Editorial

Fifty years ago, in March 1969, Action Forum first landed on the door mats of Rainham. For those of my generation this seems no time at all but looking back much has changed in Rainham during this half century. The twenty four years since the Second World War had already seen major changes. The parish of Rainham following much development in previously uninhabited areas had been greatly reduced in size with Twydall to the west and Wigmore to the south each building a new church in the 1960s and becoming separate parishes (Wigmore joined with Bredhurst, Hempstead and Parkwood to become the Parish of South Gillingham). The M2 motorway had relieved some of the congestion through Rainham High Street particularly after the Hoath Way link road was completed and the electrification of the railway made commuting to London a much more viable proposition. House building continued at a pace particularly Parkwood which crept ever further south and Mierscourt Valley. New schools provided education for these areas, Parkwood, Dean Wood and Mierscourt, whilst Wakeley and Thames View provided the extra places north of the A2, so as Action gardens in support of the church OR their favourite Forum produced its first four page edition of 10,000 copies we were set for rapid change.

The Rainham Plan, long discussed, was finally implemented albeit in a vastly different form from that first proposed. The promised by-pass for Rainham High Street deemed unnecessary now we had the M2 was scrapped and the swathe of land just south of the A2 which had been blighted by restrictions for many years released for development. However the demolition of the old Church School at the top of Station Road and subsequent construction of Rainham Shopping Centre was completed by the 1980s. This was received with mixed feelings as it effectively killed much of the trade for shops in the eastern section of the High Street, only sustained to some extent by the Co-op household store and the post office.

By the 1990s Bowaters factory at Rainham Mark was in decline. Despite its final closure 20 years ago the Bowaters Blue Ball is still fondly remembered and I noticed when remedial highways work was proposed last year the signs still proclaimed Bowaters Roundabout, Likewise we still refer to Farthing

Corner Services on the M2, much preferring the ancient name, despite them being renamed Medway Services some while ago. Some of the Bowaters site was acquired for a big new Tesco's much to the alarm of Rainham traders who feared this would mean the closure of the Rainham store with a further detrimental effect on local footfall for independent businesses. Rainham continues to evolve we had periods of Estate Agents lining the A2 when house building was at its height, followed by a glut of Florists. Service centres now dominate, hairdressers, nail bars, tattoo parlours, coffee houses and cafes, very different from 1969 when we had butchers, greengrocers, bakeries, newsagents, drapers, and ironmonger stores. What will the next 50 years bring? For some time now we have printed 20,000 copies of AF each month to cover the same area but with the recent surge in housebuilding yet again this is already being pushed and we are increasing the print run. Incidentally, if you would like a walk with a purpose each month we have several roads just waiting for your help, see page 3 for the current list where volunteers are needed. So to the next 50 years but in the meantime have a very good month and we will see you again in April ready to enjoy the spring flowers.

REVEREND CHARLES COBB - Real Life Hero and Long Serving Vicar of Rainham

Born in 1828 and the son of Captain Thomas Cobb of New Romney, he lived until 90 years old and became one of the oldest clergy in the country. He served as vicar of Rainham for 32 years from 1876 to 1908 and became one of the most popular and well respected clergymen to have worked in the parish.

Charles Cobb entered the holy orders in 1853 after he had obtained his MA degree at Corpus Christi College, Cambridge. After this he held curacies at Halstead, St Nicholas-at-Wade, Lambeth and Minster Sheppey. In 1860 he was appointed Rector at Dymchurch where he remained for sixteen years. While serving in Dymchurch he carried out a heroic act for which he gained widespread praise and fame. 'The Sunday Pictorial' dated 29th March 1936, reported that during a fierce gale on January 5th 1867 a French lugger named 'Corrier de Dieppe' which had been blown badly off course got wrecked on Dymchurch Sands. The coastguards tried to fire a lifeline aboard to rescue the crew but it fell short. After this three of the crew were washed into the sea and drowned but one sailor remained clinging to the rigging. A coastguard named John Batist tried to battle his way to the wreck in rough sea and strong wind but failed. Reverend Cobb, a powerful swimmer, arrived and against the wishes of some parishioners who were also present, he took off his coat, dived into the sea and swam to the wreck where he reached the stranded sailor. Soon after this Batist also reached the vessel and helped Reverend Cobb haul the sailor to safety.

For his act of heroism Reverend Cobb received many awards which included a gold medal from The National Lifeboat Institution in 1867 and the Albert Medal from Napoleon III of France. He later had a photograph of himself wearing his medals with a framed certificate from the National Lifeboat Association displayed on the wall at Rainham vicarage. John Batist who had assisted in the rescue received a bronze medal.

Later in 1876 Charles Cobb became vicar of Rainham and got fully involved in the church and local activities. During the late 1870s and early 1880s he played as a successful opening batsman for Rainham Cricket Club and also made many friends in the parish.

After his wife died in 1903 Reverend Cobb continued as vicar of Rainham until 1908 then resigned. Reverend Tamplin succeeded him and married his daughter. Reverend Cobb continued to reside at the vicarage and maintained a role at the church taking services when his health allowed him to do so. He regularly presided over intercession services in the church during World War 1. Held in high esteem during the time he resided in Rainham, he died in 1918 and was buried in the churchyard. After his death the parishioners of Rainham, as a mark of respect and recognition of his services, presented the church with a new communion table and a communion plate in his memory.

Nature Notes

NATURE NOTES FOR JANUARY AND FEBRUARY

In late January I visited Knole Park on the outskirts of Sevenoaks. For me, the attraction was not Knole House, but the ancient oak trees in the parkland. I have been very fond of oak trees since I was a boy playing in fields lined with oaks planted in Georgian times when the remaining, mediaeval, open fields were enclosed. As large as they appeared to me, it is likely that they were not then in their prime and it is perhaps only now that that are in their maturity. By contrast, many of the oaks that I went to Knole to see are already dead or dying. The oaks growing on the heavy, red clay of my native Leicestershire are English oaks and those growing on the acidic. greensand escarpment on which Knole sits are sessile oaks. The public entry to Knole by car is from the High Street In Sevenoaks, opposite St Nicholas parish church with a fine cupola on the top of its tower. The entrance drive drops down to a dry river bed, called The Gallops, that once fed into the River Darenth and then The Thames at Dartford, Adjoining The Gallops is a knoll (small rounded hill) on which sits Knole House. Scattered along the former river bank and up the side of the knoll are trees, between which are small clearings covered in bracken. I motored slowly through these trees as I zig-zagged up the knoll. I noticed that new trees had been planted in the clearings and protected from the deer by stout wooden cages. The deer eat whatever acorns and chestnuts the jays and squirrels have not hidden and will also eat the tender leaves of any young oak or sweet chestnut trees that grow from buried acorns or nuts not retrieved by the jays or squirrels. Natural England have reported that, as a result of grazing by deer, the ground cover under the trees, apart from bracken, is limited, as is the natural regeneration of

On the top of the plateau I parked the car near to Knole House, walked to the top of the knoll and sat on my portable seat overlooking the trees I had driven through. They are part of the Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI) that covers the whole 1,000 acres of the parkland. The predecessors of Natural England considered that the trees - sessile oak, beech, field maple, downy birch, ash and hawthorn - were part of

the original wildwood. Sweet chestnut and sycamore in the wood may have been planted in the 17th or 18th centuries as ornamental trees. None of the trees I had seen or could see had been pollarded. As I sat there. studying the trees through my binoculars or by naked eye, the quietness was interrupted only by the calls of iackdaws and, in the distance, pupils of Sevenoaks School enjoying their morning break in the playground. Among the mature and dving trees were ones that were clearly dead; they had either remained upright or had fallen to the ground. The dead trees had been left where they were, as were any branches that had fallen to the ground. Some of the fallen trees and branches may have been blown down during the Great Storm of October 1987. All of this dead wood is a habitat for a rich variety of invertebrates which is the finest in Kent. That is one of the reasons why the parkland has been declared an SSSI and why the National Trust is not allowed to remove the dead wood, which greatly favours the green and great spotted woodpeckers, which seek out the aforementioned rich variety of invertabrates. As already noted, I came to Knole especially to see the sessile oaks, those at their prime being more easily observed when their leaves had fallen. A sessile oak is generally not as impressive as an English oak. Its girth is only about half the size if its cousin but it can grow much taller. A characteristic of the sessile that it is of interest to a forester is that it has a tall trunk that extends well into its crown, which is made up of straight, radiating branches. It has thus been traditionally used in the construction of ships and houses and carpentry generally. So, sessile oaks can grow tall but what is their life-span? I have a book on trees that is usually helpful but all that it states is that they are "very long lived". I did consider, knowing that Knole had supplied timber to the Royal Navy at Chatham, whether any of the clearly old trees in the wood (dead, dying or alive) had been planted by the Sackville family between the early 17th century, when they were granted the estate by Elizabeth 1st and the mid19th century, when the bottom fell out of the market for timber for wooden warships. But that is all too speculative on my part and it is best for me to keep to the description of "very long lived". I will end these Notes by saying that there is no substitute for being in the presence of ancient trees and feeling awed and inspired by their fortitude. They may be long passed

their youth, and even their maturity, and be into their decline, as evidenced by broken and fallen limbs. Ancient trees have character and strong personalities of their own, which they acquire with age. Even when some of my then unmarried aunts! an ancient tree finally dies, it can exist for many years I would very much like to hear from anyone who strong emotions.

THE YORKES TEA GARDEN

I cannot believe that there is anyone alive now who could recall The Yorkes Tea Garden, in what was then known as York Road, later renamed Durham Road, so as not to be confused with the one in Gillingham. The plot of land directly opposite the top of Edwin Road was purchased for the princely sum of £10 in the 1920s. An ex 1914-18 army timbered building was acquired which apparently had to be man-handled in sections from some distance down Edwin Road, as the top part was as yet unmade.

My father also purchased the adjoining plot and created St Margaret's Putting Green. The Yorkes became the home to my Grandmother and some of the Heather family, not all as there were 12 of them! The Tea Garden was a summer time venture, ably assisted by some of my many aunts. The timber 'hut' occupied that site until the demise of Uncle George and Aunty Nellie, residents until the 1960s or thereabouts. I became aware many years later, that Dad had sold his holding to Uncle Bill (a Naval Officer), husband of one of his sisters, Aunty Elsie, to build a house there, for the sum of £100. Mum never forgave him for that

I have fond memories of visiting Gran on summer Sunday afternoons before and after World War 2. walking from Tennyson Road, along the Darland Banks and through the woods to Wigmore. Time spent Book in advance, Bring your own Drink and Nibbles there 'running wild' through a small maze of hedges, with my cousins Eileen and Stanley who lived next door. At dusk I distinctly remember the many glow worms amongst the hedge rows. The day would end with a final bit of enjoyment for me, the dash across the road to catch the last bus home. So much has changed. Fortunately, the Darland Banks and most of the woods have survived; for how much longer is always a question with the race for more houses! One thing that is still the same though - the bus stop at

the top of Edwin Road is still in the same place!
