WIGMORE FOOTBALL CLUB in 1968

I enclose a photo of the first football team to play in Wigmore. I founded the team in 1967 and was secretary. We played in the Medway Towns Minor League, for one season only, as most of us left the area to go to university. We comprised mainly my fellow 17 and 18 year old pupils from Gillingham Grammar School, which did not play the round ball game. We are now all in our mid 60's.

We played home games on the only field at Kings Frith, between Wigmore Road and Bredhurst Road that was formal grass: the rest were still overgrown paddocks. Our changing room was in an unimproved pigsty, near the prefabs, which can be seen in the background of the photo. Gillingham Council charged us 7/6d rent per game. I made the goal posts and marked out the touchlines etc.

The photo was taken at the end of our final game, which we lost 3-5 to Cliffe, the champions, a reasonable score, bearing in mind that our leading scorers, Pete Samwell and Micky Nash, were missing. We also ran an under 16 team, which played for two seasons and for whom Dave Abbey, John Steadman, Keith Sharman, Kevin Nichol and others played. I haven't met the majority of my team-mates whose names are listed under the photograph on page 1, since 1968 but would be glad to hear from anyone who wishes to get in touch.

Nature Notes

NATURE NOTES FOR AUGUST

"I do like to stroll upon the Prom, Prom, Prom, / where the brass bands play 'Tiddely-om-pom-pom'!" Music Hall song. John A Glover-Kind 1907. Deal, here in Kent, on the English Channel coast, has a long maritime history and has become a popular seaside town, despite not having the benefit of a sandy beach. I visited the town in August of last year. First of all, I walked along the pier which was lined with anglers. It was good to see that many of them were parents and their children. Enquiries of one family revealed that they were hoping to catch a bass or two. From the cafe at the end of the pier I could see, to the north, Ramsgate and, to the south, ships entering and leaving the Port of Dover. Straight ahead of me, I had a superb view of the buildings along Deal sea front, which stretch for about a mile and a half, from the remains of Henry VIII's Sandown Castle at one end to his Deal Castle at the other. The buildings range mostly from the 17th to the 19th centuries and there is not a modern, high rise building among them. It is a delightful view of perhaps the longest, oldest, most unspoilt sea front in the country. I then walked southwards along the sea front, in the direction of Dover. I passed a small fleet of fishing boats hauled up onto the steep shingle beach. The majority of boats sailing from Kentish ports and beaches are small and they fish as day boats in the English Channel. Catches are relatively modest. In tonnage, whelks are the largest catch but those of sole, wild bass, cod and lobster are the most valuable. I noticed that whelks and jellied eels were on sale at a stall near the entrance to the pier. I also noted a number of boats that were available for hiring by sea anglers. I was told that Deal's coastal waters were among the best for sea angling and that world fishing championships were

I walked past Henry VIII's Deal Castle and, in due course, entered onto the Promenade, by the landward side of which is a well- used paddling pool, a summer only lifeboat station and a bandstand erected in memory of the eleven Royal Marine bandsmen who were killed in the IRA bombing of the Royal Marines

School of Music in 1989. The base of the bandstand has eleven sides, each carrying the name of one of the dead bandsmen. Where the Promenade came to an end I continued in southerly direction down the Saxon Shore Way. Growing on the shingle on the seaward side of the Way were plants which can tolerate salty air. There was fennel, a tall umbellifer, with yellow flowers. It has leaves which smell like aniseed and are used in cooking. There was also sea kale which grows in large clumps and is a member of the cabbage family. When in flower, it has the appearance of oversized cauliflowers. Also growing on the shingle was red valerian or "Kiss me quick", the alternative name being appropriate for plants of those of the species growing at the seaside. Nearer to home, red valerian can be seen growing on the walls of Rochester Castle and on the steep, chalk bank of Chatham Hill. The flower is one of the most strikingly scented of our native species. Finally, there was viper's bugloss which has flowers in spikes that are pink turning vivid blue. They can put on a spectacular show of colour. The Saxon Shore Way was quite busy, not only with pedestrians but also with cyclists. One or two families were having picnics on the shingle. As the music hall song states, we do like to be beside the seaside, we do like to be beside the sea. Loitering near the picnickers were fierce looking herring gulls, among which squabbles would occasionally break out as to which gull was first in the pecking order. I also passed by a docile flock of herring gulls resting on the shingle; they were a mixture of adults and immature birds. Every now and again one of the latter would emit a somewhat pathetic squeak, hoping to be fed by one of its parents. They squeaked in vain. After a while I retraced my steps and joined others who had been strolling along the Prom, Prom, Prom. We headed towards the Royal Marines Bandstand where we were to listen to a concert given by the City of Canterbury Brass Band. A Union Jack hung down limply in the still air. The Walls Ice Cream man was doing a roaring trade. The concert got off to a rousing start with "Knightsbridge March". My favourite piece of the total of fourteen on the programme was an arrangement of Irving and Berlin's "Putting on the Ritz". The audience was a mostly elderly one. On


