The White Horse was one of four public houses listed in Rainham in Pigot's 1839 Directory. The other three were The Cricketers, The Green Lion and The George & Dragon, Moor Street. By the 1870s The White Horse boasted 'very fine livery stables', and it was the Liberal Party's headquarters during the election of 1874. This picture shows the newly rebuilt White Horse in about 1900 after the disastrous fire of 1892. (See David Woods article about the fire on page 9). For many years the Inn was run by Charles Adie assisted by his sons. By the end of the 1930s there were garages rather than stables, and aviaries to attract visitors who called for lunch or tea. Sadly after reopening under new management only a year ago the White Horse is now boarded up, having closed last month, giving a rather despondent feel to the centre of Rainham.

BERENGRAVE NATURE RESERVE Dear Editor.

I have been sent a copy of Action Forum by a friend living in Rainham which includes the article about Berengrave Nature Reserve by Joe Ennis (June 2017 no 532)

The concrete blocks and wash mills mentioned in the Nature Notes are the only remains of the original chalk processing built about 1906 by Goldsmiths the barge owning family in preparation for the opening of their cement works on Rainham Creek, Motney. The Goldsmiths did not own this site of the chalk so had to pay the owner for the chalk and flints extracted, this continued until 1932 when the site closed.

I led the team which excavated the wash mill site. Country Park, who manage the site raised concerns over Health and Safety which were never clarified. constructed by me based on the evidence recorded during the dig, and is as accurate as I could make it.

The concrete blocks mentioned could be the six used in pair to mount three vertical ball grinders used to reduce the chalk slurry to a liquid in preparation to being pumped to the works at Rainham Creek, During the period when the Nature Reserve was flooded in 2013/14 the blocks became submerged, meaning the water at this time was four feet deep. The wash pond mentioned are in the area beyond the blocks. The flooding caused considerable damage to the trees and wooden walkways in the reserve, I am now led to believe the walkways are closed to the public.

Nature Notes

NATURE NOTES

This month's notes are mainly about my search for the nightingale, the cuckoo and the turtle dove in the lower Rainham Road Countryside Park, in the months of May, June and early July. All three species are summer visitors. The Park includes Eastcourt Meadows which are covered in hawthorn and other trees and have an understorey mainly of brambles and nettles. Birds such as blackcap, garden warbler, dunnock and white throat nest in the understorey. In early May a Park warden told me that a nightingale had been heard singing on the Meadows, in a triangle of fenced off scrubland. So, on that evening and the next one, I sat on a bench next to the triangle. On both occasions, I heard the songs of chaffinch, blackbird and song thrush, but not nightingale. The thrush often sings well after sunset and its song, which is loud, farcarrying and musical can sometimes be confused with that of the nightingale, as is evidenced by the song line "A nightingale sang in Berkeley Square." As the second evening wore on, I began to ask dog walkers. in some desperation, whether they had heard one. This was all to no avail until one lady said that, one recent evening, she had recorded one, on her mobile, near to where I was sitting. She had played it back to the nightingale, which responded with another long, loud song. I explained to her, although I suspect she knew already, that the nightingale was trying to scare off an imagined intruder into his territory. The lady kindly played her recording twice but there was no response from the triangle or anywhere nearby. I thanked her and said goodbye. As the sun went down, rabbits came out in increasing numbers. I glanced down at an open page of my guidebook on birds. "... a shy, skulking bird keeping to thick vegetation in damp woods, copses and hedges," it noted. How very true! I decided to give up and go home. I was not a happy

I heard my first male cuckoo call, in early May, in the vicinity of the reed beds at the bottom of the Motney Hill Peninsula. These beds are one of the largest of their kind in south east England. They are the habitat, among other birds, of the reed warbler, in whose nests,

along with those of the dunnock and the meadow pipit, the female cuckoo typically lays her eggs. I heard other male cuckoo calls during my visits to the scrubland areas of the park, particularly Eastcourt Meadows. According to the RSPB, we have lost six out of ten visiting cuckoos since 1970. The plight of the turtle dove is more precarious than that of the cuckoo. The RSPB has reported that the bird's breeding population has declined by 90% since 1970 and is now largely confined to eastern and south eastern England. This may be attributable to the doves being shot whilst migrating over the Mediterranean and mainland Europe; and also to the use of herbicides in this country to kill the short-lived weeds such as common fumitory, chickweed and scarlet pimpernel, on the seeds of which the birds mainly feed. The RSPB and other bodies are encouraging farmers to grow certain flowers on bare land and landowners generally to leave out seeds favoured by the doves. The wardens of the Countryside Park spread seeds on the concrete apron of Bloors Wharf, as an initial source of food for incoming turtle doves and these attracted two or three of the species, among other seed eating birds such as linnets. Despite these sightings, I myself did not see or hear a single turtle dove, within two months and more of searching the whole length of the park, from Rainham Dock East in the east to Eastcourt Meadows in the west. That does not mean that my visits were entirely unproductive. I saw many other species of birds, wild flowers, butterflies and grass snakes in the main pond (with the bridge across). From past experience, I knew that I had a good chance of meeting a turtle dove on Motney Hill, which is just outside the boundary of the Park. At a notice declaring "PRIVATE ROAD" I got out of my car and walked. Upon reaching the houses on the top the Hill, I came to a long, dense and impenetrable length of tall brambles, on my right, which stretched about half way down the Hill. Beyond the brambles was rough grass dotted with hawthorn trees and bushes and, adjoining the embankment of Otterham Creek, was an area of common reed. At a metal gate across the road, on which there was a notice stating, euphemistically, "Waste Water Treatment Plant", I turned right onto a

DESTRUCTION OF THE WHITE HORSE INN

On May 14th 1892 one of the biggest blazes seen in Rainham took place when a fire broke out in the White The Chatham firemen could only push down the walls Horse Inn on the corner of Station Road and the High Street.

The Inn closed as usual on the night of Friday May 13th and the customers left while publican Charles Adie, his wife, their two children and four lodgers including two Royal Engineers stayed in the building. When everyone went to bed everything seemed normal according to Mrs Adie but at 4.20am she awoke to see smoke coming from the bedroom fireplace and heard knocking but at first she decided not to do anything. Unable to sleep she got up and went to the landing where she saw thick smoke coming from below. She realized that a fire had started so she woke her husband then the two Royal Engineers sleeping in the adjoining room. She went to the children's bedroom, woke them up, wrapped a blanket around each and then took them out of the building by the back staircase. Mr Adie and the lodgers also managed to vacate the premises. While Mrs Adie and her children were taken into the Cricketer's Inn opposite by the landlord Mr Jarrett, Mr Adie, assisted by police constables Packman and Bridgeland who had arrived on the scene, managed to take the horses and traps from the coach-house next to the inn to safety before the fire engulfed it. By this time a large crowd of Rainham residents had
