

WIGMORE HUTS Dear Editor

I was very interested in the photo on the May 2015 issue of Action Forum. I do not recognise the actual

house but many years ago as a child I lived in one very much like it.

It was called 'Glenkendy' and as far as I can recall it was owned by someone from London. Most of these houses, were owned as an escape to the country. Ours was in the old Bredhurst Road (unmade in those days), if the plots were sold for £10 what a bargain! The garden back and front was huge and Dad grew all we needed for a growing family. Veggies, fruit trees and soft fruit - it was idyllic.

Alas Dads health was not good as he was gassed serving in the First World War so always had problems. He worked in the Dockyard and cycled to and from work but eventually found this impossible so we moved to Holding Street. How Mum must have missed that garden to help feed us.

I have very fond memories of our time in Wigmore and often think about them. It would be interesting to know if any of the original homes are still lived in.

Dear Editor,

I lived in Ivy Cottage on Gads Hill in my childhood. On the left hand side going down Waterside Lane was the Zion Church where we went to Sunday School, there was also a very tall house where Mr and Mrs Croydon lived with their four children. On the left there was a Lane with on the corner one big and then several small cottages. We would often go there to listen to Mr Walker play his accordion on Sundays. I believe he was Irish. Further down Waterside Lane on the left were two old cottages and at the bottom a water outlet with a wall. In the summer this was a meeting place to chat and swim then venture across the water to a small mud island.

Turn to the left and there were two houses down steps, my cousin Lily Obee lived in the first. A footpath led to the Strand past allotments. If you turned to the right there were more cottages and a big house where Mr & Mrs Groves (manager of the cement works) lived. So many memories come flooding back to me. The post office at the top of Gads Hill, Mr & Mrs Wickham and daughter Sheila, Mr & Mrs Bromley with Doreen, Robert and James their children, a shop next which had packets of seeds in the window, Mr & Mrs Murrel lived here, There was a small shop tucked in the corner where we got our sweets and comics, then a Greengrocers kept by Mr & Mrs Small, Mr Alfie Hart had an orchard and a coal round, there was a Butchers on the corner on the left of Ivy Cottages. I remember Mrs Thorp and children Jean, Len and Ken, Mrs Taylor with Jean, Eileen and John, Jacks Stores and so many more people.

At the bottom of Gads Hill there still remains a small building where the siren was during the war. I moved from Gads Hill, where I lived with my

brother Gordon and sisters Betty, Shirley and Daphne, when I was 15 years old, I am now 81 but remember it so well.

Nature Notes

NATURE NOTES FOR JUNE

It is claimed that there are more ancient trees in this country than anywhere else in Northern Europe. At Richmond Park alone there are about 900 ancient trees, more (it is said) than in France and Germany combined On the other hand, Britain has poor forest cover compared with European countries and none of it remains in its original state. But those ancient and untouched forests which still exist in Eastern Europe, for example, do not necessarily allow individual trees to survive to a great age Competition with other trees causes them to grow tall and thin so that they fall prematurely. Many of Britain's ancient trees (including those in Richmond Park) are a legacy of hunting from the time of William the Conqueror onwards. The sport required fairly open land over which horses could gallop but dotted with free standing trees to provide cover and shelter for the deer. These trees grew outwards rather than upwards and, today, those that have survived are massive, gnarled and misshapen.

In June I visited Godinton House and Park near Ashford, in the valley of the Great Stour. The approach by car to the house is through parkland studded with many, very old, magnificent trees. The red brick, largely Jacobean house is open to the public in the summer, as are the three attractive gardens (formal, walled and Italian) and a wild flower meadow best seen in the spring. Facing the front entrance to the house is a large and untidy heap of timber, all that remains of a great oak said to have existed at the time of Domesday The great tree fell to the ground on 3rd September 1939, the day on which Neville Chamberlain announced that this country was at war with Germany. Having parked my car and paid for a ticket to the grounds only, I commenced on a walk around the parkland and adjoining water meadows, largely by means of public footpaths. The main trees in the parkland were ash, beech, horse chestnut, oak. London plane, sweet chestnut and sycamore. Beef cattle stood in the shade of one large oak, chewing the cud and swishing flies with their tails. Many new trees had been planted over the past few years, protected

from grazing cattle (and any wild deer) by rings of chestnut palings. A distinctive and uniform browsing line on trees throughout the parkland, a few feet above the ground, confirmed that cattle are indeed fond of young leaves.

Some old trees, especially oaks, are referred to as "stag headed" because they sport dead boughs which resemble the antlers of a stag I noted a few of them at Godington. These dead boughs have lost their leaves as a result of retrenchment by the tree in old age; they may not rot and fall off for nearly a century, long after the tree has adjusted to a smaller crown. Fortunately, there is a growing recognition that "stag headed" trees are not dying and do not need to be cut down. In due course I arrived at the water meadows of the Great Stour, overlooked by the tower of Great Chart church, and in which sheep were grazing. The spiky stems of clumps of compact rush indicated that the meadows were indeed waterlogged, at least in part. A large flock of jackdaws were feeding in the meadows, among the sheep. The existence of molehills showed that the meadows had not been ploughed for many years, if at all, presumably because of the regular threat of flooding. Growing beside the wet ditches feeding the Great Stour were meadow sweet and great willow herb or codlings and cream. Alongside the river itself were crack willow and alder trees and above it banded demoiselle dragon flies flew in search of insect prey. On my way back to Godington House, and a cup of tea and a cake in the restaurant. I came across a dead beech tree which had presumably died suddenly and quickly in the previous summer. Because their roots are extremely shallow, beeches are vulnerable to droughts and to gales. Consequently, they rarely exceed two centuries in age. The 18th century naturalist. The Reverend Gilbert White, described the beech as "A truly noble tree. The most lovely of all forest trees, whether we consider its smooth rind or bark, its glossy foliage, or graceful, pendulous boughs." There the Godinton beech stood, with its smooth bark and graceful, pendulous boughs. Only its glossy foliage was missing. It was as if, where the tree stood, it was still winter, whilst everywhere else summer had arrived. It was quite surreal.

UPCHURCH AT WAR IN 1915

Upchurch residents continued their daily lives as the war raged on but most had little idea about the reality of the conflict apart from what they read in newspaper Fund for Soldiers and Sailors,' the 'Belgian children' reports and heard from servicemen who returned home and for the 'YMCA Hut Scheme.' on leave.

an article appeared in the East Kent Gazette dated March 6th 1915 accusing the village of lacking patriotism, stating that men of fighting age were not joining up. The article ended with the words,

Wake up my lads! Seize the chance of your lifetime and lay a just claim to honour your existence as

This proved to be unjustified as 140 men from the village joined up to fight during the war including Alfred and James Robinson from Ham Green who were amongst the first of the 1915 volunteers. The fervour of patriotism continued on Sunday June 5th, 1915 when a troop of the East Kent Mounted Rifles rode into the village for an open-air recruitment meeting beside the church. At the meeting Reverend Trew urged the troop captain to persuade mothers present to commit their sons to join up, Richard Wakeley of 'Wakeley Brothers' gave a patriotic speech and Holywell headmaster Mr. Maltravers raised the Union Jack flag above the Infant's School. James Hatton and Fred Godfrey were the only recorded Upchurch fatalities at the battle front during 1915. James Hatton served as a private in The Buffs and after enlisting in 1909 he served in Singapore and Ireland before going to the European mainland with the British Expeditionary Force in 1914. He was killed on February 27th 1915. Fred Godfrey served as a private in the Buffs but perished on the Western Front on November 26th 1915. Born in Teynham he lived at NEWINGTON VILLAGE FESTIVAL Ham Green.

On a more pleasing note George Marsh from Forge Lane joined up in 1914 and after fighting in France with the British Expeditionary Force he gained promotion to sergeant then to staff sergeant in August and September 1914. He later became attached to the RAMC taking charge of motor convoy workshops. Throughout the year Holywell School raised money for the war. In May 1915 pupils presented a show in aid of St Bart's Hospital and raised £5. Fund raising activities continued under the direction of teachers Mr Admission £2, under 16s free. See Facebook for and Mrs Maltrayers. Later in December 1915 a bazaar regular updates. Festival programme available locally

at the School raised £12/3/10d for Princess Mary's Fund. The Young Patriots also raised £30 for organisations like 'HRH Princess Mary's Christmas

Several incidents in Upchurch included the arrest of Although Upchurch men had joined the Armed Forces Private William Duley, of the 5th Battalion Middlesex Regiment for being absent from the army without leave while the police forced local inventor Mr Mantle from Bayford House in Poot Lane out of the parish under instructions from the military and later charged and arrested him under the Defence of the Realm Act. They alleged that he had acted in a way prejudicial to public safety. He fought the case through his MP and it went to the Under-Secretary of State in the House of Commons. The charges were eventually overturned and Mr Mantle returned to Bayford House then after suing the government for wrongful arrest he moved away from the area.

> At the end of 1915 not much optimism existed for a quick end to the war as more village boys joined the forces while the opposing sides fought for small gains with massive casualties along the Western Front.
