Editorial

Walking has long been recognised as an excellent form of therapy if not curing at least alleviating many ills. It is generally accepted that brisk walking outside in the fresh air is better than on a treadmill in the gym. Extravagant claims are made – if you believe the recent press reports, the single most important thing you can do to make you healthier and add years to your life is to move more and the easiest way to do that is to walk. One study reported that just half an hour a day of moderate paced walking can reduce high blood pressure and cholesterol and cut the risk of a fatal heart attack by half. Further research has concluded that walking can protect against type 2 diabetes, arthritis, depression, memory loss and even Alzheimer's. But even knowing all this I find it very difficult just to go out for a walk. There is always something else that needs doing - often involving sitting at a computer or in front of a TV screen the very worst alternatives! Apparently now many of us spend up to fourteen hours a day sitting when in years gone by we spent those hours standing or walking and were the healthier for it. I can happily walk to collect the daily newspaper and walk to work and back (when war happening then. Their war was the 1914 – 18 it is fine). Recently on holiday in Northumberland walking to see a waterfall, a path round a lake, a forest stroll or woodland circle to find the Gruffalo all had a purpose and were very enjoyable but just to set aside an hour or so to walk and I have a mental block. If you are like me and know you should be exercising more but need a reason to get you moving you are in luck we can help! Each month 20,000 copies of Action Forum are delivered throughout Rainham, Wigmore, Parkwood, Bredhurst, Upchurch and Lower Halstow. We have a hundred plus band of excellent volunteer distributors who post them through your letterbox but inevitably with so many helpers just as I think all areas Occasionally the war talk did return to the present. are fully covered illness, a broken bone, holidays, moving away or someone regretfully giving up reduces our team and we need more assistance. You can help – if you have an hour or so available usually during the first weekend of each month and would like a walk with a purpose please get in touch. A list of the specific roads that currently need distributors is on Page 3. They are grouped in areas but if you are only able to help in one of those named do contact us as every little helps. Equally useful, if you like variety, are volunteers who either have a free bus pass or are

happy to drive (or walk) to roads not immediately on their doorstep and can fill in as needed for holiday cover each month. As the majority of our distributors are of the silver haired brigade most months someone is away! Not only will you be helping Action Forum, think of the health benefits you will gain plus all the money that we previously paid for distribution is now donated to charity to date in the sixteen years since September 2000 £44,550.

Lots is happening this October, Quiz Nights seem particularly popular but Concerts and some early Bazaars also put in an appearance plus of course the many walks arranged by local groups eager for your participation. Do have a very good month, we will be with you again in November.

Correspondence MEMORIES OF WAR TIME

Dear Editor

In the early 1940s it was a weekly habit on Sunday evenings for my father Percy Major, his brothers George, Sidney, Charlie, Bert and sisters Hilda and Bessie with wives and husbands and children, to meet at the Major parental house 67, William Street. My grandad Major and George sat one side of the Kitchener fire, grandma Eliza sat opposite. Around the large room sat their sons and daughters, and around the central table their grandchildren, reading comics, doing puzzles, writing etc.

There would be talk to and fro among the assembled throng about local matters past and present which also included 'the war' 'Eileen Packer's son had been reported missing', 'Bert Newman never got over being a prisoner of war when he came back' and so on. The family talk of 'the war' was not mainly about the latest conflict, because they knew so many involved in it. George Major was in the Royal Navy as he had been aboard local barges, he was on HMS Inflexible and at the Battle of Jutland. The next eldest, Sidney, was in an army regiment, among other postings he served on HMS Ganges. The other sons were too young to serve. On the walls of the room were photographs one of Uncle George in his naval uniform and another of Uncle Sid in army dress, sometimes the two sons sat under their appropriate pictures. My father remembered standing in the back garden and seeing a Zeppelin shot down in flames towards Sheerness The wireless would be put on to hear the nine o'clock news. Various comments would be made about the events mentioned. I remember one concerned the first 1000 bomber raid on Germany.

Looking back how I wish I had written down what they discussed, now a lost insight into what they had experienced but very real to them.



Nature Notes

NATURE NOTES FOR SEPTEMBER

This month's Notes are largely about the birds and wild flowers to be found in St Margaret's churchyard in spring and summer. In later Notes, I shall cover autumn and winter. As for mammals and reptiles, voles could at one time be found under the corrugated iron sheets that the grave diggers used to use. Today, grey squirrels are probably the only wild mammals sometimes seen in the graveyard. In the past, slow worms would occasionally be disturbed by those cutting the long grass, but they may now have disappeared for good. The wild flowers in the churchyard are typical of those to be found throughout the North Downs as a whole. Among the first signs of spring are the yellow petals of the lesser celandines growing under the overhanging branches of the horse chestnut trees in the High Street. The flowers are commonly seen in local woods. The buds of the horse chestnut trees themselves develop their characteristic stickiness in early spring. Cherry blossom, daffodils and spring snowflakes are also harbingers of the new season. Spring time is, of course, the breeding season for birds. A pair of carrion crows have established their territory in the churchyard and built their nest in one of the horse chestnut trees. Their presence may not have been welcome to the blackbirds, song thrushes, green finches and other birds that had their own nests in, or in the vicinity of, the churchyard. In the late spring, the starlings and their young ones could be seen searching for worms and leatherjackets in the mown grass of the churchyard. They would often rest on the parapets and the guy wires of the flag pole, on the top of the church tower. Another bird to be seen occasionally on the tower was a kestrel which, in the absence of small mammals, would doubtless have been prepared to swoop down on any unsuspecting starling.

One of the glories of late spring, and of the High Street, are the masses of white flowers, commonly called "candles", of the horse chestnut trees. Other late spring flowers to be found in the churchyard include common vetch, bird's foot trefoil and those two familiar and well loved species, the buttercup and the

daisy. Summer in the churchyard brings such species as creeping cinquefoil, germander speedwell or bird's eye, ox-eye daisy and wild onion or crow garlic. The latter species grows alongside the footpath from the Cricketers' Car Park to the north door of the church. Crow garlic has greenish white to pink flowers growing out of a compact cluster of bulbils. Butterflies that I noted in the summer, on a buddleia bush, were red admiral, small tortoiseshell and peacock. Other sightings, elsewhere, included holly blue, wall and meadow brown. An ornamental evergreen tree with oval leaves and clusters of small yellow flowers was an absolute magnet for swarms of bees, flies, hover flies and beetles. In the past, I used to thoroughly enjoy sitting in the churchyard on warm, sunny, summer evenings watching large numbers of swifts swooping through the air as the sun went down. However, not only in Rainham, but also throughout the country, the numbers of visiting swifts have fallen dramatically over the past few years. The cause of this seems to be mainly the cold, wet and windy weather during the

birds' breeding season, which adversely affects the availability of insects. Here in Rainham, it appears that swifts are no longer nesting under the eaves of St Margaret's Church. The birds still nevertheless nest behind the wooden soffit boards at the Oast House Community Centre near the railway station and in various nooks and crannies in houses in Hawthorne Avenue. I would be grateful to hear of any other colonies, by phone, on 01634 235182. The reason why none now nest at the church may be disturbance caused by the work done on the church roof some years ago. At the back of the church, long wooden boards blocked access to the eaves but I do not think that the swifts nested on the gravevard side of the church. This is because young swifts need an unobstructed flight path when they leave the nest. If they come to ground they are doomed, unless some kind person picks them up and throws them into the air. The air space at the back of the church is obstructed by gravestones and trees. At the front, the swifts' entrances under the eaves were not obstructed by the workmen but access to them was problematical. One parent bird I saw flew in close to the ground and

under the scaffolding before flying vertically, close to the wall, and then scrambling into the cavity at the top of the wall. In the absence of scaffolding, the young birds would have had a clear flight path into the air above the High Street, unless a double- decker bus happened to be going past at the time. I fear that it may have been the scaffolding facing the High Street that caused the birds to abandon their long-used nesting site at St Margaret's. Whatever the reason, which remains uncertain, I am afraid that we may never again see a large party of juvenile swifts screaming around the church tower and over the church roofs on warm, sunny, summer evenings.

RAINHAM AT WAR IN 1918

With the war in its fourth and final year, 24 Rainham servicemen died in 1918, the most recorded in a single year of the conflict. Early in the year Fred Swan from Ivy Street perished aboard the 'Raglan,' sunk in the Dardanelles Straits while Albert Hadlow aged 22 from Pudding Lane died after being gassed in France. Later in April several Rainham soldiers were reported missing. These included Thomas Mattocks and John Poynter from Wakeley Road, Job Barden from London Road and Frank Perry from Ivy Street. In April more fatalities included former Council School headmaster Harold Greenhalgh, killed by a shell in France, Cecil Bowra aged 20 from Station Road killed by a German shell while the funeral of Leonard Paul aged 29 from Ivy Street took place in Rainham after he had died from the effects of being gassed. Better news revealed that Archibald Rayner from Longley Road had won a commission in the City of London Regiment after twice getting wounded in France while Reg Barrett from Ivy Street aged 25 of the Lancers was mentioned in despatches for gallantry at Bourlan Wood in France. He had spent six hours under heavy shell fire rescuing wounded men and had earlier received the Military Medal for bravery on the Somme. In February John Reeves aged 21 from William Street, serving in the Buffs also received the Military Medal. David Wood




