

This picture postcard of 'South View, Reculver, 1800' was sent to my mother in 1927 just because the sender, a relative, thought she would like the card. I am not sure whether it was the picture or the rather gruesome information on the back he thought she would like! The caption reads:-'The Roman foundation, or Sacrificial Brick, is 24 inches long near the North Tower, under which is placed a live baby, as was the custom in AD2. They were under the impression that all the time the babe was there it was a living building and nothing could destroy it because it was a living sacrifice. When laying a foundation stone in England today we put the King's head underneath (coins) which is taken from the above custom.'

It has been a funny old season in the garden this year. The cold wet spring meant our seedlings took a long time to get going - in fact I wondered if some of the beans would ever germinate - but eventually they did and once the warm sunshine arrived everything sprang into life and you could almost watch them growing. So far so good but of course, as always, with all the plants needing attention at once some were bound to lose out. The tomatoes were terribly late arriving in their final growing positions and repaid us by hardly bothering to If any of your readers can help please contact us on ripen despite all those long, hot, sunny days! Just as a few shades of red appeared autumn came with damper conditions and almost overnight the whole lot succumbed to blight. I think I will give up on tomatoes for the next few years. The beans did not fair much better. They put their heart and soul into producing a magnificent crop and we did have many meals, and I have a freezer bursting at the seams, but whilst they were still in their prime they were attacked by another of our constant threats – the rabbits. I am beginning to know how Mr Macgregor felt about that naughty Peter Rabbit. The trouble with building a rabbit proof cage is that when the pests manage to burrow their way in it is incredibly difficult to get rid of them. Late on in the season they discovered that the stems tasted exceptionally good and proceeded to chew their way through almost the entire row. If they had just chomped their way through the lower hanging beans I would not have minded as much - we had plenty to spare – but by attacking the main stem they effectively wiped out theirs and our food supply. Still the peas and sweet corn were good, the courgettes, onions and cabbages are doing well, some of our best crops for years so it is not all bad news, and the cage is keeping the birds off our taller brassicas so it is fulfilling part of its intended purpose. At least there is always something to marvel at in a garden, you certainly never have time to get bored.

Autumn is very definitely with us now. On several occasions we have had very misty mornings, the sun sometimes manages to break through and then we have yet another glorious day but as the days shorten all too soon the daylight fades and we are reminded that long winter nights are not far away. Still before that happens we have lots to do this month, there are many activities listed in our pages, exhibitions, guizzes, concerts, walks and the inevitable start to the Christmas Bazaar season. Do please read on and

discover the items that interest you, until November have a very happy month and we will be with you again then.

BREDHURST MEMORIAL PLAOUE Dear Editor

Next year is the centenary of the outbreak of WWI. "The Great War" and I believe there is a national project being undertaken to research the story behind the names of those who made the ultimate sacrifice for their country.

I am researching the history of local names and I'd be grateful for any additional information that could be supplied by your readers on the following listed on the memorial plaque situated in St Peter's church, Bredhurst. Some of the names have Rainham and Gillingham connections:

Johnson, Charles Alfred, L/Cpl 2nd Battalion, Royal Sussex Regiment. Died 9.9.16 aged 25. Born Bredhurst, enlisted Rainham. Charles' brother

Edmund Johnson is also commemorated on the plaque. He was a private in 'A' Company, 10th Battalion, The Buffs (Royal E. Kent and W. Kent Yeomanry). Killed in action 11.8.18 aged 35. Lived in Bredhurst, enlisted in Rainham.

Akhurst, John William, Private 1st Battalion, the Buffs (E. Kent Regt). Died 30.3.17 aged 24. Resided Bredhurst, enlisted Canterbury.

Mason, William James, Rifleman 2nd/17th (County of London) Battalion, (Poplar & Stepney Rifles), London Regiment. Died 20.2.18 aged 21. Born and resided Bredhurst. Buried Jerusalem War Cemetery. Brooks, Frederick, Gunner, 269th Siege Battery, Royal Garrison Artillery, died 4.2.19 aged 21. Buried St Peter's churchyard, Bredhurst (died Balham hospital).

I have basic details from the website www.kentfallen.com, but if anyone has personal stories remembered by their parents etc, it would be really good to get a picture of the men behind the names.

Nature Notes

NATURE NOTES FOR SEPTEMBER

In September of last year Mrs Ennis and I paid a visit to Reculver Country Park, to the east of Herne Bay. The twin towers of the former St Mary's church are a distinctive feature, not only of the park itself, but also of a long stretch of the north Kent coast. The towers are visible for miles around and have guided sailors in the Thames for centuries. Also within the confines of the park are the remains of a Roman fort, the King Ethelbert Inn and a visitor centre run by Kent Wildlife

In Britain we have a long and varied coastline. Our seashores consist of a wide range of coastal habitats, including mud, sand, shingle, chalk cliff and rock. They are home to an abundance of plant and animal life. The seashore at Reculver consists of mud and sand interspersed with surrogate rocks in the form of weed covered concrete blocks and granite boulders. We chose to visit the park on a day when Kent Wildlife Trust was organising a hunt for "seashore mini beasts". Fishing nets and plastic buckets were provided and two members of the Trust stood by to identify, where necessary, what had been found. Mrs Ennis and I joined in the excitement and enthusiasm created by a large number of parents and children. On the rocks we found whelks, limpets, mussels, and a sea anemone. The latter is a plant-like animal that clings to rocks and has tentacles which are used for finding any food floating by in the water. In the pools between the rocks we came across crabs, common shrimps, a starfish and a common blenny, which is a sea version of the fresh water bullhead, having a blunt head and a tapering body. One of the crabs was a common hermit crab, which takes over the empty shell of a dog whelk or winkle. One can sometimes see what appears to be a whelk or winkle moving at an unexpected speed across the bottom of a pool. Closer examination reveals that a head and a number of legs are sticking out of an empty shell, which has been taken over by as hermit crab.

Seaweeds we came across included sea lettuce, which has two pale green fronds resembling the leaves of a rather limp lettuce and jelly buttons which looks like

an irregular blob of brown jelly. Bladder wrack, however, was the commonest seaweed; it has spherical gas filled bladders along the fronds permitting the plant to float upright when the tide is in. It is a great favourite with children because, when squeezed, the bladders explode with a loud "pop". Along the tide line we picked up razor shells, mermaids' purse (which is the egg case of a dog fish), a common whelk egg case (which resemble a bunch of shrivelled grapes) and some cuttlefish bone (which supports the long soft body of the fish). All in all, we much enjoyed our hunt for seashore mini beasts. We had a cup of coffee in a cafe within the park and then headed for the twin towers of the former St Mary's Church. We noticed that a large area of grass near to the church was festooned with thousands of long threads of silk. These are spun by young money spiders as a means of dispersal from the place where they were born. The newly born spiders climb up long stems of grass, face the breeze and then spin a strand of silk which eventually generates enough lift to send the creatures skywards. This spectacle occurs mostly in late summer and early autumn, on warm sunny days, when the ground is warmed by the sun. As air currents rise, the young spiders can be carried high into the sky. It was not clear to us whether the threads on the grass at Reculver were attached to young spiders still trying to take off or whether they had brought spiderlings from their birth places elsewhere. As our attention moved away from the spiders' webs, we noticed a small flock of sand martins flying overhead, in the direction of the English Channel. The birds are one of the first of our spring migrants to appear in this country, arriving from mid March onwards. They move south again from late July to September, with stragglers in October. One of the largest colonies of sand martins in Kent, some 100 or more pairs, can be found nesting in Bishopstone Cliffs, about a mile away from where we stood. The birds we saw migrating were likely to have been nesting in the north of England, rather than locally. A few fulmars spend their summer on the cliffs between Reculver and Bishopstone although it is rare for them to breed successfully. Most of them are likely, in any case, to be non-breeding juveniles. By



This picture postcard of 'South View, Reculver, 1800' was sent to my mother in 1927 just because the sender, a relative, thought she would like the card. I am not sure whether it was the picture or the rather gruesome information on the back he thought she would like! The caption reads:-'The Roman foundation, or Sacrificial Brick, is 24 inches long near the North Tower, under which is placed a live baby, as was the custom in AD2. They were under the impression that all the time the babe was there it was a living building and nothing could destroy it because it was a living sacrifice. When laying a foundation stone in England today we put the King's head underneath (coins) which is taken from the above custom.'
