Forty years later in 1965 the new Parish of South Gillingham proudly unveiled their modern purpose built St Matthew's Church and Community Centre in Drewery Drive. Editorial

Ninety years ago Wigmore was a new young suburb of Rainham. Until the reservoir was constructed at the southern end of Maidstone Road it was not possible to pipe water to this area so land use was severely restricted. However when the reservoir was built this immediately released many acres of mostly woodland for speculative development. Elaborate plans were drawn for the road grid and unmade tracks soon appeared. £10 plots of land on these tracks were eagerly acquired by 'townies 'from Chatham and Gillingham. Originally the plots were used as weekend include you on the guest list. As always, there is no woodland retreats in the country. Soon though wooden charge and, if required, transport can be arranged. huts appeared and, once water was available, homes for residential accommodation. Despite the notable lack of amenities the community rapidly grew and began creating their own facilities. The Small Holders Club in Woodside offered entertainment, companionship and an outlet for surplus produce. Church services were conducted by the clergy of St Margaret's Church in Rainham as Wigmore was within Rainham Parish which shared boundaries with Upchurch, Hartlip, Bredhurst, Lidsing, St Mary's Gillingham and the river Medway.

Provisions and services were provided by Rainham, The Co-op and other stores had delivery vans which made regular visits so it was possible to buy your bread, milk, meat and greengrocery without making the long walk down Maidstone Road. Telegrams - the only method of urgent communication came via a delivery boy on his bicycle from Rainham Post Office. Life was hard but as you can see from the recent correspondence very fondly remembered by those who led the life. Now South Gillingham Parish is marking 90 years of ministry and 50 years of St Matthew's Church in Wigmore with a Flower Festival over the first weekend of October. You will be very welcome to join them in their celebrations. Coincidentally Wigmore MADS also celebrate their golden anniversary at this time with a special concert of favourite music from the past 50 years on October 9th & 10th. They will be delighted if you are able attend. Much more also for you within our pages - it seems we are no sooner back from our summer holidays than we are thinking of Harvest Teas, Autumn Shows, fund raising Quiz Nights and dare I whisper it Christmas! Do read on to see what else is happening over the next month and we will see you again in October, no doubt

thinking of autumnal tints, Halloween and Bonfire Night, Until then have a very good month. N.B. Apparently the money for the flower planters in Rainham comes from an allowance the three Rainham Central Ward Councillors Rehman Chisti, Barry Kemp and Mike O'Brien have to use in the area.

WIGMORE HUTS

Dear Editor

I have been very interested in the articles headed Wigmore Huts which have featured in the May and July editions of Action Forum.

My father purchased 200ft fronting Woodside in 1914 for £25, followed a year later with another 200ft joining to Oxford Road (the old name for Asquith Road), for the cheaper sum of £20.

My younger days were very like Mrs E. Naylor, who wrote in July. Home grown vegetables and fruit etc ' enough to feed all the family. I lived in a small dwelling built in 1922, just two rooms and a very small kitchen and of course my fathers Hut. Like many of my generation this type of accommodation

was quite normal. But please don't call them huts, they were our homes, they were very cosy and we loved them.

I can remember at the age of 8 being so excited when we had running water and then electricity laid on. My home was lived in by my parents until the 1980s, when my husband and I had a brick built bungalow constructed to the front at the Woodside end of the property, where I still live.

My Grandfather and Father were some of the original members of the Small Holders Club, when home grown fruit and veg from their smallholdings was bought or exchanged - hence the name Small Holders. My father was a keen photographer, and most of the photos of Old Wigmore were taken by him.

I wonder if Mrs Naylor (nee Adie) is from the same Rainham family as Tom Adie, a friend of my brother many years ago. I would be very interested to know.

Nature Notes

NATURE NOTES FOR AUGUST

In August I visited Beachy Head near Eastbourne in Sussex. As I stood on the top of the Head and looked inland, the agricultural landscape was one of fields of sheep and cattle. There was not an arable field in sight. Between 1926 and 1931 Eastbourne Corporation bought 4, 100 acres of land from the Duke of Devonshire, comprising four contiguous farms and Beachy Head itself. The Corporation's aim was to preserve what remained of the ancient down land from the plough. However, the need for the country to become self sufficient in wheat during the Second World War was a setback for the Corporation's aim. Over the years, nevertheless, the land has been gradually put down to grass but virtually all of the remaining ancient down land is now confined to the land between Beachy Head Road and the top of the chalk cliffs. Beachy Head forms the eastern end of the South Downs. Growing on the chalk cliff face are plants such as wild parsnip, rock samphire, sea bindweed and rock sea lavender, which are able to withstand wind blown salt spray. I caught a glimpse of the famous red and white lighthouse at the base of the cliffs. It looked so forlorn and diminutive, viewed from the cliff top. The birds that nest on the cliff include rock pipits, fulmars, herring gulls, jackdaws and peregrine falcons. The peregrines prey on the other inhabitants of the cliffs.

Beachy Head is one of the many landfalls along the south coast at which migrating birds, such as wheatears, enter and leave the country. In times past, many shepherds in Sussex, including those in the Beachy Head area, supplemented their income by trapping wheatears for the table. Those wheatears that come to Britain to breed tend to nest mainly in our upland areas. Typically, they nest in holes on or near to the ground into which they bolt when alarmed. They can be readily recognised by their white rumps. The shepherds' traps were called "coops" and were set between July and September to catch wheatears returning, across the Channel, to France. The traps were laid in tunnels under the down land turf. If conditions were not suitable for the birds to cross the

Channel they sheltered from the weather and predators in the tunnels and were caught. They could be gathered in their hundreds and were worth a penny each. What the shepherds would not have known was that the birds' winter quarters were in West Africa. Still less would they have known that some of the wheatears flying over Beachy Head and elsewhere were passage migrants, having nested in either Northern Canada or Greenland and arrived here via Iceland. To have ended up in a "coop" on the South Downs was an unworthy end for such a delightful and remarkable bird as the wheatear.

The short, springy turf along the cliff edge at Beachy Head is kept low by the incessant tread of people and by coastal winds and very little of interest grows there. However, I noted, away from the footpaths, such typical chalk down land flowers as vipers' bugloss, stem less or dwarf thistle ("picnickers peril"), greater knapweed, marjoram and wild thyme. These flowers had attracted bumble bees and marbled white, chalkhill blue and meadow brown butterflies. Also inland from the cliff top is scrubland of mainly hawthorn and privet. The trees and shrubs are bent over by the sea winds and sculpted into grotesque shapes. Birds such as linnets, and whitethroats nest in the scrub. Yellow hammers, meadow pipits and skylarks breed in the rough grass at Beachy Head. I paused to admire Belle Tout Lighthouse, beyond which the soil is deeper and the flowers grow taller. I came across clustered bellflower, harebell and carline thistle whose yellow bracts are so pale as to look as though they are dead. I soon came to Birling Gap where a shingle beach separates the cliffs of Beachy Head from those of the Seven Sisters. I decided to divert to a working down land farm just down the road in East Dean. As I approached it I came across a massive, mixed flock of rooks, jackdaws and black headed gulls resting on grassland at the farm. It was the biggest gathering of these birds that I had ever seen. The farm is centred on a 17th century Sussex barn built of flints and around which a couple of swallows were flying. The farm was packed out with families whose children could feed the orphan lambs and meet farmyard favourites such as goats, pigs and chickens. It was clearly not for me and so I went back

to Birling Gap and the National Trust café, shop and visitor centre, where a solitary, elderly, birdwatcher in a Panama hat would not look or feel out of place.

A NEW LEASE OF LIFE

When the committee of the Friends of Berengrave Nature Reserve met in June, they decided that the time had come to face the inevitable and wind up the association. It had become too difficult to persuade people to stand for election as officers. So an Extraordinary General Meeting of the members was called. However, the committee's recommendation was rejected by a large majority.

The E. G. M. should have been followed immediately by the association's A. G. M., but the meeting broke up before it could take place. Instead it happened in July. The result was that a new committee was elected to lead the Friends, and the membership was reinvigorated by signs of new interest on the part of Medway Council, including attendance of their Volunteer Officer.

Those elected are Chair: the Revd Canon Nicholas Kerr: Honorary Treasurer: Mr Eddy Newport: Honorary Secretary: Mrs Pat Clare. Also elected were Mrs Liz Arnold, Mr Brian Baker, Mr Harry Keane, Mr Richard Lusted and Mrs Phyllis Platt. Canon Kerr is a relative newcomer to the association. He and his wife retired to Rainham in 2011 to be near their daughter and son-in-law. It was not long after his arrival that he learned of the existence of the Friends and paid his first subs. However, Canon and Mrs Kerr were not entirely strangers to the district. Their second daughter was born in Chatham, when Canon Kerr was serving as Assistant Curate of St. Margaret, Rainham, between 1980 and 1984, and Mrs Kerr was working as a Staff Nurse at the Medway Hospital. Mr Newport had previously served as Treasurer before becoming Chair in 2014. Mr Baker was the first Chair and now manages the Friends' Website and the quarterly Newsletter. Mrs Clare has served as Secretary for a number of years. Berengrave Nature Reserve consists mostly of the old chalk pit which is bounded by Lower Rainham Road to the north, Berengrave Lane to the west, Chalky Bank Road to the south and private land to the east. It connects with Rainham Dock East, Riverside Country Park and Motney Hill. The Friends have been responsible for carrying out some very significant archaeological research to do with the

history of the chalk pit. You can find out lots more about this and other facets of the association's work on the Website, www.friendsofberengrave.btck.co.uk. The new committee has proposed four meetings in the coming year, which will be held at Rainham Cricket Club in Berengrave Lane. It is hoped that speakers will be found to give presentations on a variety of topics around Natural History and Nature Conservation. The first will take place on Friday 9th October, at 7.30p.m. Look out for announcements in Action Forum.


