

Editorial

On a beautiful autumn half term day we decided to share the 'M25 experience' of my weekly visit to the grandchildren near Woking and meet at the British Wildlife Centre (www.britishwildlifecentre.co.uk) just over the border from Kent into Surrey. Although only a 45 minute journey away, on the A22 near Lingfield, the centre was new to me. Created about twenty years ago by an enthusiast on the site of his former dairy farm it is primarily an educational establishment, fully booked for the foreseeable future with school parties and other groups during term time but open to the general public at the weekend and during school holidays. Not cheap, currently £37 for a family of four, but a very good day out if you have primary school aged children or grandchildren to entertain. We arrived soon after 10 when it opened and had to coax our five year and three year old boys away at 4.30pm after the final flying display by four species of native owls (including an enormous eagle owl apparently a pair of these can be found nesting somewhere in Kent). Every half hour throughout the day an informative 10 minute talk was delivered by the enthusiastic, knowledgeable and caring staff introducing the assorted animals. Interaction with and questions from the visitors were welcomed and even though they must have given the talks many times each sounded fresh and original. These are given at the enclosures so we learned about red squirrels with them running around our feet and even jumping on some bystanders. The foxes, wildcats, otters, red deer, badgers and pine martens stayed in their runs but with the reward of food from the keepers delighted us with their antics. Only the hedgehogs it being late October remained resolutely curled up asleep. Even the badgers have learned to wake at 3.00pm for a quick walk around and a snack before returning to the sett until their more normal nightly scavenge. The highlight for Jamie (aged 5) was a stoat running round and round the wire netting alleyways and going to and fro over his head - I think he would have staved there all afternoon if the lure of the playground had not called. All in all a very good day out, lovely for children but there were also teenagers and adults practising their wildlife photography skills with guaranteed sitters although few of them would stay still long enough for me (including the children). Only a couple of months left to prepare for Christmas

so of course we include details of the many Favres Sales, Bazaars and Concerts which will be held during the next few weeks. From a poem "Trees" by Joyce Kilmer, a (male) American writer 1886 – 1918

The large number of the country's ancient oak trees growing in the grounds of Blenheim Palace, but hidden from public view, were in the news earlier in the year. There was, for example, the Countryfile Programme in late August about the Country Fair at Blenheim. We saw a forester felling an ash tree to give one of the ancient oaks more light and space. The Palace's grounds were designed in the early 18th century by Capability Brown, but he left untouched 120 acres of ancient woodland which was once a royal hunting ground, founded by Henry 1 in the 11th century, and known as High Park. Recent investigations by a Kew Garden researcher have shown that the park contains at least sixty oaks which are up to 900 years old. These ancient oaks are believed to have seeded naturally and not to have been planted. Some of these oaks were pollarded in the past, which has had the effect of prolonging their lives. Blenheim Palace claims to be the home of the greatest collection of ancient oaks anywhere in Europe. In his book "Meetings with Remarkable Trees", Thomas Pakenham writes about what he says are the two common oaks with the largest girths in Britain and Ireland - and probably Europe. One is at Bowthorpe, near Bourne, in Lincolnshire and the other is at Fredville Park, at Nonington, here in Kent. Both trees have much the same girth (circumference) at 12 metres (40 feet). The Kent oak is taller at 19 metres (62 feet) because it is a maiden tree, that is, it was never pollarded. Accordingly, it has a tall trunk and a substantial crown, albeit that both are getting smaller as time goes by. It is some 500 - 600 years old. The Bowthorpe Oak was pollarded in the past and thus has a short trunk and a small crown. Because of the lifeextending effect of the pollarding, the Lincolnshire oak is older at 600 - 1000 years of age. Packenham wrote that a onetime squire of Bowthorpe used to sit down to dinner in the tree with twenty friends. He

recalled that the six grandchildren of the farmer who currently lives at Bowthorpe showed off the tree to him as if it were a family pet. They stroked it, petted it and climbed it and, in doing so, disturbed a little owl that was snoozing inside the tree. The author felt that the Lincolnshire oak was more like a cave than a tree; a cavern with branches growing from it.

Twenty years ago Packenham described the Fredville Oak as "still strikingly beautiful" and I was anxious to find out whether this was still the case. I asked Mrs Ennis if she would like to join me in a visit to the Oak but she replied that she was happy enough with seeing some quite impressive oak trees every time she goes up and down the Maidstone Road. It was on my own, therefore, that your Natural History Correspondent headed for East Kent on a sunny October day. The downs between Canterbury and Dover are characterised by sleepy villages, scattered woods, fields of sheep and arable land. It is an area of open skies and little used country lanes. I turned up unannounced at the gatehouse to Fredville Park but there was nobody in. Luckily a local man was working on the adjoining grounds of Nonington Cricket Club and he gave me directions. I was to obtain the permission from the estate's gamekeeper to see the oak. I motored across parkland dotted with sheep and knarled oak and sweet chestnut trees and stopped at a group of cottages outside which immature pheasants were pecking at the ground. It was the gamekeeper's wife who kindly took me to the oak. Surrounded and hidden by other, much younger trees, which shield it from the wind and gales, it is no wonder that the Fredville Oak, with a local name of "Majesty", is so little known. I have not been able to discover when the tree got its name but I shall assume that it was in Victorian times and treat the tree as female. Her main trunk is hollow to the sky. It was as if I was looking up the inside of a ruined, roofless tower. All around the tree, where branches have broken off, there are holes both large and small. Most holes extend through the thin shell of the main trunk, thus giving the appearance of windows in a tall tower. One large branch which has fallen to the ground remains jammed up in the tree and the landowner, John Plumtre, has decreed that it should remain there. After a fairly long

conversation between us, the gamekeeper's wife left me on my own and I spent some time sitting on my portable seat and studying the tree from all angles.
