#### A Walk to Hartlip (Nov issue)

It's said good things often come in small packages and that applies to Action Forum. I was pleased to see the directions for a walk to Hartlip. Here was an opportune moment to take advantage of fine weather rather than hang about waiting for the car service to be completed.

All started well but it wasn't long before ambiguous directions had me backtracking. Whilst I appreciate the author had to meet a limited word count, it is no excuse for directions that are not explicit or are misleading. Footpath numbers are quoted but none are physically present on the signage. Where instructions were given to 'cross diagonally' or 'continue diagonally' - is that left to right/ right to left? Ambiguity probably added an extra km or two onto the route.

The article didn't reflect the conditions I found so what should have been a pleasurable walk turned out to be a frustrating one, due to inaccurate and presumptive narrative. I would suggest that future articles to encourage a bit of rambling are more accurate than the one provided.

#### **Howard School Memories** (Nov issue)

Dear Action Forum,

I read E Barton's piece about the Howard School in the Nov 2025 edition. I thought I'd share my memories - which are different from those reflected in the piece.

Firstly, some prior history. Rainham Boys Secondary had been in Orchard Street along with Rainham Girls until they both moved to 'The Campus site' off Derwent Way in 1967. St Margaret's Infants and Juniors then moved from the top of Station Road to the Orchard Street site. The old school building served as a community centre until the Oast at the station superseded it. It was then demolished and the Shopping Centre built.

The Howard was formed in 1975 with the merger of Rainham Boys and Gillingham Grammar which had been based at Third Ave (now Rober Napier) since the 1930s. This was an attempt by Kent County Council to deflect growing national calls to abandon selective education by having a 'bi-lateral comprehensive' as a single school but with streams following different curriculums. It was named after a Mrs Howard who was a councillor involved in education at that time. John Hicks who had been the head of the grammar school was its first headmaster.

I had gone from St Margarets to the Grammar in 1974 so was the last year to start at the old site. In Sept 1975 we all moved to the new Howard School which used the old Rainham

Boys buildings with some new blocks added. Having been ex-grammar, I was in the Alpha stream, starting in  $2\alpha 2$ . Many of my ex-St Margaret's friends were in the A stream. The timetable adopted originally was the old grammar school one, hence the long day, but soon in the first year the afternoons were cut back so we left at 3:30pm.

There was some of the sense of 'us and them' between the streams when we started. But many ' $\alpha$  boys' preferred that football was on the PE curriculum where previously it was only rugby and hockey in the winter. I certainly don't remember being treated with any additional respect by the teachers, who regularly threw wooden board rubbers at your head or hit you with keys spun on a long chain if you weren't 'on task'.

There were opportunities to mix with Rainham Girls in extra-curricular activities, music especially, which I enjoyed. I remember several performances with pupils from both schools. In 6<sup>th</sup> Form there was the youth club where, just before I left, I met the girl who later became my wife. On leaving, I went onto a training scheme with GEC Avionics (now BAE Systems).

In 2001, my son enrolled at The Howard, without taking the Medway Test as it then was. The school was brilliant for him and he left to study Physics and later a PhD at Leicester University.

### Nature Notes

#### No 9 – A Journey through the winter dark

November has been a month of leaden skies and damp days. The clocks turn and we turn inwards, away from the summer bright garden. For many it can be a tough time of year as the darkness descends early and the light barely seems to break the horizon, even at midday. The long gloaming of winter is upon us and it seems to press some of us closer to the earth.

But, even during the darkest times, nature can see us through. During the winter lock down of 2020, I cycled every evening from my home in Rainham to the reedbeds of Motney Hill to watch the amazing murmuration of starlings which swirled en mass in the skies; expanding and contracting, twisting and spiralling above the estuary skies, like avian fireworks. One of the great spectacles of nature taking place feet from the snarled-up traffic on the Lower road. The starlings kept me going during the difficult days following bereavement, a small miracle at the end of my street that temporarily lifted my heart every evening.

Now, five years later, I have been going through another dark time but, each morning, I rise early and sit at first light in my garden with a cup of hot coffee and wait for the

jackdaws to fly over, clack clacking with a sharp metallic sound as they fly out of their night roost in the trees that border the edge of town.

The sparrows wait, in the hedge surrounding my garden, the one that I refuse to cut lower despite the benign pressure of neighbours urging me to do so. They hang like early Christmas baubles in the hawthorn tree, chattering to each other and their homely faces make me smile.

Goldfinches arrive in a twitter, their call, like a dash of sunshine in the growing dawn. They bathe in the shallows of the small garden pond that I dug earlier this year, all flashing golden wings and punk rocker hairdos as the water ruffles their feathers. The site of them enjoying a little habitat that I have created brings me joy, JOY in capitals. As the light grows, a late bumblebee searches the last of the deep purple flowers of salvia for a dash of energy-rich nectar to see it through the winter.

It reminds me that nature perseveres, even in these months of gloom. It goes through the darkness, as sometimes we must do, to emerge once again into spring.

#### December in the Wildlife-Friendly Garden

Already, across the country, we are seeing the dangers of climate change. Storm Claudia didn't impact us much here in Kent but the effect of a month's worth of rain in a couple of days illustrates again that building on the flood plains is a recipe for disaster. The water suppliers and regulators need to do more work to hold the water on the land nearer the source of rivers. We need this in Kent as much as any county. Kent Wildlife Trust has recently purchased land which the River Teise runs through. This gives us a great opportunity to rewet the landscape and re-establish the old meanders. As the Teise is part of the Medway river system, working with others will help to ameliorate the flooding we often experience. In our own gardens we can do our bit to help by having permeable bases to our hard standing areas, avoiding concreting more than we need and restoring our front gardens from concrete to areas that will soak up water, allowing it to go back into the aquifer, rather than running into the overloaded drains.

#### Shrub of the month

TRADING

Providing natural food for birds through all your garden is a valuable thing to do, especially as birds congregating in a small area encourages the spread of avian influenza. Check whether your Cotoneaster, Pyracantha, Elder, or other berry bearing shrubs are producing abundant fruit.

If not, they may benefit from pruning after the current berries have been eaten. Cornus mas "Golden glory", otherwise known as Cornelian cherry, is a great winter-flowering shrub, followed by fruits in the autumn.

#### Jobs of the month

Get out into the garden when you can, keeping warm, dry and well shod! Carry secateurs, a tub for rubbish and just do the one thing in front of you that needs it most.

Clean greenhouse glass to keep light levels as high as possible, keep adding leaves to the leaf mould and grass to the compost, along with paper shreddings.

Keep paths clear and clean, grass edges neat and your garden will look a million dollars! Mulch borders and wherever there is bare
