Nature Notes

September in the Wildlife-Friendly Garden

Our summer has continued to be mainly hot with very little rain. As I said last month, plants have continued to suffer, although our current gardening practices have helped some of our pollinators: The introduction of wild flowers into grassy areas has definitely helped struggling butterfly populations and leaving our grassy areas uncut for longer gives many species the opportunity to produce more generations of insects during the year. I know, more than ever, that each of us gardening in a wildlife-friendly way contributes to providing those oases which provide a springboard for new populations previously living in the countryside. There is a mass of evidence to back that up as well. As farming methods become more aware of nature-based solutions, that too will help habitats to recover and nature flourish along with it. Kent Wildlife Trust is getting more requests for help from our Wilder Grazing Team, both theoretical (human) and practical (a range of grazing animals, suited to different habitats).

Shrub of the month

There are a surprising variety of flowering shrubs that are good for wildlife during September. I always wax lyrical about Ivy, as

you know how good that is. Other choices include Elaeagnus, which makes a magnificent hedging plant, Ceratostigma (Hardy Plumbago) with its stunning blue flowers and later red foliage or Arbutus, the Strawberry Tree. I had always thought my neutral soil wouldn't be suitable but the only thing it doesn't like is being waterlogged.

Job of the month

I have so much work to do in the garden because, as you may know, I don't function well in the heat. Now it is a question of not what, nor where, but how? So what I am doing is starting in one corner and working my way round the various sections, trying to be systematic but also keeping my eye open for things in trouble! I follow up the clearing with supplementary planting to replace those pollen and nectar sources.

Wish us well with our garden, as I wish you lots of good sightings of wildlife in yours. That reminds me, we had the first sighting of a slow worm in the garden! It was under a board we had put over a border for builders to stand on when they replaced a window for

No 8 – A Sea Swim at Leysdown on Sea

Leysdown on Sea, on the Isle of Sheppey is still in holiday mode on this super hot day. We are in the midst of yet another heatwave, the 4th this sticky summer and I am eating an ice cream as the tide slips into the estuary. And yet, there is something in the air, a shifting of the earth. The swallows, wheeling overhead like dark blown confetti know it and so do I. Autumn is coming.

I walk along the sea wall towards Shellness. Inland, the fields are golden with stubbles and gangs of sparrows are taking advantage of this brief bonanza of seed left behind by the harvesters before the stubbles are ploughed in and the fields re-sown.

There is a beach which I swim off, far enough away from the town that few people visit. In the spring the oystercatchers find shelter here to build a nest and raise their young amid the carpet of sea spurge. Now, late in the season, the acid yellow spurge has mellowed into hews of dusty pink and carmine red and the oystercatcher chicks have flown.

I crunch, through the cockles and razor shells, down to the shoreline and take tentative steps into the sea. It is warm, well about as warm as a British sea gets. The water has slipped in slowly over the estuarine mud and envelopes me in its soft, cloudy waves. I breaststroke out between the beach groins through pockets of warm and cold water before flipping over

onto my back.

The clouds bubble up with the heat and, overhead, a gull spies on me with its yellow eye to see if I am too big a sea creature to make a tasty meal. It decides I am and heads away, hoping to spot a shoal of mackerel off shore. Sometimes I am joined by a common seal, who watches me from a distance. He never approaches but just to swim in the same water as him is a joy.

I love these sea swims just a little harder at this time of year knowing that soon the water will grow too cold and the beach too windy to make these dips pleasurable for me. But, for now, the sea re-sets me in a way a dip in a crowded council swimming pool never does. It is something to do with being emersed in nature, the smell of the ozone, the distant horizon. We are born through water and often I emerge from my dip feeling revitalised; the troubles of the day washed away, a little more certain of my course for the coming months.

Like the farmers in the fields, the end of summer is our time to gather in, take stock. Know that the nights are drawing in and accept it but grasp that last glint of summer that remains.

Despite sowing 2 window troughs of pollinator-friendly flowers as yet we have had no butterflies and just a few bees have visited; are we killing them off?

The nearest butterfly was resting on a window ledge - I think it was a meadow ringlet or brown but it flew off before I could take a photo of it.

The only other thing was a funnel spiders web - a photo of which I attach.

Dear Graham,

Thank you for planting your window troughs for pollinators. The fact you've had some visitors shows the plants are working at attracting bees - butterflies are always more difficult.

I notice some annuals have finished flowering - plant a succession of plants, starting with crocus and forget-me-nots and continue through the season. Poached egg flowers are quite difficult for me so well done! It is difficult to see butterflies early and I hope you are seeing a few more late summer. I wonder whether the brown butterfly you saw was a Gatekeeper - they have been more numerous this year.

To help continue to attract pollinators, small-flowered salvias continue into autumn and, with a little care over winter, should survive for another flowering next year. It is always a case of trial and error to see which plants are happiest in your situation but you have made a great start and are on the right lines. I do hope you continue to get pleasure from your troughs.

Rainham History (AJ)

Fascinating Find (cont. from front cover)

As the author of the Rainham History website I get copies of photos sent through, many of which are previously unseen but some are examples that have appeared elsewhere. Around 10 years ago, I received some scans of various scenes around Kent, including our cover photo this month, but didn't get any more info. Fast forward to July and Hamish Mackay Miller passed on a box of old photos which also contained some original 6"x 4" plate glass negatives, including the cover photo, dated to approximately 1910. This scene shows one of the earliest trams that came to Rainham, along with the area around the High Street and Station Road. The White Horse is still the same building but the Cricketers was rebuilt in the 1930s further back from the road. Hookers garage was replaced by Barclays Bank, again in the 1930s.

I tried to scan the negatives with limited success so contacted local photographer Claire Colston. She has been working with old cameras and developing the results in her darkroom.

Claire writes:

Printing from glass plates differs slightly to film, especially plates that are fragile and 120 years old. Just a tiny finger print or bit of dirt, especially on the emulsion side of the glass, is always harder or impossible to remove compared to more modern day film. Still, I managed to clean up the glass plates fairly well and only handled them with surgical

gloves as cotton gloves tend to slip. There is a thumb print of one of the plates that could only have occurred when the emulsion side was still wet. This has to be the original photographers which I find

Enlarging would be possible but tricky and detail is slightly lost the bigger we make them. There was no need to enlarge the negatives as they are so big to start with - the photo is a direct positive of the original negative. What a privilege to work with these glass plate negatives. They are art in their own right, I believe.

Two of the pictures have the same lady and boy in yet are a few miles apart. There is no doubt this was the photographer's wife and child but how did the family get around? These negatives were taken on a half plate wooden and brass large format camera which would have been extortionate in its day. Whoever took them was a professional and these would have been made into postcards in their day.

I use these cameras too, and it is a real art but so satisfying to get an image. I have made a limited edition set of 20 postcards for my personal use - it isn't commercially viable to sell these. However, I will be giving 2 away to local residents/business. See how to win one on my Facebook page, *Claire Colston Photography*.

I am available for bespoke darkroom work only, using original darkroom techniques. I do not scan. Scans have their place but, I think you will agree, printing these in the darkroom in the way that was originally intended does produce slightly better results.
