Bare-knuckle prizefighting is the original form of boxing, closely related to ancient combat sports. It involves two individuals fighting without boxing gloves or other padding on their hands. As a one time regular at the Railway Pub in Rainham I was pleased to see the photo and article in the September issue. I don't actually live in Rainham but have a long association with it. My brother does live in Henry Street and it was he who showed me the copy of Action Forum.

I attended the Medway College of Art from 1958 and got to know another student named Paul Graham and, later, we formed a not very successful rock group which also featured my brother and Andy Tyler. Both Paul and Andy lived in Station Road, Rainham. My brother and I hailed from Wayfield in Chatham and in later years my brother began to use the Railway as his 'local'. I followed suit in 1969 and Bob, the landlord, liked to boast that he had two customers who travelled some distance to enjoy his beer etc.

I think I am correct in saying that the photo of the 'football' team was actually taken at Easter in 1970 and not Boxing Day in 1971. I know this as I am in the picture and only ever played in that game. I have many other reasons for remembering 1970: I was dumped by my (then) girlfriend, failed my driving test on my 27th birthday and also left Mackay's the printers after five years of working there!

# Nature Notes

#### NATURE NOTES

In early September of last year, I visited Scotney Castle Estate, which is near Tunbridge Wells and which is owned by the National Trust. In particular, I went on a guided tour of the estate's Little Scotney Farm, which is a mixed one. The tenant, Ian Strang, raises beef cattle and sheep and grows wheat and hops. Most unusually, he dries his hops in his three traditional oast houses. Our guide led us along a drive towards the farm, through parkland dotted with oak and other trees, among which sheep and red Sussex beef cattle were grazing. Also feeding there was a mixed flock of rooks and jackdaws and migrating swallows. I could hear the call of a green woodpecker, which was doubtless in search of the yellow meadow ants that live in large, grass covered anthills. In the ancient hedge alongside the drive. I noted rose hips and the berries of hawthorn, elder, bramble, bryony and holly. They were a sure sign of autumn. In due course we came to the farm, which is typically Kentish, consisting mainly of red brick buildings with peg tile roofs. There is an 18th century wooden framed barn, with a hipped roof and tarred clapboarding, which serves as a maternity unit at lambing time. A large, modern, open shed in the middle of the yard houses the beef cattle in the winter. There is a long row of loose boxes which house riding horses. It being a Saturday, a number of young ladies were to be seen mucking out their horses. Finally, there are three round oast houses, built in the 1870s, with an adjoining shed, erected in the 1950s, and containing bine stripping machinery. This replaced the picking of the hop cones, carried out, by hand, by generations of hop pickers as they sat in the hop gardens. Hens, cockerels and an assortment of terriers run freely throughout the farm yard. It was good to see a flock of houses sparrows on the farm. They presumably feed on the seeds in the hay given to the horses. Little Scotney Farm is in an idyllic spot. It sits between the Rivers Teise and Bewl, both of which are tributaries of the River Medway. From the high ground of the farm there is a view over both the farm's own hop garden and the neighbouring Finchcock hop

garden. Also in view are the rag stone towers of Horsmonden and Goudhurst parish churches. One could not imagine a more Kentish scene. Leaving the farm yard for later in our visit, we headed for the hop garden. Five varieties of hops are grown at Little Scotney, the main one being "Target". It is the aromatic, female flowers of the hop that develop into the greenish yellow cones that are used in brewing. They clarify the beer, help it to keep longer and give it a bitter flavour. The bines and the string around which the bines have climbed are cut down by hand, which is a strenuous and dusty job. They are carried to the stripping shed in a procession of narrow trailers hauled by three diminutive Massey Ferguson tractors of 1960s vintage.

In the shed the bines are fixed onto hooks dangling from a continuous metal chain which conveys the bines to a stripping machine. This separates the cones from the stems and leaves of the bines. The process is very noisy and dusty. The cones are then conveyed to one of the three oast houses where they are spread over cloth laid on top of a slatted drying floor. They are then slowly dried by means of oil burners and subsequently packed into large sacks (or pokes) for conveying to the brewers. About half of the hops are sold to a large London brewer and the rest to a variety of mini-brewers, including Westerham Brewery Company, which makes Little Scotney Pale Ale, among other beers. Our guide told us that nearly all of the people working in the hop garden and on the farm, which were a mixture of men and women, young and elderly, lived locally. During our time in the stripping shed and the oast houses, the workers were sitting down together and eating their lunches. As we filed past them, apologies were made for our intrusion but the workers seemed relaxed about our presence. We stopped briefly to admire the front gardens of two farm workers' semi detached cottages. I spotted, among other flowers, Michaelmas daisies, roses, dahlias and hollyhocks, the latter of which had long gone to seed The hollyhock, growing against a cottage wall, is the archetypal plant of the English cottage garden. A robin gave out a somewhat melancholy song as it perched on a washing line. We were finally taken to see two terraces of hoppers' huts, each ten

foot square. They were in any idvllic spot, in Broadham Wood, among heather and foxgloves and alongside the River Bewl, from where the hoppers obtained their water. The huts were discretely hidden away, so as not to be seen by the former estate owners Alec Roberts, the champion of his weight had never in the big house. Today the big house is owned by the National Trust, whose members are prepared to pay good money for a guided tour to see the hoppers' huts. 'For fully a minute the men circled round, viewing

Because the fight was illegal it had to be staged secretly in the early morning hours. E P Fay of the 'Clarion,' went to Rainham from London to report on the fight. While travelling on the Roberts as the winner. midnight train he met a group of well-known gentlemen that included a peer, a racehorse owner and minutes, the police arrived to investigate but they were a bookmaker all on their way to the same fight although they made out that they did not know each Alec Roberts and many spectators left for London on other. They got into four carriages outside Chatham railway station and set off for Rainham at 1.15am. When E P Fay and accompanying gentlemen arrived at Meresborough they were met by Fred Scott who escorted them to the first floor of his big barn where two long tables laden with huge amounts of meat, vegetables and barrels of Kentish ale were placed. A problem arose when Rainham police-constable Barranger arrived to find out what was happening. He discharged from the force. 


