

We are very pleased to include this month an article by Florence Classey, a friend of Ellen Stringer, celebrating Ellen's 100 birthday this month. Ellen was "THE WITNESSES" born and bred in Rainham but after travelling the world returned to her roots when she was needed to assist her parents. We have now reached the time when our centenarians were born after the end of the First World War but nevertheless had extremely difficult early lives as the country only slowly recovered but then slipped into depression, economic unrest and a second world war. Those celebrating a hundred years now must indeed have been very hardy The Witnesses is Clive Sansom's best known souls. I wonder how many centenarians we have in the collection of poems and tells the life of Jesus of Rainham area and particularly how many were born and brought up here.

September is according to John Keats poem 'To Autumn' the season of mists and mellow fruitfulness. This year we could also add hot, sunny days as we basked in the sunshine. A prolonged Indian summer always sets us up to better endure the short, cold days

The performances will take place at St Peter's Church, ahead and nothing seems quite as bad if the sun shines. When Ellen was a child in Rainham, and indeed until the 1950s, September would have been the time when you loaded all the needs for the day on to any available wheeled handcart and with the neighbours and all the children the women walked to their nearest hop garden for the annual picking season. Although it was regarded as a holiday it was serious hard work as each picker was paid by quantity picked. The adults who were much quicker and more skilled stripped the largest clusters from the bine whilst the children were left with the small blooms at the tips which took much longer to produce any worthwhile quantities. When the weather was good it was an enjoyable, social occasion and the extra money was certainly very useful in many households. I remember as a child seeing our neighbours trudging home at the end of each day with black hands and bedraggled clothes as their reward for a hard days picking. From our Diary pages it would appear that October is Ouiz time. You have a wide choice of charities to support if you enjoy pitting your wits against each other in friendly competition. We also start the build up to the Christmas season with several early Fairs and Bazaars but before that we have the annual Remembrance Day events and poppy selling. Local

organisers would appreciate your help manning the many British Legion Poppy Stalls we have in and around the area. A CENTURY WORTH CELEBRATING

Ellen Mary Stringer is celebrating her 100th Birthday on 13th October 2019.

Ellen's parents belonged to 'The Farming Community of Rainham' where her father was manager of a fruit farm. Kent was then known as 'The Garden of England' because of its fertile soil and mild climate allowing orchards of fruit and hop gardens to be successful. Ellen enjoyed helping with the work. She remembers sitting on the bails of hops being carried by horse and cart to the Oast Houses in Rainham for drying. Hop picking in Rainham was primarily done by locals, the local schools had an annual two week 'hop picking' holiday in September so the children could help, but further afield in Kent London families were recruited for the work and to enjoy a holiday in the countryside in the process.

Ellen was christened and confirmed in St Margaret's Church, where her father was an active member. She had a brother, Frank, who worked in the Dockyard and a sister Florence, married to Arthur, who had a daughter Rosemary. Sadly all have died.

After graduating from the County Grammar School Ellen trained as a nurse at Hammersmith and West Middlesex Hospitals in London. She later completed a midwifery course at St Bart's Hospital. During the war years she remained in London, helping with nursing, midwifery and social needs following the devastation to health and housing during the Blitz. She was also allocated to the midlands to look after people affected there. Ellen then undertook a Teachers Training Course at High Wycombe College to prepare her for her next plan of action. She went to Canada where she worked in community care in rural areas with teaching and supervision and also working at Hamilton Maternity Unit.

Ellen returned to Kent owing to her father's illness and looked after both parents until the end of their lives. Her next move was to Sheppey General

Unit, she remained there for many years until her retirement. The consultants were Mr Smelts and later Mr Mathews. A colleague was Sheila Judge, a midwifery sister, farmer, horse woman and author.

Following retirement Ellen helped in the Rainham Community with care for neighbours, friends and members of St Margaret' congregation. While her health allowed she was very active in the church, she belonged to many organisations including: The Trefoil Guild, a group of ex Girl Guides who support local groups; NHS Fellowship for retired NHS staff; MMs for retired midwives.

Over the last few years Ellen has had to make significant changes to her life. Giving up driving, moving from her bungalow in Orchard Street to live in sheltered accommodation at Longford Court and then Newington Court where 24 hour help is possible. None of these decisions were easy for such an independent person but each became necessary. However she is grateful to God for the life she has had and the good family and friends along the way.



Nature Notes

NATURE NOTES FOR SEPTEMBER

Once upon a time, in the northernmost part of the ancient county of Kent, there was a chalk stream with clear, cool water, fed from underground chalk aquifers in the North Downs. It ran from its source at Orpington, through the mediaeval villages of St Mary Cray; St Pauls Cray; Foots Cray; North Cray and Bexley to a little way beyond Crayford, on the Roman Watling Street, where it joined with the River Darent on its way to the Thames. The stream was full of brown trout and white clawed crayfish, both native to this country. It is likely that the crayfish was named after the watercourse in which the crustacean was first found, namely, of course, the Cray. By the time of the Domesday Book, the waters of the Cray were being used to power a total of six water mills. I shall say no more about the history of the chalk stream, as I move forward to my first visit to the Cray in early September. Firstly, I should explain that, in order to give them more protection under the law, the Department of the Environment has designated all worthy chalk stream Rivers. The River Cray, as I shall now call it, has been adversely affected by the outwards spread of the London Borough of Bromley into the upstream half of the river. In particular, the Cray has been largely hidden away by surrounding houses and commercial development. In places the river runs in concrete channels or underground culverts. It has, however, largely escaped intrusion into its middle reaches at Foots Cray Meadows, North Cray and the extensive grounds of Hall Place, all of which are in the London Borough of Bexley. In 1965, the River Cray, along with the communities by the side of the river, including the four villages collectively known as 'The Crays', were absorbed into the new London Boroughs of either Bromley or Bexley. Thus they were no longer in the ancient county of Kent.

In 2013, Bexley Council made a report on its Sites of Importance for Nature Conservation. The River Cray was described as one of London's finest chalk streams with some excellent wildlife habitats, including the species - rich, damp pastures of Foots Cray Meadows and the North Cray ancient wood. The river was also described as one of the Thames' clearest tributaries which still possesses a natural profile. Concrete

channels and underground culverts do not constitute a natural profile but, to be fair to Bexley, these structures appear to be mostly upstream in Bromley. In 2014 the World Wide Fund for Nature (WWF) made a report on the state of England's chalk streams. On the River Cray, it reported that, in the 1970s, wild brown trout became extinct there. This was due. firstly, to over-extraction of underground water in the North Downs by Thames Water. Secondly, heavy industrialisation by, at one period in time, fourteen water mills which milled flour, produced paper and sawed timber, amongst other operations. Thirdly, urban pollution. The report noted, however, that the Cray was still the home of dace and pike, among other course fish, and eels. Sadly, the WWF noted that today's generation of children may be the last to find a native crayfish in the Cray because of diseases carried by the imported signal cray fish.

On my second visit to the Cray, in mid-September, Mrs Ennis accompanied me to Hall Place in Bexley where there are extensive gardens and parkland through which the river flows. The estate is owned by the Borough of Bexley and entrance to the grounds is free. There are a number of small, well-tended gardens of flowers, vegetables and soft and top fruit. There are also large flower gardens around the Manor House as well as some magnificent London plane trees, holm oaks and common limes. After visiting the gardens we had a coffee in the riverside café, listening to the sound of water splashing over a weir. We had sat on decking overlooking the site of a water mill which was mentioned in the Domesday Book. I noticed, upstream, a water hen nervously crossing the river and a male grey wagtail, sporting a bright yellow breast and bobbing up and down on a post. There was no sign of the kingfisher that visitors are encouraged to look out for but we did spot a small red dragonfly and a banded demoiselle damselfly. It was good to see meadow sweet still in bloom, with its creamy, delicate flowers. Coffee finished, we came across a man fishing with a rectangular net in the deep water below the weir. One of the two young ladies with him said that they were from the Environment Agency and were searching for young eels (elvers). She showed us two that had been caught. They would have come from the eels' spawning grounds in the Sargasso Sea and would have taken about three years to cross the Atlantic to get here. We then walked downstream of

the Cray, with the extensive parkland on our right. The river is lined on one or both banks with alder. sallow, willow and whitebeam trees, among others. Here the Cray really does have a rural atmosphere about it. As we walked along, I was pleased to see that the water was very clear. But whether I was really walking along a chalk stream was nagging me. The reasons for my doubts were, firstly, that, in summer, the chalk spring at Orpington regularly stops flowing as a result of a low water table. Secondly, when the spring is flowing it is diluted as it enters into and passes through three flooded gravel pits abandoned in relatively recent times. Finally, it is further diluted when it merges with the River Shuttle, which is not another chalk stream, near Hall Place. I decided not to let it worry me. The London Borough of Bexley is clearly happy with its inheritance and I am grateful to them for giving Mrs Ennis and me an enjoyable and free day out.

Part Two continued from August 2019 If you walked across the fields between St Margaret's Church and Wigmore you must have heard the shrill song of many larks as they soared above you, and the plaintive call of the cuckoo who welcomed the spring. You did not need to leave your bed to hear the full dawn chorus of many different birds as they greeted the day. True this has been replaced by the mournful call of the collard dove. If you have never heard that indescribable greeting to the day you will have to seek it somewhere beyond todays Rainham but fortunately we are surrounded by rural villages that may still enjoy the many country sounds that are lost to us. Before the Second World War we heard the hooters from farms and the cement factory calling time to the workers and a whistle or bell for 'cover the bricks' when rain was expected. The telegraph boy was summoned by whistle and the Council School bell hailed its pupils twice daily. Part time firemen were called up by a maroon and the clanging bell announced the coming of both fire engine and ambulance.

We always looked up to see a passing aeroplane and especially when it was manoeuvring with loop the loop and sky diving as they often did making much more engine noise. Guy Fawkes Day had its traditional singing and collecting but there was much

less fireworks noise.

The war produced new sounds. The siren warning us of imminent raids and the welcome all clear. Sometimes gun fire practise from Shoeburyness echoed over the village and we ceased to look up for every plane. Air Raid Wardens took over the friendly street cries with their 'Take cover' and 'Put out that light' reminders.

Since the war Rainham has become a town with more noise and bustle and haste and without the former village smells and sounds we used to know.
