

Nature Notes

NATURE NOTES FOR MAY

In early May I visited the most northern part of the parish of St Margaret's, Rainham. I headed for Motney Hill Road and, having parked my car, joined the embankment that runs along the western edge of the road. The characteristic estuary smell of mud, seaweed and salt pervaded the air. In one direction I had a view towards the River Medway and the dominating presence of Kingsnorth Power Station. Black headed gulls, oyster catchers and shelduck stood out prominently as they fed on the mudflats of the estuary. Not so readily noticeable, because of their brown plumage, were redshanks. However, one particular nearby redshank, surprised at my sudden appearance, drew attention to itself with an explosion of shrill alarm notes. In the other direction from where I stood were large areas of scrub, mostly of hawthorn and bramble, and one of the most extensive reed beds in south east England. The reed warblers, sedge warblers and reed buntings that nest in the reeds attract the attention of cuckoos. The reed beds owe their existence to the presence of artesian wells, the water in which has permeated down through the chalk of the North Downs. This water eventually flows under Motney Hill Road and along a channel which empties into Rainham Creek. Ducks, geese, waders and gulls can often be seen along the channel, either bathing in or drinking the fresh water.

I continued along the embankment, passed some houses on Motney Hill, turned right at the entrance to the sewage works and eventually came to the sea wall overlooking Otterham Creek. I could see, on the opposite bank, the "candle snuffer" shaped, shingle spire of St Mary's Upchurch. A small flock of Brent geese, not yet returned to their breeding grounds in the Arctic, were feeding on aquatic vegetation growing in the mud of the creek. It was a warm and sunny day and the air was heavy with the bitter sweet smell of hawthorn blossom. I could hear the rich warble of a blackcap and the scratchy songs of lesser whitethroats in the extensive scrub that lay in front of me. Some of the songsters revealed themselves at their perches. I listened in vain for the soft, purring notes of a turtle

dove. From distant reed beds, owned by The Kent Wildfowling and Conservation Association, emanated the familiar sound of a cuckoo, which later flew by me. I recognised its slim body, pointed wings and a long tail. Feeding on the long grasses adjoining the reed beds was a herd of beef cattle. The sun was shining in the rag stone tower of St Margaret's Parish Church, about a mile and a half away. On the horizon were the North Downs.

According to the RSPB, we have lost six out of ten visiting cuckoos and nine out of ten visiting turtle doves since 1970. The cuckoo has a highly specialised diet feeding almost exclusively on caterpillars, many of which are hairy and sometimes toxic. One toxic caterpillar is that of the cinnabar moth. It has yellow and black bands around its body, which is full of deadly poison from the ragwort that it feeds on. It is not clear whether a lack of caterpillars is adversely affecting the cuckoo. As for turtle doves, their plight may be attributed to their being shot or trapped migrating through Europe and to the use of herbicides on the short lived weeds, such as fumitory, on which they freed whilst in this country. Turtle doves can still be found at the Countryside Park and so, on another sunny day in early May, I headed for the Lower Rainham Road. I was told by a warden in the visitor centre that a number of nightingales were in song on Eastcourt Meadows but, so far, no turtle doves had been seen or heard. For hundreds of years the meadows consisted of grazing land but, until some years ago, they were used as a municipal rubbish dump. They are now covered in trees and scrub (the latter being mostly of hawthorn and bramble) and are the breeding ground of many species of birds such as dunnock, chaffinch, song thrush, lesser whitethroat and nightingale. As I had been led to believe by the warden, I did indeed hear the song (or part song) of nightingales. Three of them confined themselves to characteristic "choc" "choc" bubbling notes and only one of them went on to give the complete, rich, loud warble, with repetitions, that comprises the males' song. Quite unexpectedly, as I was walking up a grass ride set out for horse riders, I noticed what at first I assumed to be a collared dove feeding on the low vegetation of the ride. Through my binoculars I could see the bird's pinkish breast and throat and the orange performed in most of Medway's historical theatre and buff chequered pattern on its wings. It was a turtle venues including The Theatre Royal, The Empire and dove. It flew into a grey poplar tree from which came the Royal Hippodrome, the company was eager to the unmistakable call of a turtle dove, a soft, soporific celebrate their centenary within Medway and so will purring sound which is quite distinct from the cooing calls of the collard dove. I was able to announce to the on Saturday November 1st at the Central Theatre in warden, before I left, that I had both seen and heard my first turtle dove of the season.

The company continued to perform during this period by performing concert parties to keep people entertained. Once hostilities were over they took up where they left off and produced many musicals including Rose Marie, Me and My Girl, Seven Brides for Seven Brothers, West Side Story and even The Full Monty! Since then the Kentish Players or KP's as they are affectionately known has produced at least one major musical annually along with countless concerts and revues. The history of their productions serves as a snapshot of the development of musical theatre as they transitioned from Gilbert and Sullivan through Rogers and Hammerstein to the modern juke box musical seen sorts of media. All free to the general public. so frequently in the West End today.

The centenary production at the Hazlitt Theatre Maidstone from 18th to the 21st of June is a classic example of this genre of musical. All Shook Up is the hip-swivelling, lip-curling musical inspired by and featuring the songs of Elvis Presley. This show will have you jumping out of your blue suede shoes with such classic Elvis hits as "Jailhouse Rock", "A Little Less Conversation" and "Heartbreak Hotel", as it follows a guitar-playing motorbike-riding roustabout as he turns a small town on its head and changes everything and everyone he meets.

As Medway's oldest amateur musical theatre society the company still conduct all their rehearsals in the Medway Towns but often appear in Maidstone for productions. But as a Medway society who have

also be hosting 'An evening with the Kentish Players' Chatham. The evening will be a fantastic trip down memory lane for supporters of KPs and lovers of musical theatre alike.

Other events during the year include quizzes (centenary themed of course), beach trips and a dinner and dance which will provide further opportunities for members, family and friends to celebrate together in this special year. There is even a book being produced to celebrate this event with contributions from many current and former members.




