery is matched by the colony's atmosphere of commotion. Rooks perform spectacular communal movements with towering spiral flights above the rookery, which are known as "crows" weddings. As the rooks at Northwood Hill rose into the air and circled around, their feathers reflected the sun's rays as if they were mirrors.

In due course, we retraced our steps along the edge of the wood and entered it at a point well away from the heronry and rookery so as not to disturb the breeding birds. We came across many spring flowers, including bluebell, early purple orchid, red campion, common dog violet and yellow archangel. Birds such as song thrush, chiff chaff, blackcap and lesser whitethroat were in song. The warden pointed out a number of boxes which were intended to attract any dormice that may be in the wood. However, only wood mice, bumble bees, blue tits and great tits had been found to use them. He explained that Northwood Hill was guite isolated, being connected to other woods only in a south westerly direction and the wood was surrounded by marsh land and river estuaries in the other directions. This makes it unlikely that mammals such as dormice would find their way to the wood. To my surprise, he added that even fairly common woodland birds such as nightjar, nuthatch, tree creeper and woodcock are either absent or rare, as breeding species, on the reserve.

We eventually arrived at a ride in the wood lined with hawthorn scrub and we were asked by the warden to stop talking. We were fortunate to hear two nightingales singing on the edge of the ride that evening but we saw neither of them. Whereas a song thrush may be readily seen singing from a tree top or a blackbird from its perch on a TV aerial, the

nightingale sings from deep within cover. The male's song has been described as "outstandingly rich in volume and range of notes" and "loud and musical with repeated notes and pauses". The nightingale's virtuoso performance is perhaps best heard in the stillness of a warm evening in early May when the competition from among the males to attract females arriving from Africa is at its height. We were very lucky with both the weather and the bird song during our visit and we went home a group of very happy bunnies.


