

A settlement with a few houses along Hempstead Road has existed for several hundred years, known in the 1600s as 'Hemsted'. The hamlet's original farmhouse still stands. According to Wikipedia 'lands owned by this farm bequeathed to regional administration have become today's "Hempstead Playing Fields". In Geoffrey Huftons book 'Off The Beaten Track' he states 'In 1890 the Old Farmhouse and Farm had been bought by a solicitor named Brake. He split the farm into smaller plots and offered them for sale. The 'Chatham News' of 1st September 1900 carried the following advertisement HEMPSTEAD ESTATE Near LUTON Freehold Plots 20 x 20 feet Price £10 each (may be paid in instalments). ## **Editorial**

For the last two years all of our attention has been focusing on the many anniversaries of the Great War, most recently the beginning of the Somme campaign. Rather slipping under the radar is the forthcoming 950th anniversary of the great Battle of Hastings fought between the Saxons and Normans in 1066 at Battle in East Sussex presumably so named in honour of the event. It is the one date that we all know from childhood immortalised in the title of the humorous book by W.C. Sellar and R.J. Yeatman '1066 and All That' which was the layman's guide to all important historical dates before the advent of the 'Horrible Histories' series of books. Considering that this was actually a defeat of the native army by the conquering Normans it is strange that it is so indelibly engraved on our memories. The Bayeux Tapestry reinforces the image with the dramatic depiction of the death of King every lamp post and other similar bits of street Harold. Battle Abbey, the location of where he fell with the arrow in his eye, has recently moved a stone marking the site of his death to a spot about 20 feet away from the already revised 1980 position. Possibly a more accurate assessment but also a good publicity ploy at the beginning of the holiday season! Anyway it anyone interested a very good idea of the mode and made me take notice and pass on the information so well done to the publicists - it worked. I hope the Abbey gets the visitors it deserves on this historic occasion. John Austin in a letter on this page suggests local children should be encouraged to remember the actual date, October 14th, with an army of craft work soldiers around Rainham. This would need substantial planning so there is probably not enough time now to fulfil the ambition but perhaps local schools could do something on their own premises so a new generation of Brits will be able to recall with certainty at least one important date from our history.

Coincidentally Joe Ennis visits East Sussex in Nature Notes this month. He describes a visit to the Kent and East Sussex Railway and Bodium Castle so should you wish to see King Harold's revised death site and time travel back to 1066 you could combine the two locations for a great day out.

The holidays have only just begun but already many of our readers are thinking of the new academic year. If you are part of the silver hair brigade and keep thinking you really should astonish your grandchildren by learning at least the basics of that computer they insisted you needed - now is your chance. The pupils

#### HEMPSTEAD THE OLD FARMHOUSE: (1932 - c.1990)

'The Old Farmhouse', (once known as 'Hempstead House') stands in Harrow Road behind the 'Flying Saucer'. Originally the house fronted onto Hempstead Road, but in the early 1940's the owner (my Grandfather) sold land to the brewers that included the frontage - and a derelict bowling green that was directly in front of the house. This had the unfortunate effect of cutting the house off from Hempstead Road, hiding the property behind a high fence and also spoiling the view.

Actually 'The Old Farmhouse' was not only one house but really two houses! Facing Harrow Road is the Georgian section known as 'Hopewell House', (insisted by some to be a mis-spelling of 'Hop Well'), was born and the well was dry anyway! Sadly, the which had two bedrooms, two living rooms, two sculleries, one inside and one outside toilet, a front door, a side door (and several interior doors opening into the 'Old Farmhouse' itself). 'Hopewell House' was always home to tenants but my Grandparents always inhabited the 'Old Farmhouse' side, so it was that they and various relatives lived on one side whilst my parents and the tenants on the other! I grew up fed on a hodge-podge of stories relating to so large it was possible to crawl right inside. About the lovely Tudor side - how the massive black beams across the ceilings had once been parts of sailing ships and had the notches to prove it. I heard about the beams in the kitchen that had been replaced when my Grandfather set fire to a pot of tar he had been heating on the grate of the inglenook fireplace. and was told how 'The Old Farmhouse' was not originally a farm house at all but had started life as a hunting lodge - there was even a theory that Elizabeth Tudor had come to visit and hunt the wild boar and deer that inhabited the dense forest area. In Harrow Road was a large barn called 'The Hollies', once it had been one of several barns belonging to

'The Old Farmhouse' but now it was owned by Mr Gorf, our neighbour.

I understood that in the early 1900's my Grandparents had bought the house and much land from two spinster ladies named the Miss Catts. I know it had once belonged to a Charlotte Wraikes but have never been able to verify anything about the Miss Catts so maybe they were only renting? I once had access to old deeds when choosing a name for my own house and discovered a very early owner had been a Sir Richard de Wildash, a good name (Wildash) for a house, I thought!

Outside of the kitchen was a rather ornate pump, made of cast iron and weighing a ton! I never knew it to be used as mains water was connected before I top of the pump was stolen about 1990 - perhaps for scrap?

The three sculleries in the two abodes were extremely primitive with flint walls and uneven brick floors, concrete coppers, cold water taps and shallow sinks. At one end of the 'Old Farmhouse' was a room with a sloping roof known as the 'End Place'. Here there was a wonderful brick built oven, 1950 my Aunt (Mrs Waters) purchased the property from my then widowed Grandmother and had the 'End Place' and brick oven demolished- also the flint built sculleries. The whole house (s) had been allowed to deteriorate badly and during the war heavy gunfire, shrapnel etc. had contributed to the dreadful condition of the roof. In fact it was quite possible to stand on the ground floor in some parts and see the sky. Now the whole house was repaired, a new bathroom put in and one kitchen built to replace the sculleries. There would be no more tenants!

With only my Aunt and Uncle occupying the house that had always been home to so many people, it seemed that much of the atmosphere was lost. Empty rooms that had once been warmed by logs and coal fires were now cold and damp, and gradually the whole place took on a feeling of decay as my Aunt became older and less able to notice the deterioration. By the time she died the poor old house was in much the same state it had been in when she had first moved in!

## Nature Notes

#### NATURE NOTES FOR JULY

On a sunny July day, of some time ago, my wife and I went on a boat trip on the River Rother from Newenden to Bodiam Castle and made the return journey by a steam hauled train of the Kent and East Sussex Railway. Newenden, one of the smallest of Kent's villages, is on the border with East Sussex. It has a small church, a public house (the White Hart) and a cricket pitch with a pavilion that stands in the shade of a massive oak tree.

We boarded the motor vessel "Dannie Lee" at Newenden Bridge. Teas can be had, before or after sailing, at Riverside Cottage alongside the bridge. The River Rother has fairly high banks on the stretch to Bodiam Castle and the view from the boat was therefore somewhat limited. However, the trip was a relaxing one and there was plenty to see, from a natural history point of view, on or alongside the river. Waterside plants to be seen in July included meadow sweet, purple and vellow loosestrife and great willow herb or "codlins and cream". We heard the rattling notes of a sedge warbler emanating from the common reeds that line the river. We saw many dragon and damsel flies, including the banded demoiselle, one of our largest damsel flies. The male has a metallic blue abdomen and a broad, blue black band to its wings. The banded demoiselle has a butterfly-like flight. It can often be abundant on slow moving rivers with tall vegetation, such as the River Rother.

We alighted from the boat just before Bodiam Bridge and entered the grounds of Bodiam Castle which was built in the 14th century, is surrounded by a moat and is owned by the National Trust. The castle towers serve as places where, during the summer, three species of bat, Daubenton's, Natterer's and pipistrelle roost and the females of the species give birth. The first two species are medium sized bats and the third is Britain's smallest and commonest bat. The maternity roosts are occupied from May to August, and sometimes into September. The males roost separately, sometimes all three species together. In the heat of a summer's day, bats often move about inside the roost sites and there is plenty of chattering,

especially in the maternity colonies. Droppings litter the floors of the towers in which the bats and their young roost. The droppings are small, dark, oval shaped and crumbly.

Daubenton's bats feed over water and, at Bodiam, they fly low over the castle moat and the River Rother in search of insects such as caddis flies. The Natterer's bats hunt among trees where they pick flies and small moths off leaves and twigs. Pipistrelles are the species to be found flying over domestic gardens and around houses in search of flies and small beetles. They have a rapid, jerky flight. In due course we had a cup of tea and a cake at the National Trust restaurant. We were entertained by some very cheeky house sparrows and chaffinches mopping up crumbs on plates that had not been cleared away. On our way to Bodiam Station we crossed over the River Rother by means of a three arched 18th century bridge. We noted that the native plants in the river were being crowded out by masses of Himalayan Balsam, an introduced plant, which is becoming a nuisance in many of the country's rivers. At Bodiam Station we climbed aboard a train to be hauled by a former Great Western Railway Pannier Tank steam engine No 1638. Once on the move we had a view, out of the left hand window of the carriage, of the fields alongside the River Rother, which are lined with fresh water dykes. Mute swan were swimming in some of the dykes, in one case among a raft of yellow water lilies. Some of the fields were arable and were producing oil seed rape, wheat, maize and mowing grass. Jackdaws and rooks were feeding in a field littered with large hay bales bound with black plastic polythene. Other fields were in use for the grazing of beef cattle and sheep. The view out of the right hand window was one of woods and small fields typical of the Sussex Weald. The tower of Ewhurst Green church stood out

prominently on the high ridge of the Weald. The flowers we spotted from the train included foxgloves, rose bay willow herb, tansy and fleabane. The regular sightings of oast houses and of escaped hops growing in festoons over line-side hedges and fences were an indication that hops were once commonly grown in the area. The brewers Guinness once had extensive hop gardens in the vicinity of Bodiam Station which,

in days gone by, was busy with the comings and goings of hop pickers from London. We alighted at Northiam Station a short distance, by footpath, to where we had left our car at Newenden Bridge.

When the hurricane struck in 1987, folk jokingly remarked that "The Old Farmhouse' was the only building in the village to remain undamaged - because the wind went straight through", no exaggeration! Now the property went on the market and was purchased by a developer. Hopes that this meant the house would be repaired etc. were soon confounded! An application had been received by the Council for the building to be demolished, and for a number of houses to be built on the land! Happily the Council were quick to put on a preservation order but still substantial damage was inflicted by heavy plant throbbing close to the walls. Villagers were appalled and rallied support in every way possible, but for some Parkwood Community Centre, Rainham, ME8 9PN ownership, until there were fears it would fall down unless something was done quickly. Today, thanks to the farseeing Murphy family, 'The Old Farmhouse' stands as proud as ever. Picked down to a skeleton and rebuilt brick by brick i

now graces the very small plot left by the builders and more than holds its own against modern neighbours. It may have gained another dormer window and a bathroom or two but who cares? 'The Old Farmhouse' remains what it has always been since Tudor days the heart of Hempstead.
